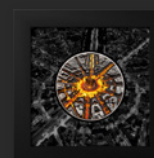

VILLE DE NUIT PARIS

Few roundabouts are as famous as the one at the Arc de Triomphe in Paris. It is considered one of the most chaotic and unusual traffic junctions in the world. Although it has a diameter of 240 meters, there are no lane markings, so cars move freely, or rather chaotically, within the space. This vibrant scene is particularly impressive at night. And it is precisely this pulsating magic of the Parisian night that the coin captures. A snapshot from a bird's-eye view. Like flashes of fire, the streets converge at the central point – the Arc de Triomphe – while the buildings are depicted in highly detailed and realistic side views. The accentuated depictions of the buildings form a dramatic contrast to the luminous, golden streets. This is only feasible thanks to the possibilities of smartminting® technology, which combines a black proof finish with partial gilding and a coloring. Each of the twelve avenues is individually labeled, and the coin's edge features the names of all 20 arrondissements of Paris in microminting. The 3 oz silver coin is limited to only 500 pieces worldwide.



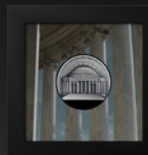

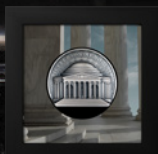
This is the magnificent final issue in the successful series. It pays tribute to the Jefferson Memorial, a majestic monument in Washington, D.C., built in honor of Thomas Jefferson, the third president of the United States and author of the Declaration of Independence. The monument's classical architecture, inspired by the timeless beauty of Roman architecture, features an imposing dome and elegant columns reminiscent of the Pantheon in Rome. These venerable walls were built between 1939 and 1943, and inside them sits an imposing statue of Jefferson, surrounded by quotations from his speeches and writings – a powerful symbol of his vision of democracy, freedom, and human rights.

CHINGGIS KHAAN

1 OZ SILVER



These releases are entirely dedicated to the extraordinary personality of the legendary ruler Chinggis Khaan. He appears enthroned and powerful in meticulous detail. His posture, the finely rendered folds of his robes, and the elaborate ornamentation of his throne demonstrate the highest precision of modern high-relief striking. A special reference to the historical model: The monumental statue of Chinggis Khaan, on which this motif is based, measures an impressive 700 × 630 × 750 cm. It depicts Chinggis Khaan in his youth in 1189, at the beginning of the rise of the Great Mongol Empire and is entirely covered in Mongolian gold. The imperial throne bears the golden seal of the empire and rests on a multi-part pedestal of marble, bronze, and gold, the design of which is inspired by the sacred Mount Burkan-Khaldun. The three-tiered base symbolizes the past, present, and future. The depiction is complemented by a tiger skin, emblematic of victory, and a white felt carpet, representing the enduring power of the state. This extraordinary work was ceremonially unveiled on March 1st, 2025.

In the background of the coin, radiant sunbeams spread out, symbolizing both power and enlightenment. The surrounding landscape complements the venerable motif by depicting the mountains and plains that once formed Chinggis Khaan's empire. The front depicts a majestic eagle – the classic hunting animal of Mongolian culture. In Mongolia, the eagle symbolizes strength, courage, freedom, and cultural heritage. Particularly in western Mongolia, this significance is embodied by the centuries-old tradition of eagle trapping and hunting with golden eagles – a connection between humans and animals based on respect, symbiosis, and a deep spiritual bond with nature.

The coin combines this iconic image with a vast landscape of the Mongolian steppe, which appears as a fine relief in the background, anchoring the animal in its natural habitat. A particular highlight is the radially arranged guilloché pattern, which harmoniously surrounds the Mongol Bank's coat of arms. A finely polished surface finish creates an impressive lustrous effect: the sun's rays seem to burst forth from the center, lending the scene an almost sacred radiance. The coins will be released in three different sizes: a 1 oz silver issue with a mintage of 1500 pieces, a 1 oz gold issue with 100 pieces, and a 0.5 g gold issue with a mintage of 2026 pieces.

