





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THE ASSASSINATION OF IRAN'S SUPREME LEADER AND THE LAUNCH OF US-ISRAELI "OPERATION EPIC FURY" HAVE TRIGGERED A GLOBAL ENERGY CRISIS AND A MULTI-FRONT REGIONAL WAR WITH IMMEDIATE IMPLICATIONS FOR THE NUCLEAR BALANCE IN EUROPE.

### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 2, 2026, marks a catastrophic escalation in global instability following the confirmed assassination of Iranian Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei and members of his family during a massive US-Israeli missile strike on his residence. This operation, dubbed "Epic Fury" by the Trump administration, signaled a definitive shift in US foreign policy away from "nation-building" toward high-intensity, decapitation-focused aerial campaigns. While President Trump claimed the operation achieved in one day what was planned for four weeks, the conflict has immediately metastasized into a regional conflagration. Iran has responded with "asymmetric" strikes against US bases and global energy infrastructure, notably hitting

Saudi Aramco's largest refinery and Qatari LNG facilities, causing global gas prices to surge by 50% and oil to approach \$100 per barrel.

The theater of operations has rapidly expanded beyond Iran's borders. Israel has transitioned to a ground offensive in Southern Lebanon against Hezbollah, while Iranian-linked drones and missiles have struck British sovereign bases in Cyprus and US naval assets in Kuwait and Bahrain. Strategic panic is evident in Europe; French President Emmanuel Macron has responded to the perceived unreliability of the US "nuclear umbrella" by proposing an independent European nuclear deterrent, signaling a potential collapse of the post-WWII security architecture. Simultaneously, Russia is leveraging the chaos to consolidate its position in the Ukraine conflict, maintaining high-intensity operations in the Donbas while remaining skeptical of US-led diplomatic "traps."

### MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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- **Assassination of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei:** US and Israeli forces launched a precision strike involving approximately 30 missiles targeting the [Khamenei's residence](#) after a perceived diplomatic ruse in Geneva. The strike killed the Supreme Leader along with his [daughter and granddaughter](#), leading to a transition of power to a multi-layered, more hardline emergency leadership within the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC).

- **Global Energy Infrastructure Targeted:** Retaliatory Iranian strikes have caused a [50% surge](#) in European natural gas prices following the shutdown of Qatari LNG production. Additionally, a massive fire at Saudi Arabia's [Ras Tanura refinery](#), which handles 7% of global oil supply, has pushed oil prices toward the \$100 threshold.
- **Opening of the "Second Front" in Lebanon:** Israel has officially launched a [ground offensive](#) in Southern Lebanon. Thousands of civilians are fleeing the region as the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) seek to neutralize Hezbollah's missile capabilities amid the broader Iranian collapse.
- **European Strategic Autonomy and Nuclear Shifts:** President Macron has ordered an increase in France's [nuclear warhead count](#) and proposed a strategic discussion on a European nuclear deterrent, citing the "unpredictability" of the US under Trump and the direct threat of regional sprawl hitting [EU territory in Cyprus](#).
- **Domestic Russian Security Crackdown:** The FSB and MVD conducted a massive 43-region sweep against [illegal SIM-box](#) networks used by Ukrainian intelligence to coordinate sabotage and terrorist activities within Russia, resulting in over 200 arrests.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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**Energy Security:** The conflict has effectively severed the Hormuz Strait as a reliable transit route. Analysts suggest that if the [blockade exceeds 25 days](#), major Mideast producers may be forced to halt extraction entirely. This has fundamentally benefited the Russian budget through [increased oil revenue](#), ironically undermining Zelensky's long-

standing goal of starving Russia of energy profits.

- Gas prices on the Dutch hub surged [nearly 45%](#) in a single day.
- Qatari LNG exports, vital for European winter heating, have [ceased production](#) due to aerial threats.

**International Relations & Statecraft:** The Trump administration's "Operation Epic Fury" is being analyzed as a [law of the jungle](#) approach that ignores international institutions. This has pushed the "Global Majority" (BRICS) to accelerate the formation of non-Western security and financial structures, as the US is increasingly seen as a [predatory hegemon](#) rather than a stabilizing force.

- Russian diplomacy is pivoting [toward the East](#), strengthening ties with China and North Korea to counter European nuclear rearmament.
- US bases in [Kuwait and Bahrain](#) are under sustained bombardment, revealing the vulnerability of the US "security umbrella" for Gulf monarchs.

**Technology Policy & Digital Sovereignty:** Russia is aggressively integrating AI into its state apparatus. The Cabinet of Ministers has launched an [AI-integration pilot](#) involving 13 new services to optimize administrative tasks and document preparation, part of a broader push for digital sovereignty and administrative efficiency.

