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DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 2, 2026, marks a transformative and violent inflection point in Middle Eastern history. Following the confirmed death of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei in the opening hour of a massive joint U.S.-Israeli operation, the Islamic Republic of Iran has entered a state of fractured leadership and high-intensity conflict. The U.S. military, under the command of President Donald Trump and Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth, has initiated "Operation Epic Fury," a multi-stage campaign aimed at neutralizing Iran's nuclear and ballistic missile capabilities. The coalition claims to have struck over 1,000 targets in the first 24 hours, effectively decapitating the clerical and military leadership while destroying significant portions of the Iranian Navy and Air Force. In response, a leaderless but reactive IRGC has launched "True Promise IV," striking civilian and energy infrastructure across Saudi Arabia, Qatar, the

UAE, and Israel, successfully driving global oil and gold prices to record highs.

The internal stability of Iran is deteriorating rapidly. While the state has formed a Temporary Leadership Council to manage the crisis, reports indicate deep fractures within the remaining elite and the security apparatus. Mass celebrations by anti-government factions are occurring alongside organized mourning by loyalists, creating a volatile domestic environment. Concurrently, the humanitarian toll is mounting; a strike on a girl's school in Minab and the destruction of the Ghandi Hospital in Tehran have drawn international condemnation, though the U.S. and Israel deny intentional targeting. The conflict has now officially spilled over into Lebanon, with Israel conducting heavy strikes against Hezbollah in Beirut and southern Lebanon to prevent a northern front from opening. The geopolitical architecture of the region is being forcibly dismantled, with no clear diplomatic exit as the U.S. demands unconditional surrender and the total dismantling of the IRGC.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

The Decapitation of the Islamic Republic Leadership

- Confirmation that Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei was [killed in the initial minutes](#) of the U.S.-Israeli assault on Tehran.
- Formation of a Temporary Leadership Council consisting of President Masoud Pezeshkian, the Chief Justice, and Alireza Araf from the Guardian Council to [oversee the succession process](#) amid wartime chaos.

- The IRGC confirmed the deaths of seven high-ranking commanders, including the Deputy Chief of Staff for Intelligence and the [Head of the FARAJA Intelligence Organization](#).

Operation "Epic Fury" and U.S. Military Strategy

- President Trump and Defense Secretary Hegseth announced that the U.S. is prepared for a [campaign lasting four to five weeks](#) to ensure the total destruction of Iran's nuclear and missile infrastructure.
- The U.S. Air Force utilized B-2 and B-1 bombers in [36-hour non-stop missions](#) from the U.S. mainland to strike underground facilities in Iran.
- The U.S. Navy reported the [destruction of 10-11 Iranian warships](#) in the Persian Gulf and Sea of Oman within 48 hours.
- The U.S. confirmed at least [four military fatalities](#) and several injuries since the start of operations.

Regional Retaliation and Energy Market Shock

- Iran launched over 700 drones and hundreds of missiles at [500 regional targets](#), including U.S. bases and neighboring civilian infrastructure.
- Successful strikes on the [Ras Tanura refinery](#) in Saudi Arabia and the Ras Laffan gas facilities in Qatar have disrupted global supplies.
- Brent crude oil reached [over \\$82 per barrel](#), while gold prices surged by \$100 per ounce due to safe-haven demand.
- Hezbollah entered the conflict by launching rockets into Israel, prompting Israel to conduct [heavy bombardment of Beirut](#) and southern Lebanon.

Civilian Toll and Humanitarian Crisis

- An explosion at the Shajareh Tayyiba girl's school in Minab resulted in [165 confirmed deaths](#), the deadliest civilian incident of the war thus far.
- The Ghandi Hospital and [multiple medical centers](#) in Tehran, Ahvaz, and Hamedan suffered significant damage during airstrikes on nearby government buildings.
- Human rights organizations expressed grave concern over the [safety of political prisoners](#) in Evin and Zanjan jails, reporting that guards have abandoned posts without providing food or water.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Succession and Stability

- The constitutional mechanism of Article 111 was triggered to form a [Temporary Leadership Council](#), but its legitimacy is being questioned by IRGC hardliners and protesters.
- Larijani and other pragmatic elites are attempting to maintain a unified front, [denying any negotiations](#) with Washington to avoid appearing to capitulate under fire.
- The sudden removal of the "Supreme Leader" figurehead has left a power vacuum that the IRGC is struggling to fill via its "Mosaic Doctrine" of decentralized command [designed for regime survival](#).

Energy Security

- The shutdown of Aramco's Ras Tanura refinery and Qatari LNG production due to drone threats has placed [unprecedented pressure](#) on global energy security.

- Iran's "regionalization" of the war is intended to use energy markets as a [bargaining chip](#) to force a ceasefire from the international community.

