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THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN ENTERS A POST-KHAMENEI ERA AMIDST REGIONAL WAR AND UNPRECEDENTED MILITARY ESCALATION

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 1, 2026, marks the most significant existential crisis for the Islamic Republic since its inception, characterized by the [assassination of Ayatollah Khamenei](#) and nearly the entire top tier of Iran's military command during a targeted strike on a Defense Council meeting. The dead include the Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces, the Commander-in-Chief of the IRGC, the Minister of Defense, and the Secretary of the Defense Council. This decapitation strike, attributed to a joint U.S.-Israeli operation, has triggered "Operation True Promise 4," a massive regional military response that Iranian officials claim has escalated into a full-scale "regional war" involving strikes on U.S. aircraft carriers and bases across seven countries.

Domestically, the state has moved with high speed to ensure institutional continuity via Article 111 of the Constitution, forming a

[Temporary Leadership Council](#) to prevent a power vacuum. While the nation is in a state of deep mourning and "Holy Unity," the government is simultaneously managing a wartime economy, ordering 24-hour operations for customs and essential services to prevent civil unrest or supply chain collapses. The narrative is heavily focused on a "martyrdom" that fertilizes the soil for further resistance, specifically leveraging the [civilian casualties in Minab](#)—where 159 schoolchildren were reportedly killed—to solidify public support for an indefinite military campaign against the "Arrogant Powers."

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Decapitation of Iranian Leadership:**

- The Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, was killed in what is described as a "cowardly" strike while at his place of work. [Ayatollah Khamenei's martyrdom](#) occurred during ongoing negotiations, which Iranian officials now frame as a deceptive trap by the U.S.
- High-ranking martyrs include [General Abdolrahim Mousavi](#) (Chief of Staff), [General Mohammad Pakpour](#) (IRGC), [Admiral Ali Shamkhani](#) (Defense Council), and [General Aziz Nasirzadeh](#) (Defense Minister).

- **Operation True Promise 4 and Regional Escalation:**

- The IRGC and Army have launched nine waves of missile and drone strikes. A primary achievement claimed is the [strike on the USS Abraham Lincoln](#) with four missiles, forcing it to retreat toward the Indian Ocean.
- U.S. and Israeli bases in [Qatar, UAE, Bahrain, Kuwait, Jordan, and Saudi Arabia](#) have been targeted, with Iran claiming over 560 U.S. military casualties.
- The [destruction of a THAAD radar](#) system in the UAE and the downing of an MQ-9 Reaper drone are reported as major tactical successes.

- **The Minab Massacre Narrative:**

- State media is heavily saturating coverage of a strike on the [Shajareh Tayyebah girls' elementary school](#) in Minab, with the death toll rising to 165 children. This is being used as the primary moral justification for "harsh revenge."

- **Institutional Succession:**

- The Expediency Council selected [Ayatollah Araf](#) to join President Pezeshkian and Chief Justice Mohseni-Ejei on the Temporary Leadership Council.
- Officials emphasize that the [structure of the system](#) is no longer individual-centric and will continue without interruption.

- **Global Reaction and Axis of Resistance:**

- Mass protests have broken out in [Iraq, Pakistan, Kashmir, and Lebanon](#). In Pakistan, ten protesters were reportedly killed by police during an attack on the U.S. consulate.
- The "Axis of Resistance" (Ansarullah, Hezbollah, Iraqi militias) has declared [full participation](#) in the war effort.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Succession & Stability: The activation of Article 111 is the highest priority. The [Temporary Leadership Council](#) has taken over all duties of the Supreme Leader, including declaring war and peace and appointing military commanders. The Assembly of Experts is tasked with choosing a permanent successor "as soon as possible," though the wartime environment complicates the logistics.

National Security & Defense Architecture: Despite the loss of the top military echelon, the "True Promise" operational framework appears decentralized and pre-planned. The [integration of Army and IRGC](#) forces is unprecedented, with the Air Force (Army) and Missile Forces (IRGC) conducting joint strikes across the region. Iran has declared the [Persian Gulf a "killing field"](#) for U.S. forces and warned regional neighbors that any base used for attacks on Iran will be considered a legitimate target.

Economic Security & Supply Chains: The Ministry of Agriculture and the Customs Administration have moved to [24-hour operations](#) to ensure food and fuel remain available. Authorities are pleading with the public to avoid "emotional buying" or hoarding, claiming that [six months of essential supplies](#) are stockpiled. All transit

and export-import activities at Shahid Rajaei port are continuing to maintain the flow of goods.

International Relations & Foreign Policy:

Diplomatic relations with the U.S. have effectively ceased following what Iran calls a "stab in the back" during nuclear negotiations. Foreign Minister Araghchi is engaging with [Turkey and Azerbaijan](#) to shore up regional support, while Russia and China have condemned the strike as a [violation of international law](#) and the UN Charter.

