Request for Extension to Respond to Secretarial Letter dated April 12, 2025**

Dear Secretary Homsher:

On April 12, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") issued a Secretarial Letter regarding notice of an *En Banc* hearing concerning interconnection and tariffs for large load customers, M-2025-3054271, requesting testimony and comment on various related topics. There were fourteen (14) suggested topic areas as well as an invitation for "any other procedures, rules, or tariff designs that can facilitate the efficient and timely interconnection of this unique category of electric customers."


The *En Banc* hearing was held on April 24, 2025 and the Secretarial Letter provided for a 30-day comment period following the hearing, i.e., May 27, 2025. Reply comments were permitted fifteen days thereafter, i.e., June 11, 2025.

The Energy Association of Pennsylvania ("EAP") is a trade association whose members include the major natural gas and electric public utilities operating in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. EAP's electric distribution company members participated in and provided testimony during the *En Banc*.

EAP respectfully requests an extension of ten (10) days to respond to the above-captioned Secretarial Letter until June 6, 2025 to allow for further time to compile comments on the various

topics raised in the initial Secretarial Letter, during the *En Banc* hearing, and posed in Vice Chair Barrow's directed questions document filed on May 1, 2025. EAP asks that the reply comment period be extended as well to June 23, 2025. EAP asks that this extension be available to all interested parties and stakeholders.
