

The seven deadly sins have their origins in early Christianity and were first formulated in the 4th century. But it was not until the 13th century that the eminent theologian and philosopher Thomas Aquinas integrated them into Catholic moral teaching. The seven deadly sins are: pride, greed, lust, anger, gluttony, envy, and sloth. They are not considered concrete actions, but rather inner attitudes or vices that can distance people from God and lead to grave sin. In this series, we depart from the traditional, rather martial symbolism and choose animals that best represent each deadly sin. A possible surprise effect is entirely intentional.

The second edition of the series takes up the theme of gluttony, the excessive preoccupation with eating and drinking. What animal could be better suited to this than the panda bear? It spends an average of 14 hours a day eating bamboo, consuming up to 40 kg per day. Excess in its highest form. The panda thus becomes a symbol of "never getting enough." Yet it appears harmless, cute, and peaceful - which is precisely what makes the parallel so exciting: a deadly sin like gluttony often appears tempting, almost "innocent", even though it has destructive dimensions. This classic and colored coin is limited to only 999 pieces worldwide and is an ironic depiction of this deadly sin. Gluttony 2.0!

Tiger

The tiger is a global symbol of strength, courage, and independence. In many cultures, it is revered as the ruler of the forest, a creature that inspires both fear and awe. At the center of the coin is a fascinating portrait of a tiger, whose face is captured with flawless precision. The tiger's distinctiveness is highlighted by the exclusive, deep black obsidian finish. The artfully applied white accents highlight the characteristic stripes and bring the portrait to life.

Special attention is paid to the tiger's reflective eyes, which are both frightening and attractive. This effect gives the tiger a presence that captivates the viewer. The background of the coin features a relief structure that replicates the tiger's fur. This detail not only makes the coin aesthetically appealing but also reinforces its connection to nature. The combination of texture and shine gives the reverse side an extraordinary look and a distinctive character. The 1 oz smartminting® silver coin is limited to only 999 pieces worldwide.

With the "Peter the Great Egg", a magniunfolds with elegance and exquisite detail. and brilliant colors. Particularly impressive Winter Palace at the heart of the egg, which strikingly emphasizes the historical connection to Peter the Great. Enhanced with a proof finish and complemented by the gleaming inscription "Peter the Great", depth. With a relief height of around 2.2 mm and the characteristic reeded edge, this collector's item is not only a technical masterpiece of minting but also a tribute to the unmatched artistry of Peter Carl Fabergé. The original "Peter the Great Egg", created in 1903 for the Russian imperial Museum of Fine Arts in Richmond, Virginia. and its estimated value exceeds 20 million US dollars.

This is the sixth and final installment of this successful series. This time, it's all about Vikings. It is the story of Ragnar Lodbrok and his sons, Ivar the Boneless and Björn Ironside. Ragnar is said to have lived in the 9th century as a Viking king, adventurer, and plunderer who traveled as far as England and France. The nickname Lodbrok ("fur pants") is said to come from pants made of fur or clothes treated with tar, which protected him from snake bites. He is often portrayed as a fearless but also romantic hero. According to legend, he was captured by King Ælla of Northumbria and thrown into a snake pit, where he died. His sons then swore revenge. One of them was Ivar the Boneless, leader of the "Great Heathen Army". His name is thought to be because he may have suffered from brittle bone disease or another form of muscle weakness or paralysis. Despite his physical disability, he was a brilliant strategist and led the Vikings to one of the largest invasions of England.

His brother Björn "Ironside" probably got his name because of his invulnerability in battle or his armor. He was considered one of the bravest warriors and leaders among Ragnar's sons. He was less of a strategist like Ivar and more of a classic warrior hero, leading raids in the Frankish Empire, Spain, North Africa, and Italy. This coin impressively depicts all three figures in ultra-high relief. Their aggressive facial expressions and weapons clearly convey the message: we are ready for anything. The background pattern represents the sacred halls of Valhalla, a resting place for fallen warriors in Nordic mythology. The reverse shows Ivar the Boneless on his sailing boat. Thanks to smartminting® technology, the rough sea and inflated sails look absolutely realistic.

Petra is a world-famous archaeological site in southern Jordan, known for its rock-cut architecture and historical significance. The "rose-red city" – as it is often called because of the color of the sandstone – was founded around the 4th century BC by the Bedouin tribe of the Nabataeans and was an important trading center. The 40-meter-high treasury "Al-Khazneh" is considered the symbol of Petra. Petra has been a Unesco World Heritage Site since 1985 and was voted one of the "New Seven Wonders of the World" in 2007.

One eye-catching feature is certainly the open edge, which allows the special architectural form of the building, carved in stone 2,000 years ago, to be impressively depicted. You can see how realistically the sandstone and its surface are represented by the antique finish. Thanks to smartminting® technology, buildings appear to rise out of the rock, just as they do in reality. It is essentially an ultra-high relief with a depth effect. The coloring is also unique, and the shade created by the sun's rays has been reproduced extremely well. The artwork is rounded off by the reverse side, which shows a wavy carpet in Arabic style next to the national coat of arms. The coin in 5 oz silver is an outstanding combination of minting art and history, limited to only 500 pieces worldwide.



Grande Europe

The "Hidden Treasure - Grande Europe" coin takes collectors on an artistic journey across the continent, bringing together famous European landmarks in a captivating hidden object picture. This masterpiece combines art, history, and a playful spirit of discovery, while also harboring a special secret: a hidden cat that must be found - the mascot of this series. The coin features more than 20 European landmarks, masterfully designed in an antique finish with proof elements and elegant partial gold plating.

The interplay of these finishes creates a vivid 3D effect that draws the viewer's eye to new details again and again. Some of these details extend beyond the edge – a technical masterpiece in coin minting that gives the impression that the monuments extend beyond the boundaries of the design. Thanks to smartminting®, it combines masterful minting technology with a playful element, turning every discovery into a personal experience.
