Crown

In classic antiquity, crowns served as a reward for prowess and a sign of honour and dominion. Athletes, poets, and successful warriors were awarded crown-like wreaths of different forms whereas chiefs of barbarian tribes customarily wore distinctive helmets. In the earliest English coronation ritual, dating back more than 1000 years, the king was invested with a helmet instead of a crown. Today, crowns continue to be part of the court ceremony in certain countries and enchant many a spectator.

One Noble

The Noble coins have been issued by the Isle of Man since the early 1980s. Despite their world-wide popularity, they have not been minted every year. This adds to the appeal of the coins, as earlier issues are difficult to acquire. For the 2022 issue, we were privileged to further develop the Noble, updating it with its first change to the original design since its introduction in 1983. Due to the enthusiastic response of our customers to last year's edition, we now present the 2023 release in splendid proof with the portrait of King Charles on the obverse.





Vault

Vaults are an integral part of the building in which they are located, with armoured walls and a door secured with complex locks, they hold the items we find most precious. Historically, vaults were built in the basements of banks where the ceilings were vaulted, hence the name. Nowadays they are also common in other buildings where valuables are kept, such as post offices, grand hotels, rare book libraries and certain government ministries. During its beginnings, vault technology evolved into an arms race with bank robbers. 
hazel brown




Second Skin


First Ascent

Mount Everest

The world's highest mountain had remained unknown to western society until 1852, when surveyors discovered it during the charting of India. Identified as the highest mountain in the world, Mt. Everest became a subject of interest during the golden age of alpinism and thereafter. Prior to the British Mount Everest expedition of 1953, roughly 10 expeditions had failed on the mountain since 1921. The incredible triumph of the successful first ascent of Mt. Everest is claimed by Tenzing Norgay and Edmund Hillary, who reached the world's highest peak on May 29, 1953.
