- ☐ **1. Menu** — Confirm each product under North Carolina cottage food rules (county cannot expand a state ban).
- ☐ **2. Pickup & zoning** — Home occupation and porch pickup cells above; HOA/lease may still block customer traffic.
- ☐ **3. Local tax / license** — Business license or sales tax certificate if your city/parish requires it (common even with no state food permit).
- ☐ **4. Training** — Food handler or state registration before market day.
- ☐ **5. Labels** — Disclaimer, allergens, ingredients, net quantity, producer info.
- ☐ **6. Call if unclear** — County health and planning for your exact address.

LABEL FIELDS TO INCLUDE

- ☐ Product name · producer name · address (or allowed alternative)
- ☐ Ingredients by weight · major allergens · net weight/quantity
- ☐ North Carolina home-kitchen disclaimer (see live label one-pager)

Must use an approved water supply; well water may require testing.

HANDWASHING

Adequate handwashing facilities required as part of the kitchen inspection.

FOOD STORAGE

Shelf-stable storage required; products must be non-refrigerated.

Yes — Annual inspection of home kitchen by NCDA&CS required before registration renewal each year.

HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT

Pasquotank County Zoning Ordinance (home occupation provisions); no specific cottage food county code identified.

No county-specific cottage food ordinance found for Pasquotank County. Northeastern NC coastal county, home to Elizabeth City. State baseline (02 NCAC 09C .0307) applies. Annual kitchen inspection and pet disqualification rules apply statewide.

State context — North Carolina cottage food law

Pasquotank County's rules sit on top of North Carolina's state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

Yes — Home processors may sell to retail stores, restaurants, and directly to consumers. Sales at farmers markets are permitted. Labels are required for wholesale and packaged self-service retail; direct hand-to-consumer sales (e.g., from home or at events) may be exempt from affixed labels if ingredient info is available on request. NC requires annual home kitchen inspection, which is unusual among no-cap states.
