

THE US-ISRAEL "OPERATION EPIC FURY" AGAINST IRAN HAS TRIGGERED A GLOBAL ENERGY CRISIS AND SHIFTED RUSSIA TOWARD A WARTIME FOOTING OF SOCIAL UNITY AND INTERNAL SECURITY.

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 3, 2026, marks a critical escalation in global instability as the United States and Israel intensify "Operation Epic Fury" (Epicheskaya Yarost) against Iran. The conflict has moved beyond surgical strikes to a full-scale regional war, characterized by high civilian casualties, including a devastating strike on a [girls' school in Minab](#) that killed 171 children. Iran has responded with waves of drone and missile attacks targeting US and Israeli assets across the Middle East, successfully striking the [US Embassy in Riyadh](#) and US personnel in Iraq and Qatar. This escalation has fractured the Western coalition, with key NATO allies like Spain, Italy, France, and Britain [distancing themselves from the operation](#) and refusing the use of their bases for further strikes.

The economic consequences are immediate and severe. Global oil prices have surged past \$85 per barrel as Iran implemented a [blockade of the Strait of Hormuz](#), threatening to destroy any vessel attempting to pass. This move endangers 20% of global oil trade and a third of liquified natural gas (LNG) supplies. Domestically, Russia is leveraging this chaos to project stability and moral superiority. While the Middle East burns, the Kremlin is focusing on the "Year of Unity" (2026) and expanding social benefits for "Mother-Heroines" and veterans. Internally, the state is intensifying its crackdown on dissent and "Ukrainian-backed terrorism," while simultaneously engaging in a high-level public discourse aimed at rehabilitating the concept of citizen reporting or [denunciations as a civic duty](#).

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Operation "Epic Fury" and Regional Contagion**
 - US and Israeli forces have targeted Iranian leadership, presidential offices, and nuclear facilities in Natanz and Bushehr, despite warnings of [nuclear contamination risks](#).
 - The conflict has expanded into Lebanon, with the IDF launching massive bombardments against Hezbollah and [preparing for a ground invasion](#).
 - US Secretary of State Marco Rubio stated the US may take a [key role in governing Iran](#) in the future, signaling a regime change objective.

- **Global Energy Market Collapse**

- Iran has successfully shut down the Strait of Hormuz, causing [unprecedented spikes in gas prices](#) and oil reaching levels not seen in years.
- Qatar Energy has ceased production at the world's largest LNG plant following [Iranian drone strikes](#).

- **Russian Military and Internal Security**

- Russian forces have reported the [liberation of Babylevka](#) in the Sumy region and Veselyanka in the Zaporozhye region.
- The FSB reported a [prevented terrorist attack](#) in Yekaterinburg, where an agent allegedly acting for Ukrainian intelligence was killed while attempting to plant a bomb.
- The Ministry of Transport is coordinating the [evacuation of over 20,000 Russian tourists](#) stranded in the UAE and Oman due to the regional air space closure.

- **State Governance and Social Engineering**

- Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin celebrated his [60th birthday](#), receiving the Order of St. Sergius of Radonezh for his role in stabilizing the economy under sanctions.
- The government has launched a digital ID system via [Messenger Max](#) to streamline social benefits and verify citizen status.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Geopolitical Power Dynamics

- Russia is positioning itself as a rational mediator, with Putin holding strategic [calls with Viktor Orban](#) to discuss the fallout of the Iran war on energy markets.
- The US is facing significant internal and external pushback; polls show [only 25% of Americans](#) approve of the strikes on Iran.
- The UAE and Saudi Arabia are under direct fire, with [blasts reported in Dubai](#) and evacuations occurring in diplomatic quarters.

Energy Security

- The closure of the Strait of Hormuz is described as an "energy collapse" for Europe, which has already [abandoned Russian resources](#) and now lacks alternatives.
- Iraq has [suspended oil production](#) at the Rumaila field, the second largest in the world, citing security concerns.

Domestic Stability & Social Order

- The Kremlin has officially designated 2026 as the [Year of Unity](#), focusing on traditional values and the intergenerational transfer of "spiritual-moral values."
- A significant national debate has surfaced regarding "donosy" (denunciations), with state media attempting to rebrand reporting neighbors as a [sign of a mature civil society](#) rather than a relic of the Stalinist past.

- The "Mother-Heroine" title is being revitalized with monthly payments increased to [over 76,000 rubles](#) and a range of local benefits including free housing and utilities.

National Security & Lawfare

- Alexander Bastrykin (Investigative Committee) has proposed [stripping naturalized citizens of citizenship](#) if they commit "extremely dangerous" acts or crimes.
- Poland has extended the [arrest of Hermitage archaeologist](#) Alexander Butyagin under a Ukrainian warrant, an act Russia calls a "political provocation."

