### QUICK VIEW FOR BAKERS IN THIS COUNTY

**HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED?**

Yes (Production at residence required. For non-TCS foods: no license, inspection, or registration required. For TCS foods: must complete approved food safety training (ServSafe or ODAFF-approved, ≤8 hours) before selling. Gross annual sales must not exceed \$75,000.)

**SEPARATE KITCHEN REQUIRED?**

No

**PETS ALLOWED?**

Not specified in state law.

**HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT?**

Conditional (Logan County and City of Guthrie may require home occupation permits for home-based businesses. State law (§5-4.6) allows counties to enact non-conflicting ordinances. Recommend verifying with Logan County and City of Guthrie planning departments.)

**ON-SITE / PORCH PICKUP?**

Yes

**INSPECTION REQUIRED?**

No (No inspection required. ODAFF may request proof of food safety training completion, verify gross sales, and ensure labeling compliance upon complaint.)

<b>HOME KITCHEN ALLOWED</b>	Yes — Production at residence required. For non-TCS foods: no license, inspection, or registration required. For TCS foods: must complete approved food safety training (ServSafe or ODAFF-approved, ≤8 hours) before selling. Gross annual sales must not exceed \$75,000.
<b>SEPARATE DEDICATED KITCHEN</b>	No
<b>PET RESTRICTIONS</b>	Not specified in state law.
<b>WATER SUPPLY</b>	Not specified in state law.
<b>HANDWASHING</b>	Not specified in state law beyond standard practice.
<b>FOOD STORAGE</b>	Not specified in state law; standard food safety practices implied.

### Inspection & permitting

<b>INSPECTION REQUIRED</b>	No — No inspection required. ODAFF may request proof of food safety training completion, verify gross sales, and ensure labeling compliance upon complaint.
<b>HOME OCCUPATION PERMIT</b>	Conditional — Logan County and City of Guthrie may require home occupation permits for home-based businesses. State law (§5-4.6) allows counties to enact non-conflicting ordinances. Recommend verifying with Logan County and City of Guthrie planning departments.
<b>LOCAL BUSINESS LICENSE</b>	Varies

### Customer-facing rules

ON-SITE CUSTOMER PICKUP	Yes
ON-SITE SIGNAGE	Conditional
DELIVERY / PICKUP RULES	Sales allowed on-site, by delivery, at farmers markets, through cooperatives, and through membership-based buying clubs. Non-TCS foods may also be sold through third-party vendors with required disclosure placard.
MAX EMPLOYEES IN HOME	Not specified in state law; local home occupation rules may restrict.

2 O.S. §5-4.1 et seq.; Logan County and City of Guthrie zoning codes

#### RESEARCH NOTES

Oklahoma’s Homemade Food Freedom Act is highly permissive. Logan County includes Guthrie (historic state capital). No Logan County-specific cottage food restrictions found. State law allows counties to enact non-conflicting ordinances.

## State context — Oklahoma cottage food law

Logan County’s rules sit on top of Oklahoma’s state cottage food framework. The state law sets the floor — counties can add but cannot remove protections.

### INDIRECT SALES

Limited (see notes) — Sales are permitted on site, by delivery, at farmers markets, through cooperatives, and through membership-based buying clubs. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry may promulgate rules to allow sales at other locations or by other means. County ordinances may regulate but may not conflict with or impede the Act. For TCS foods, the producer must complete an approved food safety training (e.g., ServSafe Food Handler Training, max 8 hours, available online) before selling.
