## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 1, 2026, marks a tectonic shift in global security architecture, characterized by the sudden decapitation of the Iranian regime and a fundamental realignment of American foreign policy. The assassination of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei has plunged the Middle East into a high-intensity conflict, with [retaliatory strikes hitting Israel](#) and US bases across the Persian Gulf. President Donald Trump has signaled a "Vabank" approach, seeking to permanently neutralize Iran's nuclear and ballistic capabilities through air power alone, while regional maritime traffic—responsible for a quarter of the world's oil—has [effectively ground to a halt](#). This escalation is occurring simultaneously with a historic shift in the Ukraine conflict, as the Trump administration notably [refused to support a UN resolution](#) upholding Ukraine's

territorial integrity, signaling that a negotiated settlement involving territorial concessions is now the preferred American outcome.

In Lithuania, domestic stability is being tested by a convergence of high-level corruption scandals and systemic social unrest. The "Special Investigation Service (STT)" has become a fixture in elite politics, [questioning former Prime Ministers](#) and ministers regarding corruption in the agricultural sector and personal wealth accumulation. Public discourse is further inflamed by the release of a memoir by convicted former politician Eligijus Masiulis, which [alleges ethical breaches](#) by current and former Presidents. On the social front, the education sector has reached a breaking point, with over 400 teachers [launching a protest in Alytus](#) over unsafe working conditions and the perceived "judicial persecution" of educators, highlighting a deepening rift between state administration and public servants.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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### Regional War in the Middle East

- The death of Ali Khamenei after 36 years of rule has triggered a "New Day" in Iran, marked by [40 days of mourning](#) and threats of "blood for blood" retaliation.
- Iranian Revolutionary Guard forces have launched waves of missile attacks against [civilian and military targets](#) in Israel and US bases in Bahrain, Iraq, and Kuwait.
- President Trump has declared the goal of [destroying Iran's nuclear and ballistic capabilities](#), dismissing diplomatic efforts as "fruitless."

- Global maritime logistics are severely disrupted as [hundreds of tankers](#) have dropped anchor in the Persian Gulf, halting a critical portion of global oil transit.

### US-Ukraine Strategic Pivot

- On the fourth anniversary of the full-scale invasion, the US has pivoted toward [demanding a negotiated peace](#) over Ukrainian "victory" or "territorial integrity."
- The Trump administration's refusal to back Ukrainian borders in the UN has caused [friction with European allies](#) who view the move as a violation of international law.
- European nations are attempting to maintain pressure via maritime enforcement, with France and Belgium [seizing Russian "shadow fleet" tankers](#) under ES sanctions.

### Lithuanian Political "Lawfare" and Corruption

- The STT is conducting high-profile interrogations of [Saulius Skvernelis and Gintautas Paluckas](#) regarding corruption in phytosanitary permits and unexplained wealth.
- Former Liberal Movement leader Eligijus Masiulis has published a book from prison [accusing Dalia Grybauskaitė and Gitanas Nausėda](#) of political interference and nepotism, allegations the Presidency has labeled as "lies."
- Debates over the independence of the national broadcaster (LRT) continue as [European Parliament members criticize](#) proposed legislative changes as a threat to media freedom.

### Domestic Social Crisis: The Teachers' Strike

- A significant labor action in Alytus has seen [400 teachers stop work](#) to protest the dismissal of a colleague and systemic disrespect within the school system.
- Educators report working in a [climate of fear](#), where they believe the legal system and school administrations favor student/parent complaints over teacher safety and professional integrity.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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**Geopolitical Power Dynamics** The global order is currently in a state of flux as the US moves away from traditional alliances to pursue a "transactional" security policy. The Trump administration is leveraging [regime change in Iran](#) to project strength, while simultaneously forcing a "realist" settlement in Ukraine. This has created a [leadership vacuum in the UN](#), where the US no longer reflexively supports territorial sovereignty, forcing European states like France and Belgium to act as the primary enforcers of international norms through [maritime seizures](#).

**Economic Security & Energy** The disruption of the Persian Gulf transit routes represents an immediate [threat to global energy security](#). While the Iranian Foreign Ministry claims it does not intend to permanently close the Strait of Hormuz, the ongoing military exchanges have effectively [stopped oil trade](#) through the region. Domestically, Lithuania faces inflationary pressures; despite an [8% increase in average wages](#), economists warn that a proposed hike in the minimum wage will [further drive up prices](#) in shops.

**Rule of Law & Corruption** The Lithuanian governance model is currently defined by "Elite Interrogations." The Special Investigation Service (STT) is targeting the [highest levels of the political class](#), including former Premiers and Ministers. This process is viewed with skepticism by some, as satirical commentary notes that [STT has become an "elite club"](#) for VIP clients. The blurring lines between judicial punishment and political memoirs, as seen in the [Masiulis book controversy](#), is eroding public trust in the Presidency and Parliament.

