
# 1 Safety instructions

- First check that cable and housings are not damaged. If this is the case, do not use the radio remote control unit, but take it back to your retailer for replacement.
- Please ensure that children don't play with the radio remote control unit.
- Radio signals can penetrate walls and ceilings.
   Use the remote control only in the same room in which the adjustable bed is located.


# 2 Setting Up:

### 2.1 Batteries




 Insert the batteries into the compartment of the Radio transmitter (2.1).
 3 x AAA batteries.
 Ensure correct polarity of the batteries.

# 2.2 Connecting



- Connect the receiver to the bed adjustment motor (2.2).
- Connect the mains plug of the adjustment motor to the mains power socket (2.2)

# 2.3 Teach-in procedure




- · Press both buttons for approx. 3 seconds
- Carry out teach-in procedure (2.3).

  Press buttons (A) and (B) together for approx. 3 seconds.

  Procedure (2.3).
  - Button (B) for teach-in mode is located next to the cable on the receiver. Do not use the emergency lowering button which is on the opposite side to button (B) and cable on the receiver unit.
- Now the radio remote control unit is ready for use.




### **Radio Transmitter handset**

Please use the buttons 1 - 6. As long as one of these buttons is pressed, the bed adjustment motor works.




