Introducing the Yellville Summit Trap Team

The Yellville-Summit High School Trap Team, established in 2020, has become a vital program for teaching leadership, discipline, and firearm safety to young men and women in Marion County. Led by Coaches Andy and Patsy Smith, the team provides students with an opportunity to develop focus, responsibility, and marksmanship skills while fostering a deep respect for shooting sports.

Thanks to the generous \$8,000 grant from the Second Amendment Legacy Foundation, Inc, the team is in the process of purchasing four Browning BT-99 trap shotguns from Bob's Guns in Mountain Home, Arkansas. This new equipment will ensure students have the tools they need to train effectively and compete at their best.

"My wife and I believe that trap shooting is the most important sport of all," said Coach Andy Smith. "Firearm safety, training, and proficiency are an integral part of our nation's heritage. We are honored to be part of the passing on of these skills to our local kids."
