PROCEDURAL ORDER  
(Early-filed Petition to  
Intervene)

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On May 26, 2022, under 35-A M.R.S. § 307, Central Maine Power Company (CMP) filed a Notice of Intent to file for an increase in distribution rates. In that filing, CMP identified a proposed rate effective date of July 30, 2023. CMP has not yet filed its rate case, and no Notice of Proceeding has been issued setting a deadline for intervention. On June 27, 2022, Industrial Energy Consumer Group (IECG) filed a Petition to Intervene (Petition).


When issued, the Notice of Proceeding will include a deadline for interventions and a deadline for objections to any interventions. Until that time, no action need be taken by CMP or any others with regard to the IECG's Petition, or to any other early-filed Petition to Intervene.


