



VISITATION GUIDELINES – effective 9/28/20

- When you arrive for your visit, please have your face mask on and enter through the main entrance and wait for staff assistance with mandatory screening process. All visitors will be required to pass screening process and temperature check to be granted admission into facility.
- Visitation will not be permitted if visitor has any active illness symptoms
- Visitation will be held from 9 am to 6 pm, seven days/week
- Visitors are limited to no more than TWO at a time
- Visitation will be limited to a maximum of two hours; Visitors will need to immediately exit once visitation is complete
- Visitors will limit movement in facility; visitors will be required to go immediately to resident room/apartment for visitation. Use of common areas is restricted
- Visitors are not permitted to participate in communal dining or communal activity functions with any residents
- Visitation can be conducted through outdoor visitation space (which is encouraged to best reduce risk of transmission), window visitation, dedicated clean rooms, or In-room (resident room/apartment)
- Visitors must comply with core principles of infection prevention:
 - ***Mandatory mask use at all times** (both visitor and resident)
 - ***Social distancing of at least 6 feet**
 - ***Hand hygiene with use of hand sanitizer** prior to facility entrance, prior to visit and after all visitation
 - *We discourage all forms of physical contact (we discourage hugging, kissing, etc. due to increased risk of transmission)
- No one under the age of 16 will be permitted to visit at this time
- No pets will be allowed to visit
- No food, laundry, personal items, or packages will be brought to residents during visits. If items require drop off, the items must be left at the Main Vestibule/ Main Entrance for delivery to the resident by staff at a later time
- Visitors must arrive in face mask, The Culpeper will provide facemasks to residents
- Visitors will also be required to notify The Culpeper immediately if they become suspicious of having COVID-19 and have visited The Culpeper in the 14 days prior to coming into contact or suspected contact with COVID-19
- The Culpeper recognizes the importance of visitation for residents and families and will continue to facilitate visitation to the extent possible, however, the facility has the right to not permit a visit if the visitor is unable to adhere to the infection control protocols outlined above