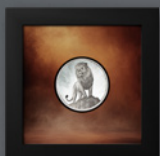

SEVEN DEADLY SINS

PRIDE

The third installment of the series is dedicated to pride – that deadly sin often considered in Christian tradition to be the origin of all other vices. Pride signifies an exaggerated sense of self-importance, the feeling of being above things and above other people. One animal embodies this attitude like almost no other: the lion. With its majestic appearance, its natural dominance, and the aura of absolute superiority, it has always been a symbol of pride and royalty. It is precisely this natural grandeur that makes the deadly sin so subtle. Pride doesn't manifest itself loudly or aggressively, but often dignifiedly, confidently, and with control – and yet it is dangerous. For those who elevate themselves too much easily lose sight of reality and humility. This third edition also appears as a classic, colored coin and is limited to only 999 pieces worldwide. An impressive yet ironic depiction of a deadly sin as old as humanity itself. Pride 2.0!

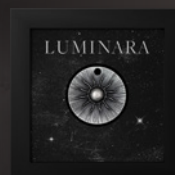
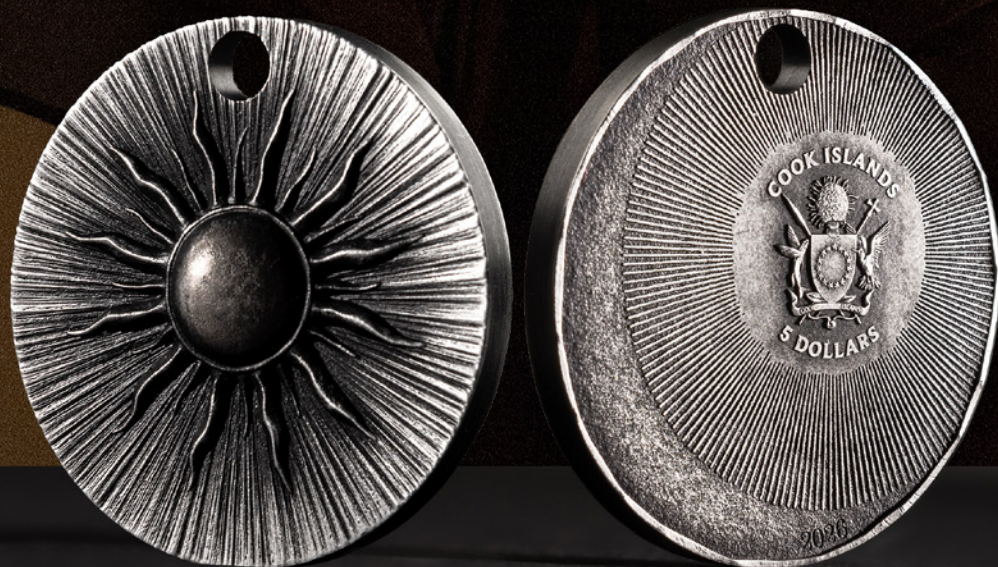

TALISMAN LUMINARA

The sun, moon, and stars have always held profound significance for humanity. They represent time, cycles, change, and the connection to the universe. Luminara presents a unique coin that captures precisely this origin: a modern talisman inspired by ancient traditions. The obverse side depicts a radiant sun, its energetic rays powerfully radiating outwards. The fine texture of the metal gives the light an almost pulsating effect, making the amulet a tangible symbol of hope and vitality. The reverse side incorporates the light motif in a deliberately minimalist design: On the left appears a curved crescent moon, symbolizing the balance between shadow and light, between calm and energy. A special detail is the opening at the edge of the coin. This allows Luminara Talisman not only to be collected but also worn as a personal amulet. Whether on a chain, a leather cord, or as a constant companion in everyday life – this talisman was created to keep you moving and to carry its symbolic power with you. This special amulet with the new dark antique finish is limited to only 1500 pieces worldwide.

