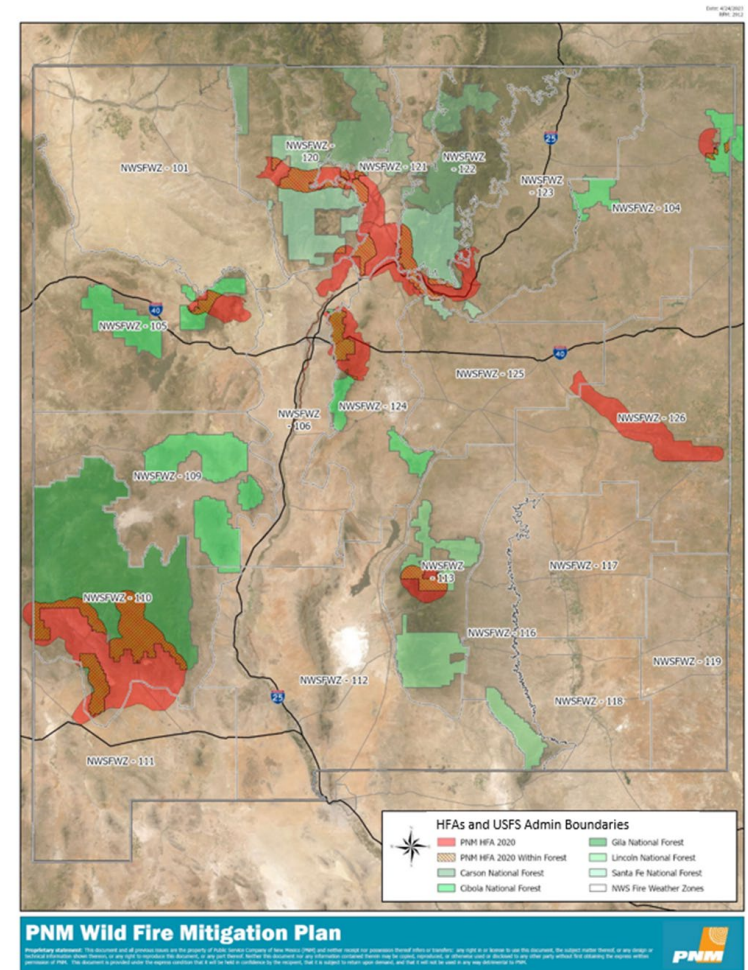

ESTABLISHING HIGH FIRE-RISK AREAS (HFA)

OBJECTIVES

- PNM conducted detailed analyses of service territory using USFS Wildfire Hazard Potential, Wildland Urban Interface, vegetation density maps, and climate models to identify HFAs.
- PNM uses wildfire risk assessments to guide and prioritize infrastructure upgrades.
- Infrastructure inspections and upgrades completed contribute to risk reduction and asset management.



