## DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 3, 2026, marks a pivotal breakdown in global stability as the Middle East enters a state of total war following the U.S.-Israeli decapitation strike against the Iranian leadership, designated "Operation Epic Fury." Russian state media reports the [death of Iran's Supreme Leader](#) (Rahbar) along with members of his family, an event that has failed to trigger the internal collapse anticipated by Washington and has instead consolidated the Iranian public behind the regime. Iran has responded with a massive "thirteenth wave" of retaliatory [missile and drone strikes](#) targeting U.S. and Israeli assets across the region, including bases in Kuwait, the UAE, Bahrain, and Iraq. Most significantly, Iran has declared the [full closure of the Strait of Hormuz](#), through which 20-25% of the world's oil flows, triggering an immediate spike in energy

prices with oil reaching \$85 and gas exceeding \$700 per thousand cubic meters.

While the U.S. administration under Donald Trump claims the operation is progressing faster than planned, domestic cracks are widening. The "Epstein Files" scandal continues to haunt the American political elite, with [Bill and Hillary Clinton](#) facing intense Congressional interrogation over their ties to the deceased financier. Simultaneously, the U.S. is reportedly facing a [critical shortage of interceptor missiles](#) (SM-3 and Patriot) and Tomahawks due to the intensity of the conflict, threatening U.S. strategic readiness against China and Russia. Russia is leveraging this geopolitical distraction to accelerate its "Special Military Operation" (SMO) in Ukraine, reporting the capture of settlements in [Zaporizhzhia and Sumy](#) while positioning itself as a diplomatic mediator for Middle Eastern monarchies increasingly skeptical of the U.S. "security umbrella."

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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### The Decapitation of the Iranian Leadership and Regional Retaliation

- The U.S. and Israel executed a strike on Tehran that [killed the Supreme Leader](#), his daughter, and grandchildren, an act described by Russian analysts as "state terrorism."
- A strike on a [school in the city of Minab](#) reportedly killed 170 young girls, fueling intense anti-Western sentiment across the Islamic world.
- Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) claimed successful [strikes on U.S. bases](#) in Kuwait (Al-Ahmadi), Dubai, and the U.S. embassy in Riyadh.

- The IRGC has threatened to [burn any tanker](#) attempting to navigate the now-closed Strait of Hormuz.

### **Global Energy and Economic Shockwaves**

- Brent crude oil has surpassed \$85 per barrel, while [European gas prices](#) surged by 45% to over \$700 per thousand cubic meters due to the halt of Qatar's LNG exports.
- More than [150 tankers](#) are currently anchored outside the Strait of Hormuz, unable to transit due to military risks and the suspension of insurance coverage.
- Analysts predict oil could [reach \\$200 per barrel](#) if the blockade continues, posing an existential threat to the economies of China and Europe.

### **The Collapse of Nuclear Non-Proliferation and European Autonomy**

- French President Emmanuel Macron has declared a ["new nuclear era,"](#) ordering an increase in France's nuclear arsenal and offering a "European nuclear umbrella" to allies like Germany and Poland.
- Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov warned that the war against Iran will likely [stimulate nuclear proliferation](#) as regional powers realize that only nuclear deterrence can prevent U.S.-led regime change.
- Work has been halted at the [Bushehr Nuclear Power Plant](#) in Iran, with 600 Russian specialists awaiting evacuation amidst fears of a regional nuclear catastrophe.

### **U.S. Strategic Overreach and Military Depletion**

- The U.S. Navy is reportedly [consuming its annual stock](#) of critical missiles (SM-3) in just weeks, forcing the Pentagon to consider tapping into Pacific reserves meant to deter China.
- A significant portion of the U.S. aerial refueling fleet and [half of its aircraft carriers](#) are now tied down in the Middle East.

### **The Evolution of the Ukraine Conflict**

- Russia captured the settlements of [Veselyanka \(Zaporizhzhia\)](#) and Bobylevka (Sumy), utilizing the West's focus on Iran to apply "maximal pressure."
- Volodymyr Zelensky has offered to send [anti-drone specialists](#) to the Middle East in exchange for a one-month ceasefire with Russia, a move mocked by analysts as a "desperate trade proposal."

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### **Energy Security and Supply Chains**

- The Hormuz blockade has disrupted [global supplies of sulfur, ammonia, and phosphates](#), in addition to oil and gas, threatening global agriculture and industrial production.

- The development of ["Judgment Day Drones"](#) for radiation and gas detection highlights the shift toward autonomous platforms in CBRN (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear) environments.

## Geopolitical Power Dynamics

- The Middle East conflict is interpreted as a U.S. strike against the [emerging multipolar world](#), specifically targeting China's energy security and Russia's regional influence.

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### The Weaponization of Deception

However, the immediate military implication is the neutralization of expensive armored platforms and manned

aircraft by low-cost, expendable autonomous systems.

### The Strategic Re-Alignment of the Middle East

The Arab monarchies are experiencing a "crisis of confidence" in their alliance with the U.S. Analysts note that while the [U.S. defense umbrella](#) is working for Israel, it has failed to protect Saudi and Emirati oil infrastructure from Iranian retaliation. This is pushing regional powers toward a "multi-vector" foreign policy, with Putin actively [engaging leaders](#) in Saudi Arabia, the UAE, and Bahrain to offer Russia as a more reliable security partner.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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### Short Term (1-4 Weeks):

- Expect a further [escalation of maritime strikes](#) in the Persian Gulf as Iran seeks to enforce the Hormuz blockade and drive oil prices toward \$100.
- The humanitarian crisis in Iran, particularly following the [Minab school bombing](#), will likely trigger widespread civil unrest and protests against U.S. interests globally.
