FOOD STORAGE	Non-TCS (non-temperature controlled) foods only; standard sanitary storage

Inspection & permitting

INSPECTION REQUIRED	Upon-complaint only — State inspection only upon receipt of complaint per Fla. Stat. §500.80(7); county cannot add inspections
HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT	Likely; verify with Dixie County — No Dixie County-specific home occupation ordinance text located in search. Very small rural county (pop. ~16,000) with county seat Cross City. Local business tax receipt and possible zoning approval likely required. State preempts county from banning cottage food.
LOCAL BUSINESS LICENSE	Likely; Dixie County local business tax receipt; contact Dixie County Tax Collector

Customer-facing rules

ON-SITE CUSTOMER PICKUP	True
ON-SITE SIGNAGE	Must comply with Dixie County signage ordinances
DELIVERY / PICKUP RULES	Direct-to-consumer; online/mail-order allowed; shipping within and across state lines via USPS or commercial carrier; no wholesale/consignment; max \$250,000 annual gross sales
MAX EMPLOYEES IN HOME	No state limit; local home occupation rules may apply

RESEARCH NOTES

No Dixie County-specific cottage food or home occupation ordinance surfaced in search. Very small, rural north-central Florida county. State baseline (Fla. Stat. §500.80) governs; county cannot restrict cottage food production.

State context — Florida cottage food law

Dixie County's rules sit on top of Florida's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

STATUTE Fla. Stat. §500.80	ANNUAL SALES CAP 250000
REGISTRATION REQUIRED No	FOOD HANDLER CERT No
KITCHEN INSPECTION Upon-complaint	DIRECT SALES ONLY No
INDIRECT SALES Limited (see notes) — Florida prohibits wholesale sales but allows online, mail-order, and in-person sales including delivery to consumers; state law preempts local restrictions on cottage food operations.
