**NATED Engineering and Management Students Phased-in Return to Campuses in June 2020 during the Covid-19 pandemic**

Official Communication has been issued by the DHET with regards to the NATED Engineering and Management programmes. The DHET has a phased-in process of students per faculty and per level. Taking cognizance of the need for campuses to be Covid-19 ready and the limit of 33% of staff and students on campuses; Damelin, Central Technical College and ICESA students will gradually return to campus for their tutorial classes. Virtual classes will continue with two virtual classes per subject taking place per week. This blended learning approach of virtual classes with a few on-campus classes will continue ahead at this time.

**Response of Damelin, Central Technical College and ICESA**

The phased-in approach is taken to ensure the safety protocols are in place at campus level and that all staff and students follow and adhere to the protocol as set out by national regulations – staff and students maintain social distance, wear face masks, sanitize and are screened for temperatures on entrance to the campus.

All students who return to campuses in June 2020 will be required to provide their own face masks and adhere to safety protocols. Each student will need to sign an Indemnity Form acknowledging that the student is freely returning to contact classes on campus; that the campus will take reasonable health and safety steps in compliance with National Regulations to protect students and staff while on campus; that the student will obey the health and safety procedures and comply with any reasonable or legitimate instructions by appointed staff to keep physical distancing, hand-washing and wearing of face masks.

Students will be required to sign a register each day, wear a fabric mask that covers their nose and mouth before entering the campus, have their temperature remotely taken on entry, sanitise their hands, and avoid physical contact with others. If a student has a high temperature or shows signs of illness, then the student will be isolated and government health procedures will be followed.

Rules and policies have been changed to regulate the safe conduct of students while on campus, and swift disciplinary action will be taken against students where there is non-compliance with the rules or student code of conduct.
