NOTICE OF DOCKETING AND SUSPENDING TARIFF

On April 28, 2025, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) filed a proposed tariff with the Utilities Commission (Commission) in the above-entitled docket.

Pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.6(1), a public utility subject to rate regulation shall not make effective a new or changed rate, charge, schedule or regulation until the rate, charge, schedule, or regulation has been approved by the Commission, except as provided in Iowa Code §§ 476.6(8) and (9). Pursuant to Iowa Code § 476.6(4), after the filing of an application for new or changed rates, charges, schedules, or regulations by a public utility subject to rate regulation, the Commission, prior to the expiration of 30 days after the filing date, shall docket the case as a formal proceeding and set the case for hearing unless the new or changed rates, charges, schedules, or regulations are approved or rejected by the Commission.