Geopolitical Power Dynamics

- The U.S. and Israel have established a [unprecedented level of operational coordination](#), with Israel taking the lead on the Lebanese front while the U.S. focuses on the Iranian heartland.
- Turkey and Oman remain the [only remaining diplomatic channels](#), as Qatar and the UAE move closer to the U.S. coalition following Iranian strikes on their territories.
- The U.S. is openly calling for the [Iranian military to surrender](#) and hand power to the people, suggesting a "Venezuela-style" transition model.

Domestic Stability and Social Order

- Iran is experiencing a "dual reality" where [celebrations of Khamenei's death](#) in neighborhoods like Abadan and Tehran coexist with state-mandated mourning in other sectors.
- The total shutdown of the internet and communications in Iran is masking the [scale of internal dissent](#) and the regime's efforts to execute political prisoners during the cover of war.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative activity today was dominated by the U.S. President's use of war powers and the Iranian Leadership Council's attempts to maintain legal continuity. U.S. Congressional Democrats are increasingly vocal about the lack of formal war authorization, while the Iranian state is rushing to legitimize its new

governing body under existing constitutional articles.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **U.S. War Powers Resolution (Proposed):** Congressional Democrats are preparing a resolution to demand that President Trump [seek formal authorization](#) for a war that has exceeded the immediate "imminent threat" threshold.
- **Article 111 of the Iranian Constitution:** Invoked to create the [Temporary Leadership Council](#), providing a legal basis for President Pezeshkian to assume caretaker duties for the defunct Supreme Leadership.

- **White House Medal of Honor Ceremony:** President Trump utilized the event to provide a [strategic update on the war](#), claiming the Iranian nuclear program is "now finished" and the regime is in retreat.
- **Congressional Briefings:** Secretary of State Marco Rubio briefed Congressional leaders [behind closed doors](#) regarding the specific intelligence that prompted the pre-emptive strikes on Tehran.
- **IAEA Statement:** Director General Rafael Grossi confirmed that while Iran claims Natanz was hit, the IAEA [has seen no evidence](#) of radiation leaks or direct hits on core reactor vessels.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The End of the "Invincible" IRGC Myth

For decades, the IRGC projected an image of a force that could paralyze the world if touched. The transcripts reveal that this [deterrence has evaporated](#) in under 72 hours. The Regionalization of the Battlefield

Iran's decision to strike Kuwait, the UAE, and Qatar represents a "scorched earth" regional policy. By drawing neighboring states into the conflict via [attacks on energy hubs](#), Iran is betting that the global economic pain will force the West to the negotiating table. However, the transcripts show this is backfiring, as Gulf states have [issued joint](#)

[statements](#) with the U.S., signaling a move away from "neutrality" toward active participation in the anti-IRGC coalition.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks)

Expect a significant increase in civilian casualties as U.S. and Israeli forces move to "Level 2" targets—smaller IRGC bases and local security hubs [embedded in urban areas](#). The Leadership Council in Tehran will likely attempt to organize a state funeral for Khamenei to project stability, which could become a flashpoint for [large-scale civil unrest](#) or counter-protests. Hezbollah will likely expand its missile range to central Israel to alleviate pressure on Tehran, potentially triggering an Israeli ground invasion of Lebanon.

Medium Term (1-6 Months)

If the centralized government continues to erode, Iran may descend into a ["fragmented state" scenario](#), with different IRGC units controlling various provinces. This would create a long-term security headache for the U.S., as no central authority would exist to negotiate a surrender. Energy prices will likely remain high and volatile until the [safety of Gulf shipping](#) can be guaranteed, which may take months of naval escorting. A massive refugee crisis at the Turkish and Iraqi borders is imminent as the humanitarian situation inside Iran worsens.

Long Term (1-5 Years)

The structure of the Middle East will be permanently altered. The "Axis of Resistance" is facing a [fundamental collapse](#) of its ideological and financial center. Any future Iranian government will likely be forced into a

"normal state" status with no nuclear program and significantly reduced regional influence. The [monarchy or a secular republic](#) could emerge as a viable alternative, though the transition will be hampered by the total destruction of current state infrastructure.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- Establish immediate humanitarian corridors through Turkey and Jordan to manage the [inevitable mass migration](#) as Iranian urban centers lose basic services.
- Prepare a coordinated international energy release from strategic reserves to [counter the supply shocks](#) caused by the closure of Ras Tanura and Qatari LNG ports.
- Initiate "track-two" diplomacy with middle-ranking Iranian military officers to encourage [mass defections](#) before the total collapse of the state leads to uncontrolled civil war.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Diversify sourcing away from any maritime routes dependent on the Strait of Hormuz, as the [threat to commercial shipping](#) is now at its highest level in history.
- **Energy Costs:** Hedge against sustained oil prices above \$100, as the [damage to Saudi and Qatari infrastructure](#) may take months to repair.
- **Security Assets:** Increased investment in regional security and cybersecurity is mandatory, as Iran is likely to [utilize cyberwarfare](#) against global financial institutions as a low-cost asymmetric response.
