

2027 POLITICAL REALIGNMENT

### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

---

March 3, 2026, marks a pivotal inflection point as the confirmation of Iranian Supreme Leader **Ayatollah Ali Khamenei's death** [has been martered](#) accelerates a regional conflagration with profound implications for Nigerian economic and national security. The ongoing U.S.-Israeli military operation, "Epic Fury," has entered its fourth day, resulting in the **closure of the Strait of Hormuz** [threats to shipping](#) and a subsequent 25% surge in global oil prices. Simultaneously, the ruling All Progressives Congress (APC) has effectively "gamed" the electoral calendar through the 2026 Electoral Act, using state congresses to **endorse President Tinubu** [sour presidential candidate](#) for a 2027 second term while the opposition remains fragmented. However, underlying state capacity remains fragile, evidenced by a significant **security breach at Abuja airport** [alleged security bridge](#) involving former Governor Nasir El-Rufai and the continued inability to secure the "ungoverned spaces" of the North-Central and North-East regions.

### MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

---

#### Middle East War and Global Fallout

- The confirmation of Ayatollah Khamenei's death by the Iranian Ambassador to Kenya has triggered a **wave of retaliatory strikes** [will not go unpunished](#) against U.S. and Israeli interests across the Gulf.
- The U.S. has confirmed the **killing of six American soldiers** [Iranian strike on Kuwait](#) in a missile strike on a military facility in Kuwait.

## Nigerian Fiscal and Cabinet Restructuring

- President Tinubu appointed Taiwo Oyedele as Minister of State for Finance, a move seen as integrating the "brain" of tax reform [brain behind the entire garment](#) directly into policy implementation.
- The Dangote Refinery has **increased petrol prices** [revised rates](#) from 774 to over 900 Naira per liter, citing the impact of global crude price spikes.

## Internal Security and Law Enforcement

- APC congresses in Gombe, Edo, and Bauchi have turned into **endorsement rallies** [Tinubu as party's loan](#) for Tinubu's 2027 candidacy, signaling an early closure of the internal primary process.
- In Ondo State, **parallel congresses election divided** and court injunctions reveal deep fissures between the state executive and federal interests (Interior Minister Tunji-Ojo).

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The 10th National Assembly is characterized by "institutional gaming," prioritizing legislation that favors the ruling party's 2027 prospects, such as the **2026 Electoral Act unsettled the opposition**, while facing criticism for delays in constitutional amendments regarding **State Police incorporate state police** and women's parliamentary seats.

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

---

**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect **protests at petrol stations** as Dangote's price hikes filter to the pump. The Nigerian government will likely launch **evacuation flights reputation flights** from Oman and Saudi Arabia for stranded citizens. Continued **volatility in gold and oil no chances getting any resistance** will dominate the NGX and global exchanges.

**Medium Term (1-6 Months):** The **2026 Budget implementation personnel budget is 6.6** will face hurdles as inflation outpaces revenue projections. ## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

### For International Policy:

- **Diplomatic Neutrality:** Nigeria must resist U.S. pressure to take an **active side in the Iran conflict government directly has no bone** to avoid domestic religious friction.
- **Maritime Security:** Bolster the Navy's capacity in the Gulf of Guinea **no missile boat** as global shipping routes may pivot away from the Middle East.
- **AfCFTA Engagement:** Ensure the National Assembly **ratifies all outstanding protocols strengthen the capacity of legislature** to capitalize on the shift in global trade lanes toward the Africa-Asia corridor.

### For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Currency Hedging:** While the Naira may see short-term appreciation **naira will strengthen the short term**, long-term inflationary risks remain. Investors should hedge using stablecoins like **USDT or cNGN more popular like USDC**.

- **Energy Transition:** Rapidly pivot toward **renewable energy and mini-grids electrifying 17.5 million** to insulated businesses from the volatility of PMS/Diesel prices.
- **Compliance Monitoring:** Monitor the **new cashless airport policies new cashless payment** and customs reforms **border security** to avoid logistical bottlenecks in the supply chain.
