### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 2, 2026, marks a pivotal moment in global geopolitics, characterized by the catastrophic escalation of conflict in the Middle East following the confirmed death of Iranian Grand Ayatollah Ali Khamenei during joint U.S.-Israeli strikes. The "Furia Épica" (Epic Fury) operation has reportedly neutralized 48 high-ranking Iranian leaders, prompting a massive retaliatory strike from the Revolutionary Guard against regional targets, including U.S. and UK maritime assets. This has led to the [de facto closure](#) of the Strait of Hormuz, causing a 10% surge in global oil prices and forcing the OPEC+ alliance to implement an emergency production increase of over 200,000 barrels per day to stabilize volatile markets.

Domestically, Venezuela is navigating a complex institutional "reset" following the "sucesos del 3 de enero" (January 3rd events),

which resulted in the removal/capture of Nicolás Maduro and the installation of Delcy Rodríguez as [Presidenta Encargada](#) (Acting President). The administration is aggressively pursuing a policy of "re-institutionalization" through the application of a sweeping Amnesty Law—with over 5,600 releases confirmed—and the opening of a [nomination process](#) for the Fiscal General and Defensor del Pueblo. This domestic pivot is coupled with a pragmatic opening to the U.S. energy sector, framed as essential for national survival, while simultaneously mobilizing community-level "Consultas Populares" scheduled for March 8 to legitimize the new governance structure.

### MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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- **Operation "Epic Fury" and the Death of Khamenei:** U.S. and Israeli forces conducted a decisive strike on Iranian command structures, killing the Supreme Leader and [dismantling the military hierarchy](#). A transitional council led by Masud Pezeshkian has assumed temporary control in Tehran as the "Assembly of Experts" meets to name a successor. [Retaliatory Iranian strikes](#) have targeted the office of the Israeli Prime Minister and regional airports, while the Strait of Hormuz remains a high-risk zone for global trade.

- **Venezuelan Transition and Amnesty Law:** The Rodríguez administration reported that 5,628 citizens have received [full liberty](#) under the Law for Democratic Coexistence (Amnesty Law). The government is positioning itself as a pragmatic partner for the U.S., with Acting President Rodríguez urging President Trump to [lift all sanctions](#) to facilitate the global energy response to the Middle East crisis.
- **Hydrocarbons Law Reform and Energy Pivot:** Following the rapid approval of reforms to the Organic Law of Hydrocarbons, Venezuela is positioning its oil reserves as the ["aspirin" for global energy](#) headaches. Private sector analysts anticipate a significant influx of foreign capital, particularly from U.S. firms like Chevron, as the country moves from "intensive care" toward economic rehabilitation.
- **Public Health Emergency: Yellow Fever Outbreak:** A significant health alert has been issued for the states of Lara, Aragua, Barinas, and Portuguesa due to a [Yellow Fever outbreak](#). The government has launched a mass vaccination campaign targeting citizens aged 1 to 59, emphasizing vector control as the virus spreads through 22 parishes.
- **Mobile World Congress 2026:** In Barcelona, the tech world is showcasing [6G integration](#), humanoid robotics, and autonomous AI agents. For the second year, Venezuelan media is emphasizing these developments as part of a national push for "digital sovereignty" and economic modernization.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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**Succession & Stability:** The aftermath of January 3rd dominates Venezuelan governance. Acting President Delcy Rodríguez is consolidating power by emphasizing "democracy from the grassroots" through [Consultas Populares](#) and filling key vacancies in the moral power branch. The nomination period for Fiscal General and Defensor del Pueblo is open until March 9, framed as a step toward [transparency and equanimity](#). In Iran, the succession process for the Supreme Leader is under extreme duress, with the [Assembly of Experts](#) forced to meet amidst active hostilities.

**Energy Security:** The Middle East war has transformed Venezuelan oil into a strategic imperative. Analysts suggest that Venezuela's "rehabilitation" is the only viable path to prevent [U.S. gasoline prices](#) from exceeding \$5 or \$6 per gallon. The "architecture of licenses" and the recent reform of the Hydrocarbons Law are intended to bring the [private sector back](#) into a dominant operational role, moving away from the failed state-centric model of previous decades.

**International Relations & Foreign Policy:** A dramatic shift in rhetoric toward the United States is evident. Former rivals now characterize the relationship as ["obligatorily constructive"](#) and based on mutual respect. The Rodríguez administration is signaling a desire for a meso-American energy alliance that includes Mexico and Colombia to counter the "unipolar" influence of the U.S., while [appealing to Trump's](#) transactional nature by offering oil in exchange for an end to the "blockade."

**Biosurveillance & Disease Outbreaks:** The Ministry of Health is managing a "Red Alert" for [Yellow Fever](#). Compulsory vaccination is

being enforced for travel to rural and forested areas, with state media providing extensive coverage of the virus's [incubation period](#) and vector breeding habits. This is being used as a test of state capacity in a post-transition environment.