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The day was dominated by discussions of executive decrees and proposed tightenings of citizenship and corruption laws. High-level committee meetings focused on the "Year of Unity" implementation and the expansion of the "Social Contract" program for veterans.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Mother-Heroine Social Status Law:** Legislation refining the choice between [monthly payments or social benefits](#) (such as dental care and travel vouchers) for women with 10 or more children.
- **Social Contract Expansion:** De-mobilized veterans are now eligible for [350,000 ruble grants](#) to start businesses or undergo retraining.
- **Naturalized Citizenship Reform:** A proposal by the Investigative Committee to [revoke citizenship](#) for serious offenses, targeting those who have "lost their political-legal connection" to Russia.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **National Treasury Meeting:** Head of the Treasury Roman Artyukhin reported to Putin that [1.5 trillion rubles](#) were transferred to the budget in 2025, with a 99% execution rate.
- **Year of Unity Organizing Committee:** The first session in Moscow outlined [hundreds of federal and regional events](#) to promote national cohesion during the Special Military Operation.
- **Investigative Committee (SK) Board Meeting:** Bastrykin reported that [over 14,000 corruption cases](#) were sent to court in 2025, a 25% increase from the previous year.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Rehabilitation of Vigilance

A notable trend is the intellectual effort to rehabilitate citizen surveillance. On state talk shows, the narrative is shifting from the "4 million denunciations" of the Stalin era as a sign of tragedy toward a contemporary view where [reporting on "suspicious conversations"](#) or violations of social order (like improper pet waste disposal or political dissent) is framed as an act of "civic maturity." This suggests the state is preparing the public for a more intensive internal security regime, where "bystanders" are encouraged to act as extensions of the FSB.

Western Fragmentation and the "Epic Fury" Blowback

The "Epic Fury" operation is being used to highlight the isolation of the US executive branch. Reports emphasize that Trump is [avoiding press questions](#) and that his

administration is "paranoid" about ammunition shortages. The refusal of European allies to participate suggests a significant rift in the security architecture of the West, which Russia is eager to exploit by maintaining ties with "sovereign" European leaders like Orban. The narrative of ["Epic Fury" failing its 4-week timeline](#) aims to project Western military incompetence.

Cultural Militarization and Media Integration

The promotion of the series "New Earth" (Novaya Zemlya) serves as a bridge between entertainment and state propaganda. The series, which features [real Crimean and Zaporozhye locals](#) and addresses the "trauma" of Ukrainian rule, is framed as a "choice between good and evil." This illustrates the use of high-budget drama to normalize the occupation of new territories and the ongoing conflict, integrating the "war effort" into the daily domestic life of Russian viewers.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect global oil and gas prices to remain at extreme highs as the Strait of Hormuz blockade persists. The US and Israel are likely to launch a "decisive" phase of Operation Epic Fury involving [B-2 stealth bombers and ballistic missiles](#) to try and end the conflict before domestic US opposition becomes untenable. Inside Russia, intensified vetting of naturalized citizens and increased arrests for "discrediting the military" via citizen reports are expected.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The energy crisis will likely force European nations into a severe recession, potentially leading to social unrest and a shift toward "sovereign" politics similar to Orban's. Russia will likely capitalize on this by offering "humanitarian" energy

deals to friendly or neutral states. The "Year of Unity" campaign will culminate in a series of patriotic festivals designed to bolster the 2026 election cycle.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The Iran conflict may lead to a permanent restructuring of Middle Eastern security, with the US potentially attempting a long-term occupation or "governance" role that could mirror the failures of Iraq and Afghanistan. Russia is positioning itself as the leader of a "multipolar" world, using its [Soviet-era geographic and political dominance](#) as a template for a new Eurasian bloc that is technologically and militarily self-sufficient.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- The fracture in NATO regarding Iran strikes indicates a critical opportunity for non-US powers to engage in independent diplomacy with Teheran to reopen the Strait of Hormuz.
- The risk of [nuclear accidents](#) at Bushehr or Natanz necessitates an immediate international monitoring mission, as local radiation leaks could affect the entire Gulf region.
- Russia's "Year of Unity" suggests a hardening of the state's social core; diplomatic efforts should focus on long-term engagement with the "technocratic" wing of the government (e.g., Mishustin) rather than expecting imminent regime change.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Companies reliant on Middle Eastern LNG or oil should [immediately diversify](#) to North American or Australian sources, as the Hormuz blockade is unlikely to lift within the month.
- **Regulatory Compliance:** Naturalized Russian employees or partners may face [sudden citizenship revocation](#) or "loyalty checks," creating HR and legal risks for multinational firms still operating in the region.
- **Digital Sovereignty:** The launch of Digital IDs and [Messenger Max](#) integration signals a new level of state data control; companies should audit their data storage to ensure compliance with tightening Russian digital sovereignty laws.
