

AND A MULTI-FRONT RETALIATORY
CAMPAIGN AGAINST US AND
ISRAELI INTERESTS.

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 3, 2026, marks a transformative escalation in the regional conflict as the Islamic Republic of Iran enters its fourth day of "Operation True Promise 4," a massive retaliatory campaign following the [assassination of Supreme Leader](#) Ayatollah Ali Khamenei on March 2. The region has transitioned from localized skirmishes into a full-scale conventional and asymmetric war. Iran has deployed less than 10% of its [missile launching facilities](#) to strike US and Israeli assets across the Persian Gulf and the Mediterranean, claiming to have inflicted over 650 US casualties and destroyed multiple high-value defense systems, including the [US embassy in Saudi Arabia](#) and naval facilities in Bahrain.

The conflict has expanded into a multi-front war with the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF)

launching a ground invasion of Southern Lebanon, despite a retreat by the Lebanese national army and [conflicting orders](#) from the Lebanese cabinet. In response, Hezbollah has resumed long-range strikes against Tel Aviv and the Golan Heights. Simultaneously, Iran has effectively [closed the Strait of Hormuz](#), causing global oil prices to skyrocket and threatening the economic stability of the "Atlanticist" world and the Persian Gulf monarchies. Protests in Tehran and throughout the "Axis of Resistance" emphasize a shift from grief to a unified demand for revenge, as the Assembly of Experts [convenes to elect](#) a successor to Khamenei.

The narrative framework provided by state media focuses on the moral and technological "bankruptcy" of the West, frequently citing the "Epstein Class" in Washington as a primary driver of the war. Iranian and allied commentators argue that US President Donald Trump is being [blackmailed by the Zionist lobby](#) to pursue regime change in Tehran as a distraction from domestic scandals. This is juxtaposed against a humanitarian crisis, highlighted by the massacre of [165 schoolgirls in Minab](#) and strikes on medical infrastructure, which are being used to mobilize international public opinion against the US-Israeli coalition.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

The Martyrdom and Succession of Ayatollah Ali Khamenei

- Confirmation of the assassination of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei in his residence on Monday morning, leading to [plans for burial](#) in the holy city of Mashhad.

- The Assembly of Experts is in an [emergency session](#) to select a new leader; an auxiliary building in Qom was targeted by Israeli strikes but was reportedly empty.
- Analysts predict the next leader may take a [less moderate stance](#) toward the West, potentially revisiting the fatwa against nuclear weapons.

Operation True Promise 4 and Regional Retaliation

- Iran has launched [15 rounds of strikes](#) against US and Israeli interests, including the US fifth fleet facility in Bahrain and airbases in Qatar and Kuwait.
- Retaliatory strikes have hit [RAF Akrotiri in Cyprus](#), marking the first time Iranian missiles have targeted a European base used to facilitate Israeli logistics.
- Iranian officials report the destruction of [two US THAAD](#) anti-missile systems, rendering them non-operational.

Ground War in Southern Lebanon

- The Israeli regime has commenced a [land invasion](#) of Southern Lebanon; the Lebanese army has withdrawn from its posts along the Litani River.
- Hezbollah has engaged Israeli tanks in the [Kfarshuba Hills](#) and resumed long-range missile strikes against Tel Aviv.
- Internal divisions in the Lebanese government have emerged, with some ministers [blaming the resistance](#) for the war while others condemn state complicity.

Humanitarian Impact and Mass Casualties

- Mass funerals held in Minab for [165 schoolgirls killed](#) in a US-Israeli missile strike on an elementary school.

- Significant damage reported to [Gandhi Hospital in Tehran](#) and a neonatal ward in Bushehr, leading to the emergency evacuation of infants.
- Iran's Red Crescent confirms [787 civilian deaths](#) across the country in the first four days of the aggression.

Global Economic and Supply Chain Disruption

- The [Strait of Hormuz is closed](#), halting 20-30% of global oil trade and impacting food security in the Persian Gulf.
- Israel's war costs are estimated at [\\$5 billion](#) in the first week, with a critical shortage of 40,000 workers in the construction sector.
- China is reportedly [withholding rare earth minerals](#) from the US, limiting the production of air defense missiles.

Elite Politics & Leadership Dynamics

- Succession planning is the primary focus of the Iranian state following the [death of Ali Khamenei](#). The transition appears orderly, with successors already designated to ensure continuity in war management.
- In the US, the Trump administration is accused of Pursuing [regime change by blackmail](#), allegedly orchestrated by the Israeli lobby to conceal the "Epstein Class" scandals.

Statecraft & Financial Resilience

- Iran has pivoted to a [resistance economy](#), leveraging nanotechnology and domestic manufacturing to sustain its missile and drone programs despite total sanctions.

- The US maintains control over Iraq's finances, with oil revenues funneling through the [Federal Reserve Bank](#) of New York, a system Iran and its allies seek to dismantle through BRICS.

