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Chiefs face up to the best

» What a Saturday as Kaizer Chiefs square up to Al Ahly in the final of the African Champions League in Morocco with six carryovers to TAB soccer pools adding to the amazing excitement of a historic day.

It's a massive week for South African soccer as Kaizer Chiefs head to Morocco for Saturday's African Champions League final and the biggest game in the club's 50-year history.

To mark the occasion, TAB has added carryovers to six pools that contain the historic match, including the first of two Soccer 10 pools on the day. The pool gets a R150,000 add-in and should total about R1.5 million, so there's big money to be won!

Chiefs are the underdogs against Al Ahly, the Cairo giants who have dominated the continental game for years and are seeking to extend their record number of wins in Africa's top club competition to 10.

The Egyptians are perennial victors in these contests and have vast experience of what it takes to dominate the rest of the continent, something they showed again last year despite the pressures of the COVID-19 pandemic.

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to last season's Champions League title after arriving just before the semi-final stage, and has continued to enhance his reputation at the club despite knowing the sack is just around the corner if they slip up.

Over the past week Al Ahly have been playing catch-up games in the Egyptian league and won all three, scoring 10 goals in the process. By contrast Chiefs have not had a competitive match since their semi-final second leg against Wydad Casablanca

on 26 June.

Chiefs have also had to bounce back from several COVID-19 cases in their camp which have proved disruptive.

But while they are the outsiders, there is no reason that AmaKhosi cannot win. If they defend stoutly, they have a quick counterattack as a strong weapon. And Ahly will be wary of a team who have performed poorly in domestic competition this past season, changed their coach and not made any fresh sign-

ings, yet have reached the final of such a prestige competition. They will think there must be some kind of "x-factor".

Chiefs will be in deep trouble if the Egyptians get an early goal, but the longer they keep them at bay the better their chance.

Ahly will be cautious at the start and in the end their superior finishing ability could prove the difference. TAB soccer customers are best advised to take Ahly to win but to cheer for Chiefs!

Phillipi- based trainer Mike Robinson sent out three runners at a rain-sodden Kenilworth on Saturday, striking a double blow with long-shots, Fateful and Grey Princess, whilst Lunar Tunes so nearly overcame a bad gate under a resurgent, Craig Bantam, and was only just edged out in a photo-finish to the last race.

This represents a welcome return to the No 1 box for Robinson, a diligent horseman, who has been enduring a horribly lean spell. “That was an awesome day! I was sceptical about the two fillies with bad draws, but it all turned out well. These are tough and testing times, but I remain positive and persevere, trying to keep my head above water.”

Robinson used to run a private training operation for Gaynor Rupert out at Drakenstein Stud in the Cape Winelands till a decision was made to outsource to a range of trainers, such as Justin Snaith, Candice Bass and Brett Crawford. He now cares for a small string of 15 horses and, like many conditioners with a lower profile than the big barns, could do with more support.

He is a realist and knows that

without buying power it's tough to compete for quality horseflesh at thoroughbred auctions. Understandably, he is not willing to make speculative purchases then try “put horses together” by finding owners afterwards, due to the financial risk. So, rather than buy outright, he scours the Western Cape stud farms looking for horses to lease on an affordable basis for his remaining band of loyal owners. He mentioned owner/breeder Peter de Beyer, in particular, who continues to provide much valued support to the yard.

Robinson is always good humoured, has a gracious sporting attitude, and is totally candid about his runners' chances when approached for comment. He doesn't run a betting stable as such, but alert horseplayers realise he has a subtle competitive edge during the wet Winter months. Whilst training facilities elsewhere were waterlogged and practically unusable after torrential downpours, the Phillipi tracks remain workable.

“I feel I can get horses fitter during Winter. We've got two straight sand tracks and a circular gallop that are in good order and holding up well. The conditions are completely different to when I was out at Drakenstein with their all-weather

surface and uphill track, so I've had to change aspects of my training style, but I just keep to the basics when it comes to things like feed and stable management.’

The first of Robinson's winners was five year- old Fateful, backed at long odds from 16/1 into 10/1. A fast run 1000m sprint in very soft ground suited ideally and the Master of my Fate gelding came from off the pace down the inside under Craig Bantam for a convincing score. This jockey has also been down on his luck with only three winners this year, so it was gratifying to see him seize a rare chance to shine, too.

Grey Princess was another Robinson trained outsider to smack down shorter priced rivals. The 16/1 mud-loving mare by former Durban July winner, Grey's Inn had shown signs of life at her most recent outings and was well handled from draw 10 out of 11 by Oswald Noach. A bargain buy at R20 000, she has now earned close to R200 000 for connections.

