**RESEARCH NOTES**

Banner County is a rural Nebraska county. No county-specific cottage food or home occupation zoning ordinance was identified for the unincorporated county area. Nebraska's cottage food law (Neb. Rev. Stat. §81-2,280) requires registration and food handler certification but has no sales cap. As of LB262 (July 2024), some TCS foods are also permitted. County-level zoning is minimal or absent in most rural NE counties; state law governs.

## State context — Nebraska cottage food law

Banner County's rules sit on top of Nebraska's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

No — Sales must be direct-to-consumer. Wholesale to restaurants, grocery stores, or distributors is not permitted under the cottage food framework. Non-TCS foods may be mailed; TCS foods must be delivered in person by the producer within 2 hours.
