#### THE CATALYST: OPERATION EPIC FURY & LEADERSHIP STRIKE

**SUPREME LEADER KHAMENEI: STATUS DISPUTED**  
(WEST CLAIMS DEATH, TEHRAN DENIES)

Massive aerial campaign to degrade state capacity. Goal: "Prevent wicked dictatorship". Conflict reports persist amidst internet blackout.

#### REGIONAL RETALIATION & CONFLICT SPREAD

Iran & proxies launch broad counter-attacks with missiles/drones. Collateral damage reported, including girls' school and commercial centers.

**STRAIT OF HORMUZ: CLOSED**

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JOINT US-ISRAELI "OPERATION EPIC FURY" SIGNALS A DECISIVE SHIFT TOWARD FORCED REGIME CHANGE IN IRAN, TRIGGERING REGIONAL RETALIATION AND GLOBAL ECONOMIC VOLATILITY

## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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February 28, 2026, marks a watershed moment in global geopolitics as the United States and Israel launched [massive military strikes](#) against Iran under the codename "Operation Epic Fury." This offensive represents an escalation from previous containment and deterrence strategies toward a stated goal of regime change. US President Donald Trump and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu have both claimed that [Ayatollah Ali Khamenei is dead](#), though Iranian officials continue to deny these reports amid a near-total internet blackout within the country. The strikes targeted leadership compounds, nuclear infrastructure, and ballistic missile sites, significantly degrading Iran's state capacity in a single day of kinetic action.

The regional response has been immediate and violent. Iran launched retaliatory missile

and drone swarms against US and Israeli assets across the Middle East, striking [bases in Bahrain, Qatar, and the UAE](#). Collateral damage has been reported, including a strike on a [girls' school in Minab](#) and damage to civilian infrastructure in Dubai. The reported [closure of the Strait of Hormuz](#) has sent shockwaves through energy markets, while global aviation has been paralyzed by the closure of airspace across the Persian Gulf. Concurrently, other regional flashpoints have ignited, with Pakistan declaring [open war on Afghanistan](#) following border skirmishes.

Domestically, Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney has offered [qualified support for the US](#) objective of preventing a nuclear Iran but confirmed Canada is not a military participant. The Canadian government is focused on trade missions in India and Japan, even as it faces internal pressure regarding [AI safety regulations](#) and economic concerns related to US tariffs. The convergence of these events suggests a collapse of the previous international order, replaced by a "maximalist" approach to security and trade that prioritizes unilateral action and forced transitions over traditional diplomacy.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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- **Operation Epic Fury and the Leadership Strike:** A coordinated US-Israeli aerial campaign targeted the "center of gravity" of the Iranian regime.
  - President Trump announced [major combat operations](#) aimed at "preventing this wicked, radical dictatorship" from threatening US interests.
  - The Israeli Air Force conducted its [largest military flyover](#) in history, involving approximately 200 fighter jets.
  - Conflicting reports persist regarding the [death of the Supreme Leader](#), with Western intelligence claiming his body was identified while Tehran insists he remains in command.
- **Regional Retaliation and "Axis of Resistance":** Iran and its proxies initiated a broad-spectrum counter-attack.
  - Missile and drone strikes hit the [US Navy Fifth Fleet headquarters](#) in Bahrain and the Al-Udeid airbase in Qatar.
  - Debris from intercepted missiles caused [civilian casualties in Abu Dhabi](#) and fires in Dubai's commercial centers.
  - Hezbollah expressed [solidarity with Iran](#) but has yet to fully mobilize its northern front against Israel.
- **Global Economic and Logistics Paralysis:** The conflict has immediately severed critical global supply lines.
  - Airlines including [Air Canada](#), [Emirates](#), and [Lufthansa](#) have suspended all flights to the Middle East due to airspace closures.
  - Reports of the [Strait of Hormuz closure](#) threaten 20% of the world's Brent crude oil supply.
  - Prime Minister Carney acknowledged a [risk premium in energy markets](#) while maintaining that the geopolitical issue of proliferation must take precedence.
- **Escalation of the Pakistan-Afghanistan Conflict:** Secondary regional wars are erupting as global attention is diverted.
  - Pakistan launched [airstrikes on Taliban sites](#) in Kandahar and Kabul, citing "domestic terrorism" fueled by Afghanistan.
  - The conflict has transitioned to an [open war](#) with hundreds of casualties reported on both sides.
- **AI and Workforce Disruption:** Technology firms are leveraging AI to justify massive labor reductions.
  - Fintech company Block announced [layoffs of 4,000 workers](#), with CEO Jack Dorsey explicitly citing AI's ability to run a company with a significantly smaller team.
  - OpenAI remains under [regulatory scrutiny in Canada](#) following safety failures linked to a mass shooting in Tumbler Ridge.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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**Geopolitical Power Dynamics:** The US has moved to a [regime change doctrine](#) in the

Middle East, bypassing traditional international approval. While the UN Security Council held an [emergency summit](#), the US and Israel proceeded without a mandate, citing "inherent and lawful right to self-defense." This shift signals the obsolescence of nuclear non-proliferation frameworks in favor of direct military decapitation.

- The US [Gang of Eight](#) was briefed, but full Congressional authorization was bypassed, sparking constitutional debates.
- Canada's [trade mission to India](#) continues, with Prime Minister Carney attempting to "defrost" relations while balancing the security concerns posed by Indian agents in Canada.

**AI & Technology Policy:** The Canadian government is seeking a [detailed safety plan](#) from OpenAI CEO Sam Altman. The demand follows revelations that the Tumbler Ridge shooter maintained a second account after being banned, highlighting gaps in human review and automated escalation thresholds. Separately, the government is reconsidering a [social media ban for minors](#) as part of a new Online Harms Act.

