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





DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The global geopolitical landscape was fundamentally altered on March 3, 2026, as the "12-Day War" reached a fever pitch following the confirmed death of Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei in a joint US-Israeli strike. This operation, described by analysts as a transition to an "assassination policy" under the Trump administration, has triggered widespread Iranian retaliation against Western assets and Gulf state energy infrastructure. The resulting closure of the Strait of Hormuz has sent shockwaves through global markets, with oil prices experiencing their largest single-day gain in four years and gas prices surging by 25%. The conflict has now geographically expanded, involving drone strikes as far as Cyprus and the targeting of US embassies in Saudi Arabia and Kuwait.

In Serbia, the government's narrative of "peace and stability" is being strained by a 21-

day agrarian revolt that has turned increasingly violent. Massive farmer blockades continue despite government claims of a resolution, while the arrest of protest leaders in Bogatić has sparked allegations of police brutality and a "reign of terror" against the peasantry. Simultaneously, Serbia has been labeled a European "hotspot" for media repression by the Council of Europe, and new revelations from decrypted Sky ECC communications suggest high-level state complicity in international cocaine smuggling via diplomatic channels in Lisbon. This convergence of regional energy insecurity, domestic civil unrest, and systemic corruption suggests a period of acute instability for the Vucic administration.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Assassination of Ayatollah Khamenei and Regional Escalation:** US and Israeli forces conducted simultaneous strikes on Tehran and Beirut, successfully [eliminating the Iranian Supreme Leadership](#). In response, Iran launched a massive series of drone and missile attacks targeting [British bases in Cyprus](#) and oil facilities in the UAE and Saudi Arabia. The US has authorized the use of [British sovereign bases](#) for offensive operations, while the Strait of Hormuz remains functionally closed to global shipping.
- **Global Energy Crisis and Economic Shock:** The blockade of the Hormuz passage, through which 20% of the world's oil flows, has caused [crude prices to spike](#) by more than 10% in 48 hours. Analysts warn that a prolonged conflict could push oil to [100 dollars per barrel](#), potentially triggering a new wave of global hyperinflation and disrupting the fragile post-Ukraine economic recovery.

- **Serbian Agrarian Revolt and State Repression:** After 21 days of road blockades, the Serbian Ministry of Interior has moved to [arrest protest leaders](#) in Bogatić and Badovinci. Allegations of [police brutality](#), including officers kneeling on protesters' necks, have intensified the crisis. Veteran soldier Milan Pajić publicly [surrendered his military uniform](#) and legal weapons in an act of defiance against what he termed a "predatory regime."
- **Diplomatic Narcotics Scandal:** Decrypted messages from the Sky ECC system have revealed a plot by criminal organizations to [hide cocaine shipments](#) within the Serbian Embassy in Lisbon. The messages describe the diplomatic mission as a ["safe house"](#) for international drug trafficking, further eroding the credibility of Serbian security institutions among international partners.
- **Media Freedom Crisis:** The Council of Europe's 2026 report has identified Serbia as a [major hotspot for attacks](#) on media freedom. The report highlights the "criminalization of journalists" and state-led [smear campaigns](#) against independent outlets like N1, specifically following the deadly roof collapse in Novi Sad.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Energy Security: The closure of the Strait of Hormuz is the primary threat to global economic stability. European and Asian markets are [bracing for supply shortages](#), as Iran utilizes its "most powerful weapon" to disrupt the flow of 20 million barrels per day. The US is attempting to [mitigate the shock](#) through domestic production, but global interdependencies make isolation impossible.

Domestic Stability & Social Order: The Serbian government is facing a crisis of legitimacy as it employs [BIA \(Intelligence Agency\) intimidation](#) against prosecutors and police force against farmers. The [passive status imposed on farmers](#) as a form of political punishment indicates a weaponization of administrative state capacity to silence dissent.

Rule of Law: The ongoing trial of inspectors Miloš Knežević and Milan Isakov is being framed by the defense as [revenge for the Jovanjica](#) investigation, where Isakov helped expose a massive state-linked marijuana plantation. This highlights a deep fracture within the Serbian judiciary and law enforcement, where [state-criminal links](#) appear to dictate legal outcomes.

Diplomatic Engagement: While the Serbian government promotes a narrative of "peace," it is actively conducting [emergency evacuations](#) of its citizens from Dubai and Israel. Serbian diplomacy is caught between its [proximity to Israel](#) and its refusal to align with EU condemnations of Iran, a balancing act that is becoming increasingly untenable as the war expands.

