This includes considerable expenses for gas, generators, ice, ice chests, and the physical help needed to bring these necessities.

We bought this camp with the intention of enjoying God's beauty and incredible nature of Dularge. It's still so beautiful, but the constant and loud hums of camp generators were never a part of that dream.