Sometimes a single movement is enough to express enormous power. The design of this extraordinary coin is inspired by the Japanese painting “The Great Wave off Kanagawa,” the famous woodblock print from the 19th century. It fascinates with its striking interplay of deep black obsidian and the artfully crafted lines of a wave. Thanks to the innovative nanoshine effect, the curved shapes now appear even more vivid, reflecting light in subtle nuances and giving the wave an almost flowing dynamism.

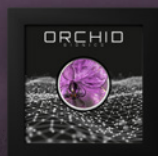

The orchid has been prized for centuries as the epitome of beauty, elegance, and rare strength. With Bionics - Orchid, this natural allure is impressively translated into modern coin art. The centerpiece of the design is the artful coloring, which brings the blossom to life in radiant, metallic shimmering shades of violet and lilac. Every ray of light reveals new facets, making the surface appear like a living work of art. Another outstanding feature is the polygonal structure, which lies like a fine, geometric net over the petals. These low poly elements lend the coin a modern, crystalline aesthetic and create a captivating interplay of natural form and precise geometry. This edition is limited to 999 pieces.



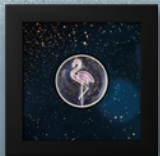

LINE ART Flamingo

This modern coin was designed in the Art Deco style. It is characterized by geometric simplification, decorative patterns, and special coloring. At the center of the coin is a highly stylized flamingo with a pink silhouette. To emphasize the elegance of the issue, it is completely covered with enamel. This stylistic element is complemented by integrated gold flakes, which seem to float in the enamel, giving the coin a luxurious, decorative appearance. Together, these elements create a contrasting, modern work of art.

