Our sixth issue in the «Numismatic Icons» series is adorned with a beautiful lion, which stands for the animal of the god Apollo. Apollo was not only the god of the arts, healing and light, but also the patron god of the colonies. The majestic lion stands for strength, protection and divine guidance. This coin highlights the significance of Leontini – an ancient Greek city located in Sicily – as an agricultural hub and underscores the colony's close ties to Apollo. The lion as a symbol of the god emphasizes the divine patronage over the colony, while the grain of barley points to the prosperity and fertility of the region. The CI numerals follow the tradition of ancient Greek coinage to indicate the respective place of origin. As usual, the edition includes three fantastic specifications in silver and gold.




Bison 2 oz Silver Black Proof