Critical Infrastructure & Cybersecurity:

Iran has warned of potential cyber-warfare and is utilizing its [cyber-offensive capabilities](#) to support military operations. Civil defense (Passive Defense Organization) is on high alert for strikes on hospitals and power grids, citing [attacks on medical centers](#) in Tehran as evidence of a total war strategy by the adversary.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative activity is currently dominated by constitutional mandates for succession and emergency wartime management. The Parliament (Majlis) is operating in a supportive role to the executive and military branches.

• BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Article 111 Implementation:** The legal process for forming the [Temporary Leadership Council](#) was completed today, transferring the Supreme Leader's powers to a triumvirate.
- **Wartime Service Mandate:** Administrative and service sectors have been ordered to [remain open 24/7](#) despite the week-long public holiday declared for mourning.

• HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Address by Speaker Ghalibaf:** Warned Trump and Netanyahu that they have [crossed a red line](#) and that Iran's military response is currently only using a fraction of its power.
- **SNSC Briefing (Ali Larijani):** Analyzed the strike as an attempt to [disintegrate Iran](#) and emphasized that the people's "inherent intelligence" will overcome the crisis.
- **Ministry of Intelligence Statement:** Warned against [psychological warfare](#) and rumors, urging citizens to report "suspicious movements" via official channels.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Transition from Individual to Institutional Power:

A recurring theme across all broadcasts is the assertion that the Islamic Republic is [no longer reliant on individuals](#). By emphasizing that the military response continued "without a second of interruption" after the deaths of the commanders, the state is attempting to project an image of a mature, resilient bureaucracy that cannot be collapsed by targeted assassinations. This is a strategic narrative shift designed to discourage further decapitation attempts.

"Holy Unity" (Ettihad-e Moghaddas): The term "Holy Unity" has emerged as a new social mandate. Officials are calling for an [end to internal political squabbles](#) and "settling of past accounts." The state is using the external threat to enforce absolute domestic cohesion, suggesting that any dissent at this moment is a service to the enemy's goal of "partitioning Iran."

Iran is framing this not as a defense of its borders, but as a [defense of the entire Islamic world](#). By hitting U.S. bases in neighboring countries, Iran is effectively ending the era of "strategic patience." The rhetoric has shifted from deterrence to [actively forcing a U.S. withdrawal](#) from the Middle East, using the Supreme Leader's death as the ultimate catalyst for this long-held strategic goal.

Deception in Diplomacy: There is a profound sense of betrayal regarding the nuclear negotiations. Officials like Larijani and Rezai are highlighting that the [strike occurred during negotiations](#), which will likely poison Iranian diplomatic engagement with the West for years. The narrative is that the West uses "diplomacy as a screen for terror."

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

- **Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect an intensification of Operation True Promise 4. Iranian forces will likely target [U.S. naval assets](#) in the Arabian Sea and Persian Gulf to enforce their "no-entry" zone. Domestic security will be tightened to prevent any opportunistic unrest or "fifth column" activities. Funeral ceremonies for the Supreme Leader will be used as mass mobilization events to signal defiance to the world.
- **Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The Assembly of Experts will likely move toward [selecting a new Supreme Leader](#), with candidates likely to be chosen for their military and "resistance" credentials rather than just theological standing. The economic impact of the war, especially on oil transit through the [Strait of Hormuz](#), will cause significant global market volatility.

- **Long Term (1-5 Years):** The Islamic Republic will likely undergo a permanent structural shift toward a more [securitized and militarized governance](#) model. Alliances with Russia and China will likely formalize into a mutual defense bloc, as Iran seeks a nuclear or strategic umbrella to prevent future decapitation strikes. The "Axis of Resistance" may become a more unified, state-like military entity under a central command structure.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The risk of a total regional war is at its highest point in decades. International mediators should expect [zero appetite for negotiation](#) from Tehran in the near future.
- Neighboring states hosting U.S. bases (Qatar, Bahrain, UAE) are now directly in the line of fire; [pressure on these hosts](#) to evict U.S. forces will increase significantly.
- The death of Khamenei may empower hardline military factions within the IRGC to pursue more [aggressive trans-border operations](#) without the traditional constraints of the Supreme Leader's "prudence."

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Markets:** Expect extreme volatility in Brent crude. Iran's stated intention to ["liberate" the Persian Gulf](#) implies a sustained threat to tankers and offshore infrastructure.

- **Supply Chains:** Shipping routes through the [Strait of Hormuz](#) are compromised. Insurance premiums for regional transit will spike, and some carriers have already suspended flights to Qatar and Dubai.
- **Regional Safety:** All personnel in the GCC and Iraq are at [heightened risk of missile strikes](#) and civil unrest. Corporate emergency protocols for the Middle East should be fully activated.
