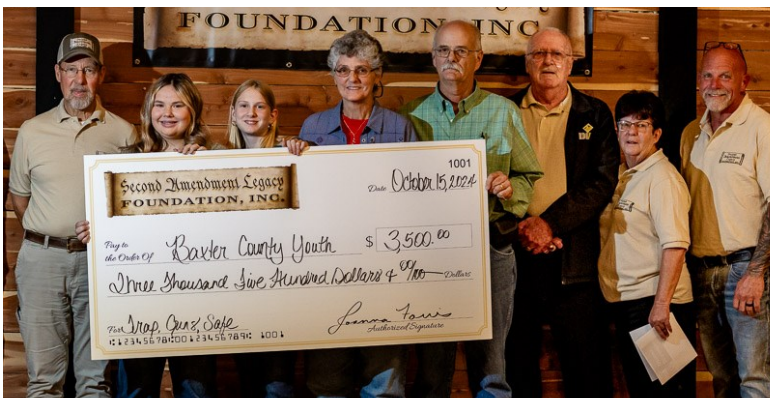

Introducing the Mountain Home NJROTC Program

The Mountain Home High School Navy Junior ROTC (NJROTC) program, established in 1993, focuses on developing knowledgeable and productive citizens. It offers leadership, discipline, and teamwork experiences without requiring a post-high school military commitment. The cadets can participate in activities like ceremonial marching, color guard, and physical training, alongside learning naval history and ship navigation. In fact, our organization was graced with their color guard at the 2024 banquet.

Thanks to dedicated efforts by Mtn. Home leadership, the program now serves over 130 cadets and receives funding from the Navy. Any high school student in Baxter County, as well as Flippin can be part of the program. It has been recognized as a "Distinguished Unit," placing among the top 30% of all NJROTC units nationwide. The Mountain Home unit was adopted in 2023 by the USS Arkansas, a Virginia-class submarine, which adds a unique connection between the school and the Navy.

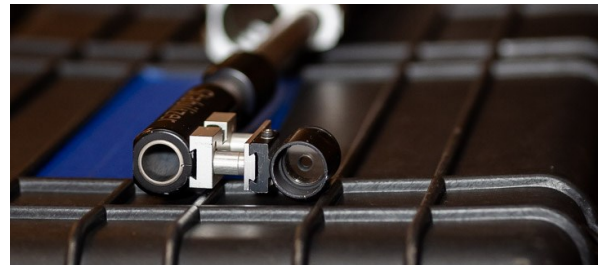
In May, 2024, two Mountain Home NJROTC cadets earned prestigious National Navy ROTC scholarships, securing full-ride opportunities at top universities, with ambitions to become Navy pilots and officers.

The current project for the Mountain Home NJROTC is to establish a precision-class marksmanship team. Their goal is to develop the best sporter rifle shooter, transition into precision rifle, and form a precision team for CMP 3-position air rifle (3PAR) and standing competitions. Precision class marksmanship is highly sought after by college teams.



The grant request was for the purchase of four precision air rifles, shooting coats and shooting trousers. Second Amendment Legacy Foundation was able to provide the funds needed for all four rifles.
