DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The reporting from February 21, 2026, depicts a world in a state of high-stakes transition, characterized by intense military brinkmanship in West Asia, a constitutional crisis in the United States over trade authority, and an escalating rhetorical shift regarding Israeli territorial expansion. The central narrative revolves around the "10-day ultimatum" issued by US President Donald Trump to Iran to reach a nuclear deal, even as the US military amasses a significant "armada" in the Persian Gulf.
