NOTICE is hereby given that an Environmental Impact
Statement will not be prepared in connection with the approval
by the Public Service Commission (the Commission) of the future
sales or purchases of transformers by New York State Electric &
Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation
(together, the Companies), as part of the participation of
Avangrid, Inc. in the Edison Electric Institute Spare
Transformer Equipment Program, based on the Commission's
determination, in accordance with Article VIII of the
Environmental Conservation Law, that such action will not have a
significant adverse effect on the environment. The exercise of
this approval constitutes an Unlisted action, as is defined in 6
NYCRR \$617.2(al).

Based on the Commission's review of the record, the Commission finds that the proposed action, which grants future authority to the Companies to sell or purchase transformers, will not have a significant adverse environmental impact.
