

Alcatraz

Alcatraz Island was originally explored as a seabird habitat in 1775 by Lieutenant Juan Manuel de Ayala. He named it Isla de los Alcatraces meaning Isle of the Pelicans.

During the Civil War, 1861-1865, a prisoner of war camp was erected on the island. Serving as a federal prison from 1934 to 1963, Alcatraz held some of the United States' most notorious criminals, such as Al Capone, George "Machine Gun" Kelly and Robert Stroud, also known as the "Birdman of Alcatraz". Upon its closure, it became and remains a popular tourist attraction.


Roses






Four Leaf Clover





Having successfully launched silver editions in 2020/21, we now proudly present the antique finish gold versions of the Tortoise and Athena's Owl. The Tortoise, a slow and steady creature embodied the idea of lasting power, making it a popular choice for coinage in Ancient Greece. Allegedly, the tortoise was first minted on currency coins manufactured on the island of Aegina. The Athenian Owl, renamed after the Greek goddess of wisdom, is arguably the most popular and recognized ancient coin. The owl evolved into the Athenians' own icon and graced a large variety of coins, such as the tetradrachm, from as early as the 5th century BC.

Scarab


Cheops

Back for the 3rd time, our «Scarab» series pays tribute to the significant personalities of Ancient Egypt. The 2023 issue honours the creator of a wonder of the world, whose work remains a marvel to this day. Khufu, best known by his Greek name Cheops, was the 2nd pharaoh of the 4th Dynasty, ruling during the 3rd millennium BC. He began work on the Great Pyramid of Giza almost immediately after assuming the throne. Estimated to have taken over 20 years to build, it was the tallest manmade structure in the world for over 3,800 years. Adorned with a glistening yellow crystal, the latest edition unveils the pharaoh's birth name as well as his throne name in hieroglyphic form.










In ancient times, various cities chose symbols for their coinage that represented the founding mythology, a pun on the city's name, a characteristic feature of the economy or the city's devotion to a particular deity. One such figure was Pan, the god of the wild, shepherds and flocks. Often associated with fertility and depicted in bestial form. Originally worshipped in Arcadia, his name derives from paon, meaning pasturer, and with pan, meaning all. Another example is Ephesos, an ancient Greek city located on the western coast of present-day Turkey. Ephesos was a significant centre of worship for the Greek goddess Artemis. The motifs on the city's coins, such as the bee, reflect this fact clearly. Lastly, Naxos, the earliest Greek colony in Sicily, located south of present-day Taormina. It is of high probability Greek immigrants brought their fondness for wine growing and worship of the god Dionysos from their Greek homeland, the island of Naxos, to Italy.







Evolution of Life

Nimravidae

The inspiring 9th edition of the unparalleled «Evolution of Life» series delights with this outstanding addition of a truly remarkable specimen from a bygone era. The Nimravidae, a prehistoric feline family including the depicted genus Hoplophoneus, flourished during the Palaeogene.

Also known as false sabre-toothed cats, these mammals were fearsome predators. Muscular bodies, razor-sharp claws, and elongated canines led to an impressive arsenal of tools for hunting their prey. These terrors likely roamed the ancient woodlands and grasslands of North and South America, Europe, Asia and Africa.





Eclectic Nature

Chameleon

Eclecticism is the combination or mixing of different styles, theories or ideas in order to gain complementary knowledge on a subject. The term comes from the Greek eklektikos, "to choose the best", and that from eklektos, "picked out, select". We have embraced this approach of choosing only the best for our 2nd edition of the «Eclectic Nature» series.

The veiled chameleon is a remarkable species that hails from the arid regions of Yemen and Saudi Arabia. The most notable feature is a large, elaborate bony protrusion atop its head, which is called a casque. Both males and females sport this fancy headgear, which allegedly serves to channel water droplets down into the reptiles' mouths, a crucial adaptation in their dry habitats.





The Vexed Man





Frankenstein

Ferryman of the Dead

Charon

Charon, who resided in the Greek Underworld, was burdened with the duty of being the ferryman of the dead, crossing the newly departed over the river Acheron. To secure passage, the deceased had to pay Charon's fee, such as an obolos or Persian denace, which ensured that proper funeral rites had been performed. Those unable to pay would haunt Acheron's banks for a century as ghosts. Although commonly linked to the River Styx, Charon's task primarily pertained to the river Acheron. The association with the Styx, leading to Hades' realm, was a later addition to the myth, as it was the most famous river of the Greek underworld.


