Download the FileZilla client and install in on your computer. If you currently have an FTP client installed, you may skip this step.


Once installed, launch the program. Once loaded, you will be presented with a screen similar to what is shown at below.


Step 2:

Located along the top of the program screen are the fields for entering the credentials, which are detailed above. Make sure to populate 'Host', 'User Name' and 'Password'. You may leave the 'Port' field empty.




Step 3:

Once you are logged in, you should see the information shown below. Click into the 'Vendor Login Files' folder. This folder contains all of the helpful resources we are providing, which are intended to increase your sales.




Step 4:

The 'Vendor Login Files' folder contains the 'CURT Library', 'DCI Data Files' and the 'masterlibrary' folders. Click into the 'masterlibrary' folder.



Step 5:

The 'masterlibrary', sorted by part number, contains all of the images and instruction sheets. Click into a product folder to see both the 'images' and 'install sheet' folders. An example list of images is shown below.



Step 6:
