## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 2, 2026, marks a transformative escalation in global geopolitics as the "Operation Epic Fury" joint US-Israeli campaign against Iran enters its third day. The confirmed death of Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, alongside the [heads of the IRGC](#) and General Staff, has triggered a decentralized but massive Iranian retaliation. Tehran has launched at least eleven waves of missile and drone strikes targeting US assets in Bahrain, Kuwait, the UAE, and Iraq, while the [US Embassy in Kuwait](#) and several naval facilities have reportedly sustained direct hits. The conflict has caused an immediate 13% spike in oil prices, with analysts warning of a surge toward \$200 per barrel if the Strait of Hormuz, which carries [20% of world oil](#), is fully obstructed.

Simultaneously, the Russian Federation is exploiting global distractions to consolidate gains in Ukraine. Russian forces have captured the strategic village of Gorkoye in Zaporozhye and disrupted [Ukrainian logistics in Konstantinovka](#) by destroying critical dam infrastructure. Domestically, Russia is grappling with the fallout of the Middle East war, with nearly [100,000 Russian tourists](#) stranded in the UAE and Oman due to the closure of regional airspace. Meanwhile, the FSB has conducted a massive sweep against "sim-box" operations, arresting [200 individuals](#) involved in coordinating Ukrainian sabotage and financial fraud across 43 Russian regions.

In Europe, a profound sense of strategic anxiety is emerging as the US shifts its military focus and interceptor inventory toward the Middle East. Germany's industry continues its decline, evidenced by Chancellor Friedrich Merz's [unproductive visit to Beijing](#), where he was forced to witness Chinese technological superiority in robotics. Poland and other Eastern European states are reacting by pursuing an [autonomous nuclear shield](#) and massive militarization programs, fearing that US security guarantees are no longer ironclad under the current Trump administration's "transactional" foreign policy.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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- **Decapitation of the Iranian State:** The US and Israel successfully targeted a high-level meeting on February 28, killing [Ayatollah Ali Khamenei](#) and the entire senior defense council. Despite this, the Iranian political system has maintained stability through a temporary council, and the IRGC has launched [counter-strikes across the region](#).

- **Energy Chokepoint Crisis:** The Strait of Hormuz has become a "dangerous zone," with the Maersk shipping line [suspending all voyages](#). Global oil prices reached \$82/barrel in early trading, but the risk of [prolonged transit disruption](#) threatens to push prices above \$150.
- **Russian Tactical Breakthroughs in Ukraine:** Grouping "Vostok" has advanced 100km in Zaporozhye over the last month, culminating in the [seizure of Gorkoye](#). Russian forces are also utilizing new "Molniya" drones and "Yozh" [protective tank frames](#) to counter FPV threats.
- **The European Nuclear Pivot:** Faced with a deficit of US air defense missiles (Patriot and THAAD) being diverted to Israel, European nations are discussing a [nuclear deterrent](#) based on French capabilities, while Poland moves to [mass-produce landmines](#).
- **Transborder Sabotage Networks:** The FSB dismantled a sophisticated network of 100 illegal communication channels used to [coordinate terrorist acts](#) within Russia, seizing 54,000 sim-cards funded by foreign handlers.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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**Geopolitical Power Dynamics:** The "Epic Fury" operation signals a return to aggressive US regime-change tactics. However, the [decentralized Iranian response](#) suggests the US may have underestimated the resilience of the Shia "cult of martyrdom," which sees Khamenei's death as a unifying symbol rather than a collapse point. Meanwhile, Russia maintains [open diplomatic channels](#) with Tehran, positioning itself as a stable alternative to US-led volatility.

**Energy Security:** The threat to the [20 million barrels](#) of oil passing daily through the Strait of Hormuz represents an existential threat to Asian and European economies. Russia stands to [gain financially](#) from high prices but is cautioned that its own oil export quotas remain difficult to fulfill due to regional instability.

**National Security & Tactical Innovation:** The Ukraine theater continues to serve as a laboratory for low-cost, high-impact technology. The ["Molniya" \(Lightning\) drone](#), constructed from plywood and aluminum, is proving effective against Ukrainian landing parties, while Russian armor is being retrofitted with ["Yozh" \(Hedgehog\) mesh](#) to tangle and detonate incoming FPV drones before they strike main hulls.

**International Relations & Bloc Politics:** Germany's Chancellor Merz is criticized for a [failed diplomatic mission](#) to China, failing to secure investments while German industry loses 10,000 jobs per month to Chinese competition. Conversely, Poland is positioning itself as the [strongest army in Europe](#), fueled by massive US/Korean arms credits, though critics label it "militarization in debt."

