### DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

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March 3, 2026, marks a catastrophic inflection point in global geopolitics as "Operation Epic Fury," led by the United States and Israel, has transitioned from targeted strikes into a total regional conflagration. The reported **assassination of Iranian Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei** following a multi-month intelligence operation has decapitated the Iranian leadership, though a "Council of 88" clerics in Qom was reportedly [targeted by further strikes](#) while attempting to elect a successor. The humanitarian cost has surged, most notably with a [US-Israeli strike on a girls' school](#) in Minab that killed an estimated 160 to 175 children, an event that has catalyzed Iranian resolve and drawn sharp condemnation from

domestic US critics and international observers alike.

The economic fallout is immediate and severe. Iran has effectively **blocked the Strait of Hormuz**, threatening to "burn every ship" that attempts passage, leading to a [spike in oil prices](#) toward \$100 per barrel and natural gas prices in Europe exceeding \$785 per 1,000 cubic meters. US military assets across the "Permian Gulf"—including bases in Qatar, Bahrain, Kuwait, and the UAE—are under [sustained drone and missile attack](#) by Iranian forces and proxies. This chaos has forced a strategic realignment; the UAE and Qatar are distancing themselves from Washington to seek a diplomatic exit, while Spain has [prohibited the use of its bases](#) for the campaign against Iran.

Concurrently, the conflict in Ukraine is being sidelined by the Trump administration. President Trump has repeatedly disparaged President Zelensky, [labeling him a "circus entrepreneur"](#) and accusing the previous Biden administration of depleting US munitions reserves for a "scam." Russian forces are exploiting this shift in Western attention, reporting [territorial gains in the Donbas](#) and Sumy regions. Domestically, Russia remains on high alert following a **thwarted terrorist plot** in Yekaterinburg and faces significant seasonal flooding in the Lugansk People's Republic.

## MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

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### The Decapitation of Iranian Leadership and "Operation Epic Fury"

- The US and Israel have reportedly confirmed the [assassination of Supreme Leader Khamenei](#), a result of two years of tracking and the hacking of Tehran's municipal camera network.
- Subsequent strikes targeted the "Council of Experts" in Qom, potentially [killing the candidates](#) for the new Supreme Leader and the newly appointed Defense Minister.
- A devastating air strike on a [girls' school in Minab](#) resulted in 175 deaths, becoming a "bloody symbol" of the conflict and fueling Iranian vows of "eternal jihad."

### Closure of the Strait of Hormuz and Global Energy Crisis

- The IRGC has declared a total blockade of the [Strait of Hormuz](#), warning that "not a drop of oil" will leave the region.
- Strategic infrastructure in Saudi Arabia (Aramco), Qatar, and the UAE has been hit, with [oil refineries and tankers](#) in flames.
- European natural gas prices have reached [three-year highs](#), exceeding \$750, while UK fuel prices have surged nearly 90%.

### The Marginalization of the Ukraine Conflict

- The US administration has reportedly deprioritized Ukraine, with Trump asserting that [Zelensky has "scammed"](#) the US out of billions in high-quality weaponry.

- Zelensky has expressed fear of a [missile famine](#) as Patriot interceptors are diverted to defend US assets in the Middle East.
- Russian forces have [liberated the settlement of Rozhdestvenskoye](#) (Zaporozhye) and advanced toward the Slavyansk-Kramatorsk line.

### US Elite Scandals and Domestic Turmoil

- Former President Bill Clinton and Hillary Clinton [testified before Congress](#) regarding their ties to Jeffrey Epstein, with Bill Clinton reportedly "shaking" as archives were presented.
- Melania Trump chaired a [UN Security Council session](#) on children and technology, which was criticized as a cynical distraction from the deaths of Iranian children.
- Anti-war protests have erupted [across US cities](#), with critics demanding Trump's son, Barron, be sent to the front lines.

### Russian Internal Security and State Capacity

- The FSB [neutralized a Ukrainian-backed saboteur](#) in Yekaterinburg who intended to bomb a high-ranking defense industry official.
- Large-scale [evacuation of Russian tourists](#) from the UAE and Oman is underway, with the Ministry of Transport coordinating dozens of "rescue" flights.
- The LNR is facing its worst [spring flooding in 20 years](#), necessitating military intervention to transport civilians via Ural trucks and boats.

## KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

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**Energy Security:** The global energy market is in a state of "protracted crisis." The [closure of the Strait of Hormuz](#) threatens to push oil to \$200 per barrel. In Europe, the **Druzhba pipeline** remains a point of contention; Hungarian Prime Minister Viktor Orban has accused Zelensky of [using energy as a weapon](#) by blocking transit to influence Hungarian elections, leading Hungary to place military guards at its energy infrastructure.

**International Relations & Foreign Policy:** A significant rift has opened within the Western alliance. Spain has [distanced itself from Washington](#), while the UK under Keir Starmer has faced "furious" criticism from Trump for initially delaying permission to use **Diego Garcia** for offensive strikes. Meanwhile, Russia and Hungary are [strengthening a "sovereign course"](#) of diplomatic engagement amid the regional collapse.

**National Security & Terrorism:** The FSB's [elimination of a saboteur](#) in Yekaterinburg highlights the ongoing domestic threat from Ukrainian intelligence. In the Middle East, the IRGC's [subterranean "missile cities"](#) prove that strategic assets remain viable despite US air superiority, shifting the security architecture from conventional defense to asymmetric regional chaos.

**Elite Politics & Leadership Dynamics:** The US presidency is being characterized by "mercurial" decision-making. Trump's [public disparagement of allies](#) (Spain, UK) and his focus on "grand hotel ballroom" aesthetics while soldiers die has drawn sharp rebukes from both Democrats and "MAGA" supporters like Tucker Carlson. In Russia, the [investiture of the "Year of Unity"](#) emphasizes state-led

social cohesion centered on veterans of the Special Military Operation.

**Economic Security:** Global stock markets, particularly in [Asia and South Korea](#), have plummeted by over 6.5%. The cost of the US operation is reportedly exceeding [\\$2 billion per day](#), raising concerns about the long-term solvency of US defense spending and the "re-heating" of the Russian energy market as a sanction-resistant alternative for Asian buyers.

## LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

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The Russian government is considering a shift toward **radical property seizure** for corruption, while the US Congress is embroiled in **legal warfare** against the "Old Guard" of the Democratic Party and attempting to curb the President's unilateral war powers.

### BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Russian Anti-Corruption Reform:** Investigative Committee head Alexander Bastrykin has proposed [complete confiscation of all property](#) for corrupt officials and stripping citizenship for those who commit "grave crimes."

## DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

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### The "Circus" Paradigm and Diplomatic Degradation

A recurring theme is the total **degradation of diplomatic norms** under the Trump administration. Simultaneously, the focus on the [Minab school strike](#) serves to frame the current US-Israeli operation not as a precision anti-nuclear strike, but as an **"Epic Rage"** campaign targeting the future of a civilization. This is being contrasted with Russia's "humanitarian" role, rescuing its citizens from the UAE and providing [flood relief in the LNR](#).

### The Rise of Asymmetric Economic Warfare

Iran's strategy of "total chaos" is a significant trend. Rather than meeting the US in a conventional air battle they cannot win, the IRGC is [targeting the global economy](#). By threatening "every drop of oil," they are leveraging the dependencies of US allies (UAE, Qatar) to **create a "fifth column"** of frantic petro-states pleading with Washington to stop. This indicates a future where regional powers can check US military dominance through "economic decapitation."

## STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

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**Short Term (1-4 Weeks):** Expect [ground-level incursions](#) as Israel moves deeper into Southern Lebanon and US "advisors" potentially coordinate with Kurdish forces (Peshmerga) for a **fragmentation of Iran**. Oil will likely exceed \$120/barrel as the Hormuz blockade tightens. Hungary and other "sovereign" European nations may [openly defy Brussels](#) to normalize relations with Moscow for energy survival.

**Long Term (1-5 Years):** The maps of the Middle East may be redrawn, with the [creation of a Kurdish state](#) serving as a permanent US-Israeli proxy against Iran, Turkey, and Iraq. The US "Petrodollar" system faces its **greatest existential threat** as Arab nations move to diversify their security alliances (potentially toward the BRICS/SCO bloc) after the failure of the "US Security Umbrella" to prevent Iranian retaliatory strikes on their soil.

## RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

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### For International Policy:

- **Regulatory Compliance:** Investors should anticipate [aggressive asset forfeiture laws](#) in Russia and potential "emergency tariffs" in the US, making "jurisdictional diversification" critical for capital preservation.
