Prior to the launch of our Ambulatory Model, for all eligible* newly hired or unvaccinated staff members and newly admitted, ambulatory residents, we are now offering COVID-19 vaccinations in select CVS retail locations by appointment.

The vaccine comes at no cost to the patient. Residents or employees can schedule an in-store appointment online by following these simple steps:

- **STEP 1:** visit [CVS.com/COVIDvaccine](https://www.cvs.com/COVIDvaccine) using your web browser.
- **STEP 2:** scroll down to select the state or territory where you reside.
- **STEP 3:** Review information to confirm eligibility. Then click the link that reads "Schedule an appointment now."
- **STEP 4:** Answer a series of questions to determine eligibility and select your appointment(s). If needed, you'll be able to schedule both doses at this time.
- **STEP 5:** Once complete, you'll be sent a confirmation text message and email. We'll also send you reminders ahead of your appointment.
