### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 3, 2026, presents a stark global dichotomy: China is heavily invested in a domestic narrative of "Whole-Process People's Democracy" and cultural celebration, while the Middle East descends into what appears to be a full-scale regional war. State media is prioritizing the lead-up to the "Two Sessions" (NPC and CPPCC) and the drafting of the **15th Five-Year Plan**, framing the Chinese governance model as a "more authentic and effective" alternative to Western systems. This domestic focus on long-term planning, "new quality productive forces" like **Artificial Intelligence**, and social harmony during the Lantern Festival serves as a deliberate counter-narrative to the chaos unfolding in West Asia.

The international landscape is dominated by a massive US-Israeli air and ground campaign against **Iran**. Reports indicate devastating

strikes on Iranian leadership facilities, nuclear sites, and civilian infrastructure, including a school in Minab. Iran has responded with "Operation True Promise 4," launching waves of missiles and drones at US bases in Bahrain, Iraq, and the UAE, while threatening to completely **blockade the Strait of Hormuz**. The resulting surge in international oil prices and the sharp decline in global equity markets signal a period of extreme geopolitical instability that China is navigating through tactical evacuations and diplomatic calls for restraint.

### MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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#### Unprecedented US-Israeli Military Campaign Against Iran

- The US and Israel have entered the fourth day of [sustained military strikes](#) against Iranian targets, including Tehran, Isfahan, and Bushehr.
- Israeli forces have reportedly destroyed Iran's "propaganda and media center" and targeted the [President's Office](#) and National Security Council buildings.
- The humanitarian toll is rising, with [787 reported deaths](#), including 165 schoolgirls in a single incident in Minab, which Iran is using to mobilize international condemnation.
- Iran has retaliated by striking [US bases in Bahrain](#) (Shaikh Isa Air Base) and the UAE, claiming to have hit THAAD missile defense systems.

#### Global Energy and Economic Shockwaves

- International oil prices have spiked significantly, with [Brent crude reaching \\$81.40](#) per barrel, a rise of nearly 5% in a single session.

- Iran has declared the Strait of Hormuz [effectively blocked](#), with dozens of oil tankers reportedly idling or halted near the chokepoint.
- Major stock indices in Europe and the US, including the [DAX and CAC 40](#), have seen sharp declines exceeding 3% as markets price in regional war.

### China's "Two Sessions" and 15th Five-Year Plan Rollout

- State media is flooding the airwaves with the concept of [whole-process people's democracy](#), emphasizing that grassroots voices are reaching the highest levels of decision-making.
- The CPPCC (National Committee) is set to open its session on [March 4](#), with a heavy focus on the 15th Five-Year Plan drafting process.
- The government is highlighting its [response to 8,754 suggestions](#) from delegates over the past year to prove administrative efficiency.

### Accelerated AI and Tech Sovereignty

- China is prioritizing "New Quality Productive Forces," with a 17.1% share of global [open-source AI model](#) downloads, ranking first globally.
- The [Zhongguancun Academy](#) in Beijing is pioneering a new "industry-university-research" model to integrate AI into aviation engines and new materials.
- A significant push into AI-integrated consumer goods, such as [AI toys for export](#), is being framed as a move up the value chain for Chinese manufacturing.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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### Geopolitical Power Dynamics

- The conflict is testing global alliances; [Spain has refused](#) the US use of its bases for strikes against Iran, while NATO has stated it will not participate.
- China is facilitating the [evacuation of its citizens](#) from Iran through Armenia and Azerbaijan, signaling a pragmatic retreat from the immediate combat zone.
- Russia is attempting to [mediate through Putin](#), though the likelihood of a trilateral meeting with the US and Ukraine/Iran remains uncertain.

### Energy Security

- China reached a milestone in 2025, with total primary energy production [exceeding 5 billion tons](#) of standard coal for the first time.
- Non-fossil energy accounted for [over 50% of new power generation](#) for the fourth time since 2020, highlighting a strategic shift away from oil dependency.

### Cybersecurity and National Security

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### The Narrative of Superior Stability

China is using the current Middle East crisis to validate its own governance model. ### AI as a National Security Frontier

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The **15th Five-Year Plan** will likely be revised to include even more aggressive targets for **strategic reserves** (food, energy, and minerals) in response to the fragility of global supply chains. If the conflict in Iran leads to a change in the [Supreme Leader](#) (as hinted by strikes on the Expert Council), China will face

a critical test in maintaining its influence in Tehran against a potentially chaotic succession.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** China's "Whole-Process Democracy" narrative will likely become a cornerstone of its **Global Governance** outreach, seeking to draw a permanent line between "stable, consultative autocracy" and "chaotic, warlike Western democracy." The integration of [AI into the physical economy](#) will determine whether China can maintain its 5%+ growth targets amidst a shrinking workforce and a fragmenting global trade system.

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### For International Policy:

- **Security Architecture:** The US-Israeli strikes on Iranian nuclear and leadership sites mark a permanent shift in the regional security posture. Neutral states must prepare for a [prolonged war](#) of 4-5 weeks minimum as stated by US officials.
- **Diplomatic Alignment:** Spain's refusal of base usage indicates a growing **fissure in Western coalition cohesion** regarding "out-of-area" military operations, which China will exploit to build alternative "peace" coalitions.
- **Energy Strategy:** Nations must immediately activate **strategic petroleum reserves** as the Hormuz chokepoint remains non-functional, with no evidence of mines but significant psychological and physical deterrence.

## For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** The [spiking international shipping and oil costs](#) will necessitate immediate price adjustments across manufacturing and logistics sectors.
- **Investment Climate:** While Western markets are retreating, China is signaling an opening in [high-level vocational education](#) and AI-integrated manufacturing, presenting a risk-reward trade-off between geopolitical tension and state-backed sector growth.
- **Cyber Vigilance:** The Two Sessions period is a peak window for **state-level cyber activity**; firms operating in China should audit their "trusted" internal network credentials and prepare for heightened regulatory scrutiny over data security.