**Labor & Industry** A severe crisis is emerging in Lithuania's public sector. Beyond the teachers' strike, which highlights [structural flaws in the Labor Code](#) regarding teacher reinstatement, the state faces a critical shortage of educators. Reports suggest that [Lithuania will soon lack thousands](#) of teachers, particularly in Lithuanian and English languages, due to high workloads and low professional prestige.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Legislative activity this week has focused on the regulation of the national broadcaster, international trade tariffs, and labor law reforms in response to civil unrest.

### BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **LRT Governance Law:** Proposed changes to the management of the national broadcaster, which critics and EP members argue would [facilitate political takeover](#) of the media.
- **Minimum Wage Increase:** A government proposal to [increase the minimum monthly wage](#) to counteract falling purchasing power, despite warnings from businesses about price contagion.

- **Labor Code Amendments:** Discussions in Alytus regarding the need to [change the Labor Code](#) so that teachers found "innocent" by courts can be reinstated to their original workplaces.

## HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Trump's Congressional Address:** The longest address in history, focusing on "America First" and [only briefly mentioning Ukraine](#).
- **STT Interrogations:** Ongoing closed-door [questioning of political leaders](#) regarding agricultural corruption and the "Epstein file" echoes in the US.
- **Alytus Teacher Mediation:** A [mediator team from the Ministry of Education](#) is scheduled to meet with striking teachers and the Mayor of Alytus to resolve the impasse.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### The "Trump Effect" and Allied Divergence

The transcripts reveal a profound divergence between US and EU strategic goals. While the US administration prioritizes a [decisive military resolution with Iran](#) and a pragmatic surrender of territory in Ukraine, the EU is doubling down on "Rule of Law" enforcement. ### The Weaponization of Memoirs

A new trend in Lithuanian politics is the use of the "Prison Memoir" as a political weapon. Eligijus Masiulis's book, ["White Collars Unbuttoned,"](#) is being used to bypass

traditional media filters and directly attack the credibility of the sitting President (Nausėda) and former President (Grybauskaitė). By alleging that [Grybauskaitė requested favorable coverage](#) from LNK, Masiulis is attempting to rewrite the narrative of his own conviction as part of a larger, systemic corruption web.

### **The Returnee Sentimentality vs. Reality**

There is a recurring narrative of the "Lithuanian Returnee" (the "Global Lithuanian"). Individuals like Mantas Makaras (chef) and Justė (teacher) have [returned from the UK and Norway](#), citing a lack of "soul" or "culture" abroad. However, their return coincides with a period where [Lithuanian society is increasingly fractious](#), with returnees expressing frustration at "negative comments" and a lack of professional respect, suggesting that the "idealized homeland" narrative is clashing with the harsh reality of domestic political and social tensions.

## **STRATEGIC FORESIGHT**

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Middle East energy prices will likely spike as [maritime eistm remains halted](#). In Lithuania, the teachers' strike in Alytus could trigger [sympathy strikes](#) in other municipalities if the mediation fails. The STT is expected to release more "VIP" interrogation summaries, potentially leading to [formal charges against Gintautas Paluckas](#).

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** Iran's regime will likely radicalize as [Revolutionary Guard generals](#) take greater control following Khamenei's death, potentially leading to a protracted insurgency rather than a stable pro-Western democracy. In Ukraine, a "Trump-brokered" peace summit is likely, which will

[pressure Kyiv to accept a frozen conflict](#) line along current military positions.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** The US refusal to back territorial integrity could lead to a [fragmentation of the Western bloc](#), with European nations seeking "strategic autonomy" in defense. Domestically, Lithuania may face a "brain drain" in the public sector unless [systemic reforms to teacher status](#) and public official ethics are implemented to restore trust in the state.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS**

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### **For International Policy:**

- The shift in US policy toward Ukraine's borders requires European allies to [re-evaluate security guarantees](#) for the Baltic States, as the "territorial integrity" norm is no longer absolute in Washington.
- The assassination of Khamenei necessitates a [new diplomatic strategy](#) for the Persian Gulf, focusing on "de-conflicting" oil transit routes before global shortages trigger a recession.
- Lithuania must leverage its position in the EU to [protect media independence](#) through the European Media Freedom Act, as domestic political pressure on LRT increases.

### **For Private Sector/Investors:**

- Energy-intensive industries should [hedge against prolonged oil price volatility](#) due to the instability in the Strait of Hormuz.
- Real estate developers in Lithuania should note the [rising demand in Jonava](#), driven by the German brigade's arrival, even as big-city markets like Vilnius face stagnation due to high costs.

- Investors in the Lithuanian tech/startup sector should monitor "lawfare" risks, as the [STT's focus on unexplained wealth](#) could increase regulatory scrutiny on high-net-worth individuals and political connections.