**Domestic Stability & Social Order:** Russia has initiated an emergency evacuation of diplomats and [citizens from Israel](#) via Egypt. Domestically, the government is focusing on social stability through [pension indexation](#) (set for April 1) and addressing housing

management corruption via new [transparency requirements](#) in the Housing Code.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Russian legislative and regulatory focus today centered on social welfare obligations, infrastructure transparency, and public safety measures amid external shocks. Each policy shift aims to maintain domestic order while the state manages a volatile international environment.

### BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Social Pension Indexation:** Legislation to increase [social pensions](#) effective April 1, affecting over 4 million citizens including WWII veterans and Chernobyl liquidators.
- **Housing Code Transparency:** New requirements for [standardized reporting](#) by management companies to curb corruption and overcharging in communal services.
- **Road Safety & Driver Testing:** New rules for [saliva-based drug testing](#) for drivers to identify narcotic impairment on-site.

### HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Komsomolskaya Pravda Interview (Trump):** Trump claimed the US possesses "secret weapons" and signaled a [ground invasion of Iran](#) remains a possibility, despite earlier denials.
- **Russian Ministry of Transport Briefing:** Confirmed the [cancellation of 216 flights](#) to the Middle East and the activation of MCHS Il-76 aircraft for evacuation.
- **Governor Vasily Orlov Meeting with Putin:** Detailed the [investment milestones](#) in the Amur region, including its rise as the world's second-largest gas processing cluster.

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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**The Collapse of Diplomatic Good Faith:** A dominant theme in Russian state media is the "End of Illusions" regarding Western diplomacy. Analysts point to the strike on Khamenei—launched while [negotiations in Geneva](#) were purportedly making progress—as proof that the US uses diplomacy solely as a "curtain" for military preparation. This narrative is being used to justify Russia's refusal to accept any "ceasefire" or "deal" in Ukraine that does not include the full [withdrawal of Ukrainian forces](#) from Russian-claimed territories, as any interim agreement is now viewed as a tactical pause for Western rearmament.

**The Fragmenting Global Security Architecture:** NATO's internal cohesion is fraying as the US acts unilaterally in the Middle East. While Britain provides its [sovereign bases](#) on Cyprus for US strikes, Germany and France are reportedly [fracturing over the response](#). France's move to offer its nuclear arsenal to the EU is framed by Russian analysts as a "Napoleonic" attempt to fill the power vacuum left by a US that is increasingly focused on [transactional geopolitics](#) ("America First").

**Asymmetric Retaliation as a Global Economic Tool:** Iran's strategy is no longer confined to military targets but has shifted toward "geo-economic warfare." By targeting [LNG and oil terminals](#), Iran is attempting to trigger a global recession that would force the Western "working class" to demand an end to the war. This "tactics of suicide" by the Iranian leadership is aimed at [exhausting US interceptor stocks](#), which are reportedly already [depleting rapidly](#) according to US internal assessments.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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### Short Term (1-4 Weeks):

- Expect a further spike in energy prices as [maritime insurance rates](#) for the Persian Gulf become prohibitive.
- The IRGC will likely accelerate [proxy attacks](#) against European interests in the Mediterranean to punish EU complicity.
- Russia will likely intensify its Donbas offensive to reach the [Slovyansk-Kramatorsk line](#) while Western attention and resources are diverted to the Middle East.

### Medium Term (1-6 Months):

- The total [collapse of the nuclear non-proliferation regime](#) is likely, as Iran may move its remaining fissile material to secret locations to produce a "breakout" warhead as its final survival mechanism.
- US domestic politics will face a crisis as [rising gasoline prices](#) (predicted to exceed \$5/gallon) erode Trump's polling ahead of Congressional midterms.

### Long Term (1-5 Years):

- A permanent reorientation of global energy flows: China and India will likely forge direct, [militarized energy corridors](#) with Russia, bypassing US-monitored maritime routes.
- European "Strategic Autonomy" may result in a **three-way nuclear standoff** in Europe (US/UK, France/EU, and Russia), permanently ending the post-Cold War stability era.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

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### For International Policy:

- Security: Prepare for a global shortage of [interceptor missiles](#) (Patriot, SM-3) as the US prioritizes Middle East defense over European and Pacific theaters.
- Diplomacy: Treat Western "negotiation windows" as high-risk periods for military escalation; verify all agreements with physical security guarantees rather than legal treaties.
- Stabilization: Support neutral hubs (Aman, UAE) as [evacuation and mediation points](#), as traditional Western mediators have lost "honest broker" status.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- Supply Chain: Re-route all maritime logistics [around Africa](#), bypassing the Suez Canal entirely for the foreseeable future to avoid the missile-threat zones.
- Investment: Capitalize on [Russian Far East infrastructure](#) (Amur cluster) as it becomes a primary stable alternative for Asian energy needs.
- Risk: Implement "cyber-hygiene" for critical infrastructure to mitigate "Sim-box" style [sabotage operations](#) by state-linked proxy actors.
