## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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February 22, 2026, marks a critical inflection point in the dissolution of the post-WWII international order and the heightening of domestic political volatility within the United States. President Donald Trump has initiated a global 15% across-the-board tariff on all imports, utilizing the International Emergency Economic Powers Act to bypass a recent US Supreme Court ruling that declared his previous trade measures unconstitutional. This move represents a direct challenge to the domestic separation of powers and an aggressive escalation of economic statecraft, which the Global South and BRICS nations are interpreting as proof of the US being an "unreliable partner." The resulting surge in interest for multipolar trade networks and local currency settlements suggests an accelerated decoupling from the US dollar-centric system.

In the Middle East, the convergence of extremist rhetoric and military posturing has

pushed the region toward an existential precipice. The US Ambassador to Israel has publicly endorsed a "Greater Israel" concept based on biblical claims, while Washington amasses a naval armada near Iran to "blackmail" Tehran into capitulation. Iran, in response, has warned of a total regional war that would permanently sever global oil and gas supplies from the Persian Gulf should it be attacked. Concurrently, the first trilateral peace talks between the US, Russia, and Ukraine have commenced in Geneva, though they are overshadowed by reports of a British-intelligence-backed assassination attempt on a Russian General in Moscow and internal EU fracturing over the continued funding of the Ukrainian war effort.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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- **US Constitutional Crisis and Global Trade War:** President Trump has ignored a Supreme Court ruling declaring his tariffs illegal, instead imposing a new 15% global tax via emergency powers. ## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### The End of Diplomatic Pretense

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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### Short Term (1-4 Weeks):

- Expect a surge in global market volatility as the 15% US tariffs take effect, potentially triggering retaliatory measures from the EU and China.