Technology and AI: Beyond the war, global governance is grappling with the [negative effects of social media](#) on youth mental health, with Meta allegedly suppressing research on the topic. In the cultural sector, artists like Paul McCartney are [protesting the unauthorized use](#) of their work to train AI music generators.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative activity in early March is dominated by emergency measures related to the Middle East war and restrictive laws in Kosovo that threaten the Serbian academic

presence in Mitrovica. Serbian authorities are also attempting to use administrative "passive status" to bypass legislative protections for agricultural producers.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Kosovo Law on Foreigners (Effective March 15):** This law requires all individuals without Kosovo documents to obtain [work permits and licenses](#), a move that academics warn will lead to the disappearance of the University of Pristina in Mitrovica.
- **Serbian Law on the University (Historical Context):** Reminiscent of the [repressive 1998 law](#) that abolished university autonomy, current critics argue that the Ministry of Education is again [replacing independent deans](#) with political loyalists at FPN and other faculties.
- **Agricultural Prelevmans and Duties:** Proposals to [increase import duties](#) on milk powder and introduce protective taxes to shield domestic producers from Polish dumping prices.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Trump Video Addresses:** President Trump has avoided live press conferences, opting for [pre-recorded video statements](#) to avoid questions regarding the objectives and duration of the Iran operation.
- **High Council of Prosecution Session:** Revelations were made regarding [prosecutors being summoned](#) by the BIA (Intelligence Agency) to influence internal judicial elections.

- **UN Security Council Meeting:** Melania Trump [presided over a meeting](#) on children's education and tolerance, the first time a US First Lady has held such a role, occurring shortly after a strike [killed 168 girls](#) at an Iranian school.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Collapse of the "Stabilocracy": The Serbian government's primary selling point—regional stability—is crumbling under the weight of three simultaneous pressures: the [21-day farmer protest](#), the [European indictment of its media policies](#), and the [infiltration of the diplomatic corps](#) by organized crime. The use of "Hit Twit" and TV Pink to frame Serbia as an "island of peace" in a burning world [is a propaganda effort](#) that is increasingly disconnected from the reality of rural blockades and city-wide protests against state brutality.

US Foreign Policy as "Atentat" Politics: Under the current US administration, global security architecture has shifted from containment to a [policy of targeted assassinations](#). This "Trump 2.0" doctrine prioritizes the rapid decapitation of hostile regimes [without a plan for state-building](#). The elimination of Khamenei has not led to the predicted democratic uprising, but rather to a [regional chaos](#) that resembles Iraq post-2003, with the added complication of global energy blackmail.

The Weaponization of Administrative Law: A subtle but dangerous trend is the use of ["passive status" registrations](#) to bankrupt dissenting farmers. By using satellite imaging to find minor discrepancies in land use, the state is effectively [cutting off subsidies](#) to those who support student protests or

participate in blockades, demonstrating a sophisticated form of bureaucratic warfare against political opponents.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect global oil prices to remain volatile as the US and Israel attempt to break the Hormuz blockade through naval force. In Serbia, the [March 4th meeting](#) between the government and farmers will be a critical inflection point; failure to reach a genuine agreement will likely lead to a [radically expanded blockade](#) of the Ibarska highway and border crossings. The March 15th Kosovo deadline will trigger a [staffing crisis](#) at the University of Mitrovica.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): Inflationary pressures from the energy shock will begin to affect retail prices in Europe, potentially leading to social unrest in "Old Europe" (Spain, Italy) where [opposition to the war](#) is highest. In Serbia, the [Lisbon embassy cocaine scandal](#) may trigger international investigations by Europol/Interpol, further isolating the Serbian Ministry of Interior from Western intelligence sharing.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The decapitation of the Iranian regime without a successor will likely result in the [atomization of the Revolutionary Guard](#), turning Iran into a vast zone of asymmetric conflict and drone-led terrorism. Serbia may face a significant [demographic collapse of its rural heartland](#) if the current policy of "systematic destruction of the village" continues, leading to increased dependency on imported food and diminished national sovereignty.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The shift to "assassination politics" requires a new UN framework for sovereign protections, as the [impunity of member states](#) now threatens the core of the international order.
- EU members must prepare for a [divergence in foreign policy](#) as Eastern members align with Trump's war while Old Europe seeks to maintain neutrality to protect energy supplies.
- The "One Health" approach [should be prioritized](#) to manage zoonotic risks in war zones where traditional veterinary and medical infrastructure has collapsed.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Energy Diversification:** The Hormuz blockade proves that traditional oil supply chains are [historically vulnerable](#). Investment in Green Hydrogen and LNG from the US/Africa is no longer optional but a survival requirement.
- **Supply Chain Risk in Serbia:** Investors in Serbian manufacturing must account for ["invisible" taxes and fees](#) that favor state-linked firms and the risk of sudden logistical blockades from ongoing agrarian unrest.
- **AI Compliance:** Companies using generative AI for creative content should anticipate [stricter licensing requirements](#) as high-profile artists and unions push for compensation for training data usage.