**Investment Climate & Regulatory Environment:** The business community, represented by groups like VenAmCham, is reporting a ["tsunami" of foreign interest](#). However, risks remain regarding the "legal warfare" and institutional decay of the last 20 years. Proposals are circulating to eliminate the [IGTF \(Large Financial Transaction Tax\)](#) and reduce VAT to stimulate domestic consumption as part of a 18-to-24-month stabilization phase.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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The current legislative agenda is focused on purging the previous legal framework to facilitate foreign investment and domestic reconciliation. Press events have emphasized that the rule of law is being restored through "balanced" and "transparent" processes.

- **Amnesty Law (Law for Democratic Coexistence):** The primary mechanism for social pacification, allowing for the [release of thousands](#) of political and social detainees to lower domestic tensions.
- **Organic Law of Hydrocarbons (Reforms):** Recently amended to allow [increased private participation](#) in operational control of oil fields, moving away from the state-majority requirement in joint ventures.
- **Gender Parity Law (Proposed):** The "Vamos Venezuela" faction is preparing a bill to mandate [50/50 gender parity](#) in all public and private executive positions.

- **IGTF Elimination Proposal:** Political factions are lobbying for the removal of the tax on [dollar transactions](#) to facilitate the formalization of the economy.

## HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Fiscal/Defensor Nomination Launch:** The Parliamentary Commission announced the [reception of credentials](#) at the Palacio Federal Legislativo from March 2 to March 9.
- **UCV Forum on Understanding:** Academic and political leaders met at the Universidad Central de Venezuela to discuss ["stabilization and change"](#), emphasizing the need for rules of engagement between the government and opposition.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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**The End of Ideology, The Return of Realism:** The most striking trend is the total abandonment of socialist "anti-imperialist" rhetoric in favor of naked realism. Leaders who once decried U.S. interference now speak of ["tragar grueso" \(swallowing pride\)](#) to ensure national survival. The January 3rd "rupture" is being processed as a hard lesson in the limits of sovereignty for a collapsing state. This is reflected in the [rebranding of the energy sector](#) as a service provider to the Western world rather than an ideological weapon.

**Institutional "Reset" and Controlled Legitimacy:** The Rodríguez administration is using the "March 8 Consultation" to create a veneer of [grassroots participation](#) while the high-level institutional changes (Amnesty, Fiscal General) are managed by a narrow elite. This dual-track approach aims to

appease the international community (through legal reforms) while maintaining domestic control (through communal financing). The inclusion of moderate figures like Enrique Márquez in [U.S. diplomatic circles](#) suggests a move toward a "pluralist" but highly managed political transition.

#### **Energy Geopolitics as Survival Strategy:**

The war in Iran has gifted the Venezuelan transition a "golden window." By positioning themselves as the only alternative to Middle Eastern oil, the Venezuelan government is banking on the [indispensability of its crude](#). This "energy blackmail in reverse" seeks to trade oil production for a complete removal from the U.S. sanctions regime, bypassing traditional democratic requirements.

### **STRATEGIC FORESIGHT**

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect the March 8th community vote to be touted as a [major victory](#) for the "new era." The Fiscal General and Defensor del Pueblo will likely be appointed by mid-March, with names carefully selected to appear "technical" and "non-partisan." Oil prices will remain volatile, potentially hitting \$100 if the [Strait of Hormuz](#) remains blocked. Yellow Fever vaccination rates will become a key metric of state effectiveness.

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** Major U.S. oil majors will likely receive [expanded operational licenses](#), leading to a slow but steady increase in Venezuelan production. The Amnesty Law will continue to serve as a pressure valve, though a small "hard-line" contingent within the Chavismo movement may attempt to sabotage the "rapprochement" with Washington. In the Middle East, a "frozen conflict" or a protracted insurgent war in Iran

will keep the [war risk premium](#) high on global commodities.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** Venezuela will likely undergo a structural shift toward a [multi-currency economy](#) with a neutered central bank, effectively becoming a dollarized energy colony with communal social layers. The success of this model depends entirely on the durability of the U.S.-Venezuela energy "peace." Structurally, the Middle East will remain fractured, potentially seeing a [nuclear-armed](#) Saudi Arabia or Turkey as they respond to the collapse of the Iranian deterrent.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS**

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#### **For International Policy:**

- The international community should monitor the [Amnesty Law](#) implementation closely; the release of social detainees must be paired with genuine judicial reform to ensure lasting stability.
- The shift in [Iranian leadership](#) creates a vacuum; diplomatic efforts must focus on preventing the "Assembly of Experts" from selecting an even more radical hard-liner who might use remaining asymmetric assets to further disrupt global trade.
- U.S. policy should decouple "energy security" from "regime change," utilizing the current Venezuelan [willingness to negotiate](#) to secure long-term supply contracts.

## For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Sector Opportunity:** The [reform of the Hydrocarbons Law](#) represents the most significant investment opening in 25 years. Firms should prepare for "joint venture 2.0" structures with increased operational control.
- **Supply Chain Risk:** The closure of Hormuz will affect [fertilizer and polymer](#) prices globally. Manufacturers should look to Latin American sources for raw materials to mitigate Middle Eastern exposure.
- **Health & Safety Compliance:** Companies operating in rural Venezuela must implement strict [Yellow Fever protocols](#) for all staff; vaccination is no longer optional for business travel to the central and western plains.