Robinson has half a dozen two year- olds getting ready to start their racing careers. He hopes that amongst them will be a few good enough to enjoy productive careers. Being able to replenish

older stock with talented new recruits is vital for any trainers' survival.

There are certainly easier ways to make a living than training racehorses, especially under prevailing economic circumstances, yet Robinson remains upbeat.

He's a highly capable horseman with loads of accumulated experience in the game since learning the trade under Chris Snaith, Dennis Drier and Mike Stewart. Robinson took out his personal trainers' license in 2008. Not only does he get horses fit but is astute in placing them in the right races and, in the past, used to sport one of the highest percentage strike rates in the country.

Those stats may have tumbled down as he battles along with lesser stock yielding just five winners this season from 135 runners (prior to Saturday's uptick,) but that doesn't mean he's forgotten how to train racehorses. Given the opportunity Robinson can certainly produce the winners – weekend warrior punters who kept faith in his abilities and got a healthy slice of some big exotic dividends at Kenilworth can vouch for that!

COMMENTATOR COHEN COMMENTS

If you win any exotics at Turffontein on Saturday, you won't need to worry about payday. It is a seriously tricky card. Another angle for today's meeting is that there isn't one debutant on the card.

The best bet comes in race 1. Little Prince put up an excellent debut two weeks ago behind Happy And Glorious who was touted as very tough to beat. Little Prince should be better for the experience and with Gavin Lerena in the irons, a huge run is expected.

Trainer Johan Janse van Vuuren has always said Manterio is average so it could be worth taking him on in race 2. He does try 2600m for the first time so don't totally ignore him. Understated was beaten by Wishonaire and Royal Mazarin last time but Understated is worth another chance.

The Sash was slightly unfortunate in her last start when she ran second behind Mauby. They renew their rivalry in race 4 but preference is firmly for The Sash who has a big pull at the weights. Lyle Hewitson takes the ride.

Fire Flower is capable and her recent form shows a win isnt too far away. She could be worth following in race 6. On a fast track, her frontrunning style should suit and she might get away from her rivals. Kabelo Matsunyane takes the ride. He often does.

Querari Ferrari gets one more chance from me when she runs in race 7. She didn't overcome her draw at her last start so that run is best ignored. She would be a welcome arrival in the P6 and the Jackpot.

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WET GOING – LOOKING FOR MUDLARKS

With the Western Cape experiencing a deluge of rain, track conditions have been very soft as the main racecourse, Kenilworth is situated in an especially high rainfall area. The surface, which can range from firm in Summer to a heavy bog during mid-Winter, does have an impact on results – yet another variable that punters must consider when making selections.

Some horses fare much better when the going is soft. Those that experience aches and pains due to slight unsoundness appreciate “the sting out of the ground.” Others have a particular galloping action which enables them to power through slushy turf faster than their rivals. There are tactical nuances too – it can be extremely difficult to make up ground from off the pace when there are clods and divots flying about, so horses that are natural front-runners avoid the kickback.

Track configuration is also a factor. The Winter course used at Kenilworth has a short run in from the final turn of just 470m – not much time for stretch runners to make up the leeway. During Winter, pace-setting and handy types have a tactical edge not only at Kenilworth but also at Cape Racing’s other venue, Durbanville. In contrast, the Summer course has a longer straight of over 600m which is fairer to all running styles.

Fitness is also very important. Whilst a partially fit racehorse can glide over a firm surface and

still do well based on raw ability, any deficiency in fitness will be exposed under more testing conditions. Racehorses in suspect physical shape often chose rain-soaked lawns as an excuse to throw in bad performances. That’s why horses with an advantage in physical conditioning are worth supporting at the right odds when it comes up mud, even if they may appear to lack the natural talent of their more fancied opposition.

All the form guides now clearly show each horses’ record in soft going. At this time of the year, it’s worthwhile to check these past performances and focus on those entries that have shown a liking for, or at least an ability to handle, an “off track.”

Nobody is saying this is an easy game but honing in on mudlarks can improve your chances of scoring a “gelukkie.” There were some hefty dividends on Saturday with the Pick 6 paying R452 963.60, and juicy Jackpot returns of R15 806.30 and R21 156.40. All of those winners in that difficult-to- catch P6 over the weekend - Apache Dream, Rewrite the Stars, Grey Princess, Worlds Your Oyster, Fateful and Adderbury Lake had shown a liking for a rain-softened turf.

Take the hint - if it keeps pouring down in Cape Town, be sure to add wet weather specialists to exotic perms and combinations.
