The seven deadly sins originated in early Christianity and were first formulated in the 4th century. However, it was not until the 13th century that the important theologian and philosopher Thomas Aquinas integrated them into Catholic moral teaching. The seven deadly sins are: Pride, Avarice, Lust, Wrath, Gluttony, Envy and Sloth. They are not regarded as concrete actions, but as inner attitudes or vices that distance people from God and can lead to serious sin.

The first issue of the series takes up the topic of wrath and presents it in a rather unconventional way. We abandon the traditional, rather martial symbolism and choose animals that best represent the respective mortal sin. A possible surprise effect is definitely intentional! We start with a classic and colored coin that shows an angry bull running towards the viewer. Not a moment you would like to experience in reality. Wrath 2.0!

Rhino

This is already the 5th issue in this successful series. The latest issue once again shows an impressive animal that is one of the Big 5 and virtually explodes on this coin. The species depicted is a white rhinoceros, which can be recognized by the two horns. This species is the largest rhinoceros species alive today and lives mainly in the savannahs and grasslands of Africa. An adult specimen can grow up to four meters long and weigh around 1.8 tons. It is a herbivore and feeds almost exclusively on grass. Unlike many other rhino species, it is relatively sociable and often lives in small groups. Due to intensive poaching, particularly for its horns, the white rhino is highly endangered.

Thanks to smartminting® technology, the rhino appears very realistic. Just look at the small but fine eye. The shards even reach the edge of the coin. In addition, some of them are either polished or dark textured, which gives an even better idea of the rhino's original appearance.




Dunescape





Machu Picchu

In this issue, we discover the next place on our bucket list. Machu Picchu is a famous Inca ruined city in the Andes of Peru. It was built in the 15th century under the Inca ruler Pachacútec and lies at an altitude of around 2430 meters. At that time, the Inca Empire stretched from present-day Ecuador to Chile and was therefore as long as the United States is wide today. As the Incas had no written language, the answer remains a mystery to this day. The site is known for its impressive architecture, its terraced buildings and its harmonious integration into the surrounding mountain landscape. No mortar was used in the construction of the buildings. Instead, the individual stones were placed with absolute precision. This allowed them to move even in the event of an earthquake and prevented major damage. This is one of the reasons why the buildings have survived so well to this day. Abandoned after 100 years, it remained hidden until rediscovered by Hiram Bingham in 1911. Today it is an Unesco World Heritage Site and a top tourist destination.