ENHANCED VEGETATION MANAGEMENT

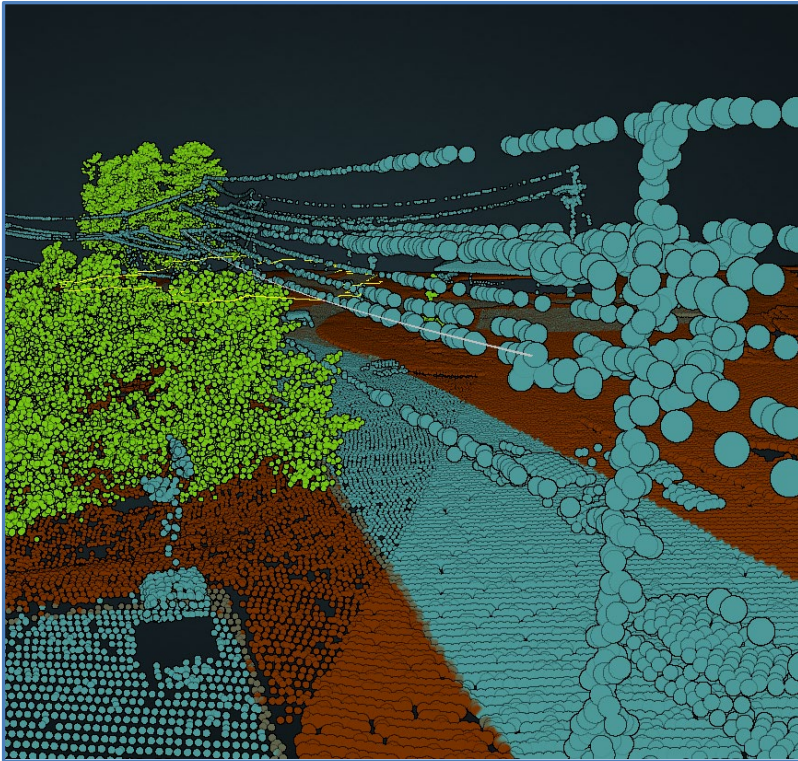
OVERVIEW

- Conducting annual inspection of power line corridors in HFAs.
- Leveraging satellite-based AI product to identify hazard trees
- Collaborating with Gila NF on widened right of ways from 20' to 40'.
Working Cibola and Santa Fe NFs on similar program.
- Working with customer and communities on how to better identify and communicate tree-related encroachment.



ROBUST ASSET MANAGEMENT

OVERVIEW

Rigorous schedules for:

- Remote sensing inspections in HFAs on annual basis.
- Groundline testing and treatment of 64,000 wood poles and virtual aerial inspection to identify defects.
- Infrared inspections on critical substations.

SITUATIONAL AWARENESS AND OPERATIONAL PROTOCOLS

OVERVIEW

- Real-time weather monitoring through various weather data providers.
 - Installing strategically located PNM owned weather stations.
 - Installing fire detection cameras (benefits increase significantly as data is shared with other agencies for notification).
- Disable automatic reclosing during Red Flag warnings
- Implemented "fast trip" protection schemes.
- Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS): De-energization of lines during extreme fire weather, including enhanced customer notification and full infrastructure inspection before restoration.

SYSTEM HARDENING AND TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATIONS

OVERVIEW OF WORK IN HFA



- Replacing wood transmission poles with steel structures.
- Higher structural standards for new distribution poles.
- Replacing oil-filled with non-oil filled reclosers.
- Replacing all open wire secondary with covered wire.
- Replacing expulsion fuses with non-expulsion.
- Increasing number of line sectionalizing devices.
- Distributed sensors for early fault detection.
- Selective undergrounding of distribution lines.
- Future state – evaluating use of microgrid options to improve resiliency.

STRATEGIES AND OBJECTIVES

- Ensure the safety of the general public and our communities.
- Model conditions to utilize in situations of **extreme** fire danger.
- Sectionalized HFAs to minimize the size of outage and customers affected.
- Provide accurate, timely, meaningful information and support to our customers to mitigate the impact of an outage.
- Provide early notification to emergency managers and community leaders to prepare for potential of outages and to ensure community resources are identified and available.
- Utilizing all local resources, local contractors, and mutual aid partners to minimize duration of event.
- Safety is the primary focus with an emphasis on Customer Service.

PUBLIC SAFETY POWER SHUTOFF

DECISION PROCESS

Evaluate: High Fire-Risk Area forecast indicates potential threat of wildfire. PNM wildfire team briefings begin to assess risk and customer impact.

Mobilization: High Fire-Risk Area forecast continues to indicate potential threat of wildfire. PNM notifies customers within High Fire-Risk Area and emergency managers and first responders.

