**Procedural Order Re: Proposed Procedural Schedule**

In accordance with the supplemental order of notice that the Commission issued on July 17, 2025, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource) filed a proposed procedural schedule. Eversource stated that the Office of the Consumer Advocate had no position regarding the proposed procedural schedule, which is supported by the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE) and the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire.

The Commission waives New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Puc 203.07(c), *see* N.H. Admin. R., Puc 203.01(a), and APPROVES the proposed procedural schedule,<sup>1</sup> so that the current procedural schedule in this docket, which supersedes any existing conflicting deadlines, is as follows:



Parties' Testimony/Technical Statements	October 3, 2025
Technical Session/Settlement Conference	October 10, 2025

<sup>1</sup> To avoid conflicts with Commission hearings, the Commission notes the dates and times of technical sessions and settlement conferences contained in approved procedural schedules on its hearings calendar. It is recommended that these be scheduled on Mondays and Fridays, as Commission hearings are generally scheduled on the other days of the week. Therefore, it is requested that, in future, the parties note either the start and end times, or the start times and amount of time allotted. The Commission will schedule around the technical sessions and settlement conferences whenever possible.


