- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under North Carolina cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ North Carolina home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED?

Yes (North Carolina home processor program (02 NCAC 09C .0307) requires annual inspection of the home kitchen by NCDA&CS. No sales cap. Allowed: shelf-stable, low-risk foods including non-refrigerated baked goods, jams/jellies, preserves, candies, dried mixes, spices, some beverages, some sauces, acidified foods (pickles, BBQ sauce), freeze-dried fruits/vegetables. CRITICAL: Presence of pet animals in the home DISQUALIFIES the applicant entirely. Products must be shelf-stable.)

ANY pet animals in the home DISQUALIFY the applicant from obtaining a home processor permit. This is a unique and strict restriction.

Varies (Nash County (Nashville, NC) may have local home occupation zoning requirements. No Nash County-specific cottage food permit beyond state home processor registration identified. Operators must register with NCDA&CS.)

Home kitchen rules

HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED

Yes — North Carolina home processor program (02 NCAC 09C .0307) requires annual inspection of the home kitchen by NCDA&CS. No sales cap. Allowed: shelf-stable, low-risk foods including non-refrigerated baked goods, jams/jellies, preserves, candies, dried mixes, spices, some beverages, some sauces, acidified foods (pickles, BBQ sauce), freeze-dried fruits/vegetables. CRITICAL: Presence of pet animals in the home DISQUALIFIES the applicant entirely. Products must be shelf-stable.

SEPARATE DEDICATED KITCHEN

No

PET RESTRICTIONS

ANY pet animals in the home DISQUALIFY the applicant from obtaining a home processor permit. This is a unique and strict restriction.

WATER SUPPLY

No specific water supply requirement stated beyond standard kitchen safety.

HANDWASHING

Annual kitchen inspection covers food safety practices including handwashing.

FOOD STORAGE

Shelf-stable non-refrigerated products only; no frozen products; no dairy, seafood, bakery items with cream/cream cheese fillings.

Inspection & permitting

INSPECTION REQUIRED

Yes — Annual inspection of home kitchen by NC Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services (NCDA&CS). Registration required.

HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT

Varies — Nash County (Nashville, NC) may have local home occupation zoning requirements. No Nash County-specific cottage food permit beyond state home processor registration identified. Operators must register with NCDA&CS.

No Nash County-specific cottage food code identified.

RESEARCH NOTES

No Nash County-specific cottage food rules found. North Carolina's annual kitchen inspection requirement and no-pets rule are notable distinguishing features. NC allows wholesale/indirect sales which is less common. The original state cottage food URL (oah.state.nc.us PDF) returned 404; NCDA&CS website confirmed as primary source.

State context — North Carolina cottage food law

Nash County's rules sit on top of North Carolina's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Yes — Home processors may sell to retail stores, restaurants, and directly to consumers. Sales at farmers markets are permitted. Labels are required for wholesale and packaged self-service retail; direct hand-to-consumer sales (e.g., from home or at events) may be exempt from affixed labels if ingredient info is available on request. NC requires annual home kitchen inspection, which is unusual among no-cap states.