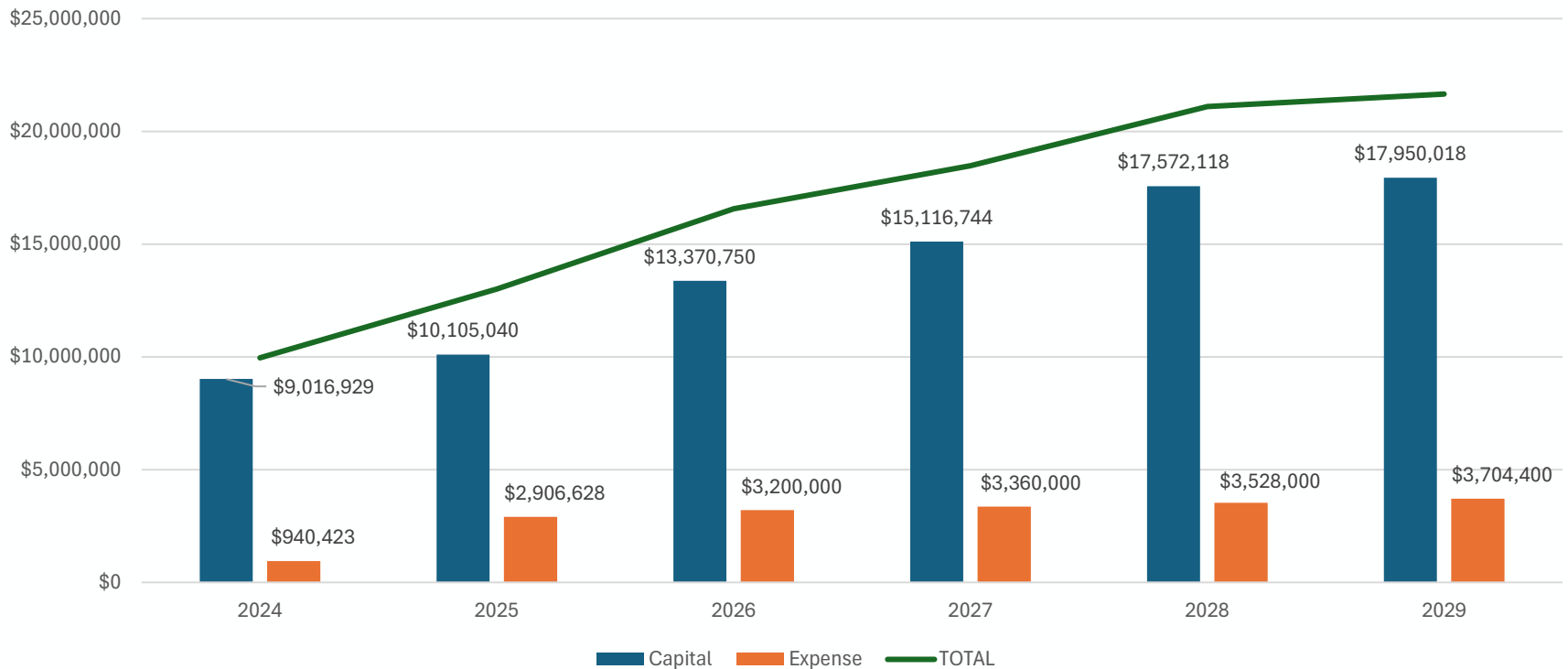
De-Energization: PNM activates Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) isolated to as few customers as possible.

Restoring: When weather returns to safe conditions, PNM begins restoration.

CHALLENGES AND NEEDS

- Based on the inherently disruptive nature of power outages and the year-round threat of wildfire, PNM must balance the risk of fire in our communities versus the impact of a preemptive outage to our customers.
- Escalating capital and O&M expenses are putting upward pressure on rates. Collaboration is very valuable.
- In New Mexico, wildfire risks affect everyone. Working collaboratively with community partners, public agencies, and private landowners to help reduce the wildfire threat and protect our communities.

If extreme weather makes a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) necessary, we will notify you in advance whenever possible:

- **4-7 days ahead:** Monitoring extreme weather forecasts. Notifying local and tribal governments, emergency officials, hospitals, and first responders.
- **2-3 days ahead:** Notifying customers via social media, PNM.com and local news.
- **1 day ahead:** Directly notifying potentially affected customers via PNM emergency alerts.
- **0-4 hours ahead:** Providing customers alerts before power is shut off.