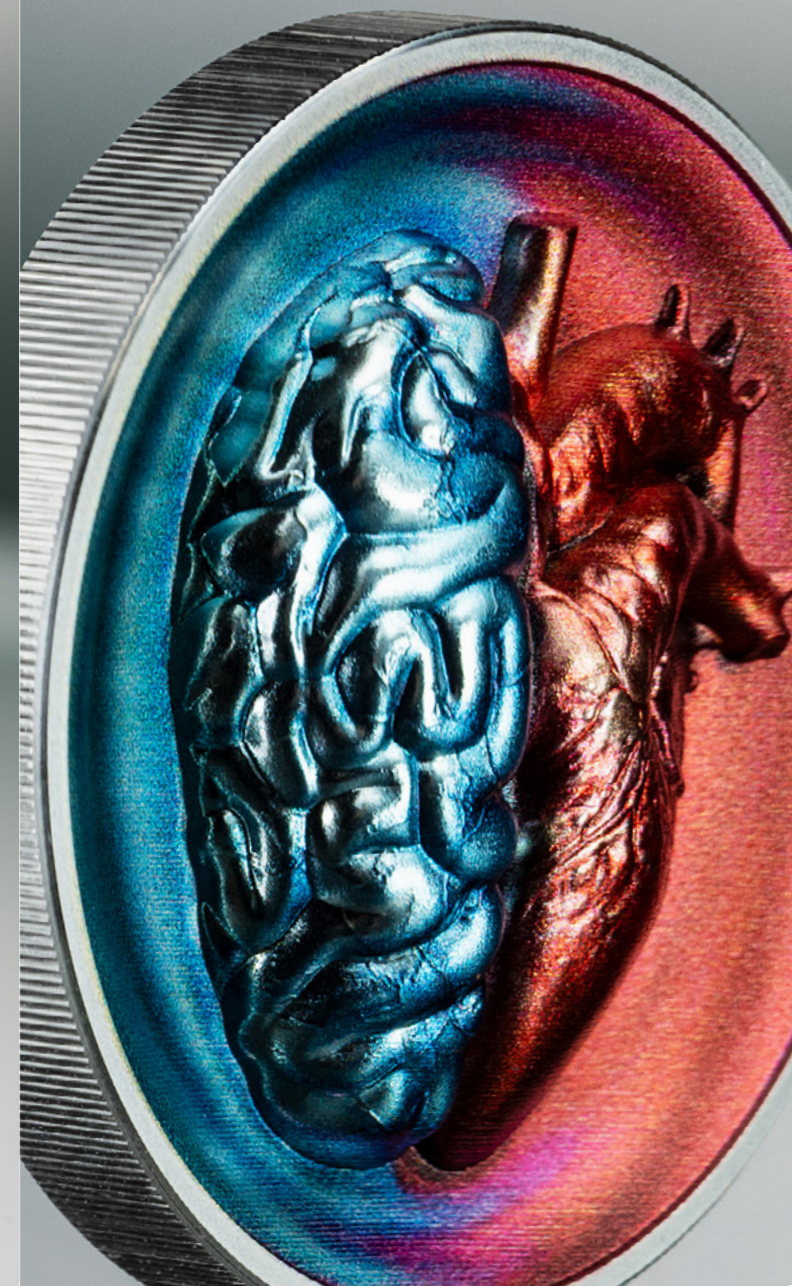
HEAD vs HEART

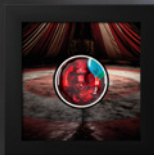

PHOBIAS COULROPHOBIA

This is the third issue in our series on phobias. This coin is dedicated to coulrophobia – the fear of clowns. Those affected often react with discomfort, panic, or strong avoidance behavior as soon as they see clowns or even think about them. But why is that? On the one hand, the heavily made-up face with its fixed, artificial smile often appears threatening, as the actual emotions are not recognizable. In addition, the unpredictable, loud behavior and the often-frightening portrayals in horror movies can reinforce this fear. As a result, many people associate clowns with danger rather than fun. All these aspects are impressively captured in this stunning 2 oz silver coin. The ultra-high relief is covered with enamel and highlighted with intense coloring. The clown seems to be waiting to step out of the coin, which is limited to only 555 pieces.

TIFFANY ART PORTALS Milan x Prague

This is the first issue in the new direction of our legendary Tiffany series. Each coin in this extraordinary collection tells a story – of architecture, craftsmanship, and timeless beauty. The focus is on famous portals, which as architectural masterpieces, are perfectly suited to delicate representation on coins. What makes this series special, however, is that each coin combines two impressive portals. The first issue features the majestic main façade of Milan Cathedral on the reverse, while the obverse shows the entrance to St. Ludmila Church in Prague. A dazzling connecting element is the green Tiffany glass, which symbolizes the open portals on both sides and brings them to life with magical luminosity. But it is not only the artistic design that makes this coin unique.

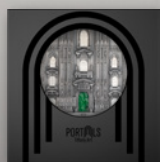

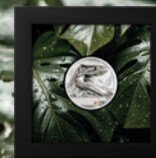

JURASSIC RELICS CARCHARODONTOSAURUS

Carcharodontosaurus was one of the largest carnivorous dinosaurs that ever lived on earth. Its name means “shark-toothed lizard”. It got this name because its teeth were similar to the teeth of a great white shark. This dinosaur lived about 100 to 93 million years ago. With a length of approximately 12 to 13 meters and a weight of up to 8 tons, Carcharodontosaurus was an impressive top predator. Unlike many well-known dinosaurs, Carcharodontosaurus was not well researched until relatively late. Fossils found at the beginning of the 20th century were lost during World War II. It was only new discoveries in the 1990s that helped to find out more about this dinosaur. Carcharodontosaurus did not live at the same time as the famous Tyrannosaurus rex. There is a gap of around 25 to 30 million years between the two, so they could never have encountered each other. Nevertheless, Carcharodontosaurus is often compared to T-Rex because of its size and dangerousness. Each of the 999 limited edition ultra-high relief coins contains a genuine tooth fragment – in this case, from the razor-sharp tooth of a Carcharodontosaurus.