**Energy Security:** The potential for a [prolonged blockade of Hormuz](#) is the primary threat to global economic stability. In Canada, Saskatchewan's Premier is pushing for [new pipelines](#) to the West Coast to displace "unethical forms of energy" and capitalize on Indian demand for LNG and crude.

**Domestic Stability & Social Order:** Large-scale rallies have broken out in [Richmond Hill and Toronto](#), with the Iranian diaspora celebrating the potential fall of the Islamic Republic. Conversely, police in [Los Angeles](#) and other major cities are monitoring anti-war protests and increasing security around

religious and cultural sites due to the high [terror threat level](#).

**Rule of Law:** In Ontario, a legal crisis has emerged for homeowners who discovered [Indigenous ancestral remains](#) on their property. Current law places the [financial burden of archaeology](#)—potentially reaching millions of dollars—on individual citizens, leading to calls for legislative reform to prevent property owners from concealing such discoveries.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Legislative activity this period focuses on the limits of executive power in the US, secularism in Quebec, and the financial responsibilities of property owners regarding heritage sites. Press events were dominated by [Prime Minister Carney's Mumbai briefing](#) and President Trump's social media communiques.

## BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Online Harms Act (Canada):** Proposed revisions to include [AI chatbot regulations](#) and a social media ban for teens following the Tumbler Ridge shooting.
- **Bill 94 (Quebec):** Expanded [ban on religious symbols](#) to include school support staff and daycare workers, leading to hundreds of potential layoffs.
- **War Powers Resolution (US):** Debated by Democrats and some Republicans to [limit the President's power](#) to act unilaterally in Iran.
- **Ontario Burial Act Reform:** Proposed changes to relieve homeowners of the [financial burden](#) of archaeological investigations when Indigenous remains are found.

## HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **UN Security Council Emergency Summit:** Secretary General Guterres [condemned military action](#) by both sides and called for a return to the brink.
- **Bill Clinton Deposition:** A six-hour [closed-door hearing](#) regarding his relationship with Jeffrey Epstein; Clinton denied all wrongdoing.
- **OpenAI Minister Meeting:** A scheduled high-level meeting between Canada's AI minister and [Sam Altman](#) to demand safety plan transparency.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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**The End of "Strategic Patience":** Across multiple theaters, governments are abandoning long-term containment in favor of kinetic finality. The US/Israeli operation in Iran and Pakistan's strikes in Afghanistan both reflect a [patience had run out](#) sentiment. This trend suggests that the "managed conflicts" of the last decade are giving way to "war as a solution," with leadership decapitation (decapitation strikes) being the preferred tool.

**AI as a Workplace Scapegoat:** Corporate layoffs are increasingly being [branded as AI-driven](#) restructuring. Experts suggest companies like Block may be using AI as a [cover for cost-cutting](#) after over-hiring during the pandemic. This trend risks hollowing out entry-level roles, potentially creating a generational skill gap as tasks traditionally done by junior workers are automated or eliminated.

**The Fragmented Diaspora Sentiment:** The Iranian diaspora presents a unique case of a population [celebrating the bombing](#) of their home country as a form of "rescue mission."

This sentiment, however, is not universal, with others warning that [regime change by air power](#) rarely results in stable democracy. The lack of a [coherent opposition leader](#) remains the primary risk to a successful transition.

**Medical Surveillance for Children:** A new trend in pediatric health is emerging with the recommendation that [cholesterol screening start at age two](#). This moves toward a life-long medicalization of genetic conditions (familial hypercholesterolemia), aiming to [reverse diseases](#) before they require acute intervention, but it faces logistical hurdles regarding community clinic capacity.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect [continued volatility in Israel](#) and the Gulf states as drone and missile exchanges continue. Global oil prices will remain elevated as long as the [Hormuz blockade](#) is active. In Iran, the regime may engage in [mass executions](#) of internal dissidents as a desperate show of control before a potential collapse.

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The US will face internal legal challenges over [War Powers](#). If the Iranian regime falls, a power vacuum could lead to [separatist movements](#) among Kurdish and Azeri populations. China's removal of [canola meal tariffs](#) may provide slight relief to Canadian farmers, but broader trade will be hampered by the Middle East conflict.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** A structural shift in the Middle East is likely, with the [elimination of the Axis of Resistance](#) (Hezbollah, Hamas, Houthi) if their Iranian patron is permanently removed. NASA's [delayed Artemis missions](#) will likely see increased private sector involvement from SpaceX and Blue Origin to

compensate for budget and technical setbacks.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

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### For International Policy:

- Prioritize the [evacuation of foreign nationals](#) from the Persian Gulf via land routes to Turkey, as commercial air travel is no longer viable.
- Formalize a [national standard for AI reporting](#) to ensure companies must report when users are planning violence, bypassing the failures of voluntary industry safety rules.
- Engage with the [Iranian diaspora leadership](#) to establish a transitional framework, preventing the chaotic "Libya scenario" of civil war post-regime collapse.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Sector:** Diversify away from Middle Eastern crude; look toward [Canadian energy exports](#) to India and Japan as long-term alternatives.
- **Tech Sector:** Prepare for a "labor reinvention" as AI replaces entry-level roles; companies should focus on **junior team growth** to prevent long-term senior leadership shortages [due to hollowing out](#).
- **Real Estate (Canada):** Homeowners and developers must conduct [archaeological risk assessments](#) prior to purchase, as current law offers no protection against the financial ruin caused by the discovery of heritage remains.