Security Architecture

- The myth of Israeli air defense invincibility has [cracked on TikTok](#) as hypersonic maneuvering warheads penetrate multi-layered shields.
- NATO remains officially uninvolved but has pledged to [defend every inch](#) of alliance territory, a stance Iran views as hypocritical given US strikes from alliance bases.

Terrorism

- The US has designated various [Antifa groups](#) in Europe as foreign terrorist organizations, a move that activists claim is a "self-indictment" of the US as a fascist state.
- Trump has issued [Green Light messages](#) to separatist groups in Iran to ignite domestic chaos, though Iranian intelligence claims to have neutralized these cells.

Energy Security

- The [Aramco refinery in Saudi Arabia](#) was targeted; Iran denies responsibility, suggesting a false flag operation by Israel to drag the Gulf states into the war.
- Iran has halted [food and energy exports](#) to UAE and Saudi Arabia, testing the internal stability of Gulf monarchies.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Domestic and international legislative maneuvers are being used to codify war efforts and repress dissent. The US

administration is leveraging [anti-terrorism legislation](#) to target domestic protestors, while the Lebanese cabinet is issuing decrees to [ban resistance activities](#).

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED

- **National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) 2025:** Passed by the US Senate with 85 votes, allocating [\\$895 billion](#) to the Pentagon, including significant aid for Israel.
- **National Security Presidential Memorandum Seven:** Issued by the Trump administration to [escalate domestic repression](#) and link protests to foreign influence.
- **Iraqi Withdrawal Law 2020:** Re-highlighted as a [failed legislative mandate](#) that the current Iraqi government refuses to implement under US pressure.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The End of the "Atlanticist" Unipolar Order Analysts argue that the current war is the "[World War III](#)" of the 21st century, pitting the "Global West" against emerging powers in Eurasia and the Global South. The failure of US diplomacy and the pivot to "gangster/cowboy" rhetoric under Trump signals a [declining hegemonic cycle](#) that began in 1945. State media emphasizes that Iran's [military developed from scratch](#) under sanctions, making it more resilient than the "fat and slow" US heavyweight. This technological shift is forcing Western militaries to [copy Iranian designs](#) to catch up.

The "Epstein Class" and Moral Legitimacy A pervasive narrative across broadcasts is the [dehumanization of Western leadership](#). Iranian and allied commentators repeatedly refer to the "Epstein Class," suggesting that Western political elites are [morally compromised](#) and subservient to Zionism due to systemic blackmail. This is used to frame the "Axis of Resistance" as the true defenders of "humanity" and "civilization," contrasting Iranian [spiritual steadfastness](#) with the "nihilistic and immoral" Global Elite.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks)

- Expect an [escalation of "revenge" strikes](#) coinciding with the 40th day of mourning for Khamenei and the holy month of Ramadan.
- The Israeli ground invasion of Lebanon will likely meet [Hezbollah ambushes](#) as the IDF moves north of the Litani, potentially leading to a "scorched earth" scenario.
- Domestic unrest in the US and UK may increase as [hunger strikes](#) and direct actions by Palestine activists continue to be met with state repression.

Medium Term (1-6 Months)

- The [8-week limit](#) on US air campaign sustainability will test the Trump administration's commitment to the war as stockpiles of high-end interceptors are depleted.
- BRICS will likely formalize an [alternative financial system](#) to bypass the dollar-based oil trade, permanently altering global energy markets.
- Israel faces a potential [mass exodus](#) of settlers and a total economic collapse if the war of attrition continues without a definitive victory.

Long Term (1-5 Years)

- Structural changes to the Middle Eastern map may occur, with the "[Greater Israel project](#)" clashing against a unified Shia/Islamic resistance, potentially leading to the disintegration of several current nation-states.

- Iran will likely emerge as the [technological and industrial hub](#) for nanotechnology and defense in the Global South, independent of Western supply chains.
- The US military presence in West Asia may be [permanently expelled](#), leading to a shift in global hegemonic power toward a China-Russia-Iran axis.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy

- The UN/IAEA must urgently [broker a ceasefire](#) regarding nuclear sites to prevent a regional radiological catastrophe as Israel considers tactical nuclear options.
- Western governments should reassess the [terrorist designation](#) of domestic activist groups to avoid fueling further civil unrest and radicalization.
- Regional states must decide between hosting US bases and [protecting their own sovereignty](#), as Iran has made it clear that host nations will be treated as combatants.

For Private Sector/Investors

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Immediate diversification away from [Strait of Hormuz](#) dependent energy routes is critical; expect sustained volatility in oil and gas.
- **Regulatory Compliance:** Investors in Israeli construction and tech must account for [massive labor shortages](#) and infrastructure damage that will delay projects for years.
- **Emerging Opportunities:** Iran's [nanotechnology sector](#) represents a high-growth area for non-Western capital, particularly in catalysts, medical devices, and advanced materials.