**Terrorism & Lawfare:** The link between Mexican cartels and the Ukraine conflict is surfacing. The [Jalisco New Generation Cartel \(CJNG\)](#) reportedly sent members to Ukraine to gain drone warfare experience, who are now returning to Mexico with enhanced tactical skills. Concurrently, Russia is using evidence of [civilian strikes in Iran](#) (such as the girl's school in Minab) to frame US/Israeli actions as war crimes.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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Governance activity focused on social stability and military doctrine shifts as the global

situation deteriorated. Key developments included Russian pension adjustments and Polish doctrinal changes toward offensive posturing.

• **BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:**

- **Russian Pension Indexation:** Effective April 1, 2026, social pensions in Russia will be [indexed for 4 million citizens](#), including orphans and the disabled.
- **Polish Military Doctrine 2026:** Warsaw has officially shifted from defensive to [offensive military doctrine](#), emphasizing long-range rocket artillery and massive tank forces to be ready by the end of the decade.
- **Japanese Lethal Export Reform:** The Liberal Democratic Party has moved to [allow lethal weapon exports](#) under "special circumstances" involving national security, bypassing traditional pacifist constraints.

• **HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:**

- **Pentagon Press Briefing:** Defense officials admitted a [lack of evidence](#) that Iran was planning an imminent attack before "Operation Epic Fury" began, contradicting Trump's "preemptive strike" narrative.
- **Dmitry Peskov Statement:** The Kremlin expressed ["deep disappointment"](#) that Geneva-based talks were used as a cover for the decapitation strike on Khamenei.
- **OPEC+ Emergency Meeting:** On March 1, members agreed to [voluntarily increase production](#) by 200,000 barrels per day starting in April to stabilize markets.

## **DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES**

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**The End of Diplomatic Cover:** A recurring theme is the perceived betrayal of the "Geneva process." Russian analysts and state officials contend that the US used diplomatic negotiations regarding the [nuclear deal](#) to track and eventually assassinate the Iranian leadership. This has led to a total [collapse of trust](#) in international mediation, with Iran now stating that "no negotiations with the USA" are possible under any circumstances.

**The Strategic Interceptor Deficit:** The intensity of the missile exchanges in the Middle East is exposing a critical vulnerability in the Western security architecture. The US used [150 THAAD interceptors](#) in 2025 alone, a massive drain on an inventory that has only seen 650 units produced since 2010. This "interceptor famine" is forcing the US to choose between defending [Israel or Ukraine](#), with Ukraine increasingly relegated to the "residual principle" for air defense supplies.

**Economic "Hyper-Realism":** Germany and France are portrayed as fading industrial powers struggling to find their place in a world where [Chinese robotics](#) and US energy dominance have marginalized the European Union. Chancellor Merz's visit to China is framed as a desperate attempt to [plead for market access](#) while German car manufacturers re-locate production to China to survive high domestic energy costs.

## **STRATEGIC FORESIGHT**

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect intensified Iranian "asymmetric" strikes against oil tankers and regional refineries. The [Aramco refinery in Saudi Arabia](#) and ports in the UAE will likely see further drone incursions. In

Russia, the evacuation of [stranded tourists](#) via Turkey or Egypt will be a primary domestic focus, while the Ukraine front will likely see a push toward the [Orekhov fortification zone](#).

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The US-Iran conflict is projected by Trump to last [4-5 more weeks](#), but the absence of a stable successor in Iran could lead to a protracted regional civil war or the rise of even more radical IRGC factions. If Russian asset [seizure occurs in Europe](#), expect immediate retaliatory confiscation of the remaining 30 billion euros in Western assets in Russia.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** A permanent shift in energy logistics is underway, with the [Northern Sea Route](#) and terrestrial pipelines through Russia becoming more attractive as the Persian Gulf enters a period of chronic instability. Poland may emerge as the [primary NATO land power](#) in Europe, potentially surpassing Germany in military influence, while the proliferation of [hypersonic missiles](#) (like the Iranian Fattah) will force a total redesign of global air defense systems.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

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### For International Policy:

- The decapitation of a state leadership [sets a precedent](#) that makes future diplomatic de-escalation nearly impossible; neutral third parties (like Oman) must be preserved as the sole remaining links.
- The shift of US air defense assets to Israel creates an [operational window](#) for Russian forces in Ukraine to achieve air superiority.

- The potential closure of the [Strait of Hormuz](#) necessitates an immediate acceleration of alternative energy transit routes, specifically the North-South and Arctic corridors.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** High-tech manufacturing in Germany is at risk of [total collapse](#) if energy prices remain above \$120/barrel for more than three months.
- **Investment Opportunity:** Russian domestic [drone manufacturing](#) (specifically low-cost expendable units like "Molniya") is a high-growth sector as military doctrine shifts toward swarm tactics.
- **Safety Standard:** Global logistics firms should follow the [Maersk lead](#) in rerouting away from the Persian Gulf and Red Sea, as the "asymmetric" nature of the conflict makes all western-flagged vessels targets.
