Our current energy regulations require all TEP consumers to pay for growth in our energy grid, regardless of where that growth comes from or who benefits from it. Thus, Project Blue will massively increase the electric bills of all residents using TEP, even though it may not benefit them significantly or at all. I believe that the ACC should require all businesses (including the proposed Project Blue Data Centers) to either provide all their own energy and water, or pay for the total cost of the expansion and maintenance of all infrastructure and other accommodations necessary for the ongoing delivery of the hugely increased amount of electricity and water they will require.
