







The Cliff

Pompe

Pompeii was a flourishing ancient Roman city near modern-day Naples in Italy that was destroyed by the eruption of the volcano Vesuvius in 79 AD. The eruption buried the city under a thick layer of ash, pumice and lava, leaving it virtually untouched for centuries. This impressive coin shows exactly this tragic moment of the eruption. On one side is Vesuvius, depicted in relief almost 10 mm high thanks to the smartminting® 4.0 technique. You can clearly see the deadly lava flows making their way into the city depicted at the foot of the volcano. Two gladiators fighting in the nearby arena have no idea of the threat that is inexorably approaching. This coin is an impressive snapshot, both historically and above all, technically.



New York

You have never seen Times Square like this before. Not on a coin, that's for sure. This is undoubtedly the most famous place in Manhattan, captured in all its glory with a fisheye lens. This is a very special perspective. The inverted shape of the coin, combined with the ultra-deep relief, enhances this effect. The delicate colorization creates an impressive contrast to the sky, which reflects it like a mirror. In that moment, this hectic place is transformed into a peaceful oasis.

The coin features a highly detailed section of the original city map with polished streets as a contrast, the defining look of the series. The city's most important buildings, such as the White House and the Capitol, are depicted in ultra-high relief. The renowned Potomac River and the Anacostia River are depicted on this coin through an integrated Tiffany glass piece. The obverse side features the Arlington Memorial Bridge, which was opened in 1932 and symbolizes the unity between the North and South of the USA after the Civil War.

A samurai was a member of the warrior class in feudal Japan who played a central role in Japanese society from around the 12th to the 19th century. They wore special armor and were the best experts in the use of weapons, especially the katana, a curved long sword that was considered a symbol of their class. Today, they stand for discipline, honor and martial arts worldwide. This ultra-high relief coin shows in an extraordinary way the intricate details of the armor and the determined, fearsome look of the fighter, making him a very real opponent. And all in proof quality and with partial nanoshine elements.

Matterhorn 2 Kilo Editio







The Matterhorn, with its almost perfectly symmetrical pyramid peak, is one of the most famous mountains in the world. It is a challenge even for the most experienced mountaineers and has claimed the lives of more than 500 climbers. At a height of 4,478 meters (14,692 feet), it is one of the highest peaks in the Alps and Europe. It was not conquered until 1865, when a group led by Edward Whymper reached the summit. This coin tells the exciting and tragic story of the first ascent – with many details.

The coin's edge is engraved with Edward Whymper's famous quote from the summit: «At 1.40 p.m. the world was at our feet, and the Matterhorn was conquered. Hurrah! Not a footstep could be seen.» 4 of the 7 members of the team lost their lives on the descent. In their memory, these fearless men are immortalized on the reverse. This impressive, numbered 2 kg coin with a diameter of 140 mm is limited to only 50 pieces worldwide.

The coin features an exclusive coloration and an impressive relief of 14 mm on the reverse and 5 mm on the obverse, made possible by the innovative smartminting® technique. And the coin is only 12 mm thick. You can almost hear the wind howling around its massive structure.
