## Competition terms and conditions

1. By entering the Promoter's Competition, entrants accept these terms and conditions (the Terms and Conditions).
  2. In these Terms and Conditions, terms capitalised will have the meaning as defined in the text of this document, and terms bolded will have the meaning defined in schedule 1 of this document.
  3. The Terms and Conditions for the Competition consist of the Terms and Conditions contained here as well as the **Competition Details**, found at schedule 1 to these Terms and Conditions.
  4. Entry is open to Australian residents who comply with the **competition entry conditions** found at item 2 of schedule 1, and who are not employees, or the immediate families of employees, of the Promoter, the Department of Industry, Science, and Resources, or any of the related portfolio agencies.
  5. To enter the Competition, you (the Entrant) must complete all the **competition requirements** listed in item 3 of schedule 1, and entries must be received by the Promoter before the **specified closing date/time** listed in item 4 of schedule 1.
  6. Those Entrants who are to win a **prize**, listed in item 6 of schedule 1, under the Competition (Prize-Winners) will be selected on the **competition judging date** listed in item 1 of schedule 1. Prize-Winners may be contacted by phone or email on the **competition judging date** and may be announced on the Promoter's website(s) or social media channels.
  7. The judges' decision is final and binding. No further changes will be considered or made to the judges' decision after the **competition judging date**.
  8. The Competition is a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each valid entry will be individually judged (by representatives of the Promoter) based on the originality and creativity provided in the entry, in accordance with the **judging criteria** listed in item 7 of schedule 1.
  9. All expenses incurred in entering the Competition are the responsibility of the Entrant.
  10. If any prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or similar value.
  11. Prize-Winners are advised that tax implications may arise from accepting a prize and may wish to seek independent financial advice prior to the acceptance of the prize. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any financial implications to any Entrant suffered as a result of entering the Competition.

12. If for any reason a Prize-Winner does not take the prize or an element of the prize by the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize or that element of the prize will be forfeited.
  13. Prizes are not redeemable for cash, credit or product and no exchanges are offered. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the prize (or part thereof).
  14. Prizes will be sent to the delivery address provided by the Prize-Winner. Please allow up to 28 days for delivery of prizes from the **competition judging date**. The Promoter takes no responsibility for prizes damaged or lost in transit and the Promoter will not be responsible for any delay in delivery, damage to or loss in transit of the prize.
  15. **Privacy Act 1988 collection notice:** The Promoter is required to comply with the requirements of the *Privacy Act 1988* in collecting, using and disclosing personal information. In submitting an entry, Entrants consent to the collection, use and disclosure of personal information, including sensitive information, contained in the entry. The Promoter will collect personal information, including the name, residential and work address, email address and phone number of the Entrant (or their parent or guardian if under 18). The Promoter will also collect voice recordings and photographic images/likeness of Prize-Winners. On completion of the competition, personal information of Prize-Winners may also be used for the purpose of administering marketing, publicising and promoting the competition. If this personal information is not provided, the Promoter will not be able to accept entry into the Competition.   18. All entries submitted to the Promoter for the purpose of the Competition (the Entries), become the property of the Promoter. Entrants warrant that entry content is original, lawful and not misleading and that the Promoter's use of such content will not infringe the rights of any third parties. As a condition of entering this Competition, Prize-Winners agree to assign all copyright and other intellectual property rights in their entry to the Promoter. No amount is payable to the Prize-Winners in connection with the assignment of intellectual property rights or the Promoter's use of their entries. The Promoter has no obligation to credit Prize-Winners as the author of any content submitted and may otherwise do any acts or omissions which would otherwise constitute an infringement of any moral rights Prize-Winners may have as an author of content.
  19. All Prize-Winners agree to the use of their name and photograph for publicity and Competition purposes, without compensation.
  20. The Competition is governed by the laws of the Australian Capital Territory.
  21. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any Entrant who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached the Competition Terms and Conditions, including copyright infringement, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition. The Promoter reserves its legal right to recover damages or other compensation from such an Entrant.
  22. If for any reason the Competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process or to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
  23. In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests,

natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the event and recommence it from the start on the same conditions at a later date.
