<b>PET RESTRICTIONS</b>	Not specified in state statute.
<b>WATER SUPPLY</b>	Not specified in state statute.
<b>HANDWASHING</b>	Not specified in state statute; covered by food safety course.
<b>FOOD STORAGE</b>	Not specifically regulated.

Chambers County is a rural county in east Alabama near the Georgia border. State law governs cottage food. No county-level overrides found.

## State context — Alabama cottage food law

Chambers County’s rules sit on top of Alabama’s state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Ala. Code §22-20-5.1

Yes (specific course)

### KITCHEN INSPECTION

No

### DIRECT SALES ONLY

Yes

### INDIRECT SALES

No — Indirect sales to grocery stores, restaurants, or wholesale are not permitted; producers may use an agent for delivery but cannot sell through retailers.
