





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THE UNITED STATES AND VENEZUELA FORGE A STRATEGIC ENERGY ALLIANCE AS A DEVASTATING REGIONAL WAR IN THE MIDDLE EAST DESTABILIZES GLOBAL OIL MARKETS.

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The global geopolitical landscape on March 4, 2026, is defined by a massive strategic pivot as the United States aggressively re-engages with Venezuela to secure energy and mineral interests amidst a widening war in the Middle East. Following a reported military action on January 3rd, 2026, the relationship between Washington and Caracas has shifted from hostility to an [alliance of mutual benefit](#), with high-level U.S. officials, including Secretary of the Interior Doug Burgum, visiting the Miraflores Palace to coordinate on critical minerals and petroleum production. This rapprochement is framed as a "three-phase plan" by the Donald Trump administration to stabilize the Western Hemisphere's energy supply while the Middle East faces a [major regional conflict](#) following the death of Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei.

Internally, Venezuela is navigating a complex "National Reconciliation" process. Acting President Delcy Rodríguez is overseeing the implementation of a massive Amnesty Law that has already seen thousands of [prisoners released](#), including military personnel, as the state seeks to end decades of political insurgency. Simultaneously, the government is signaling a total departure from "atrocious" nationalization policies, inviting giants like ExxonMobil back to the country and proposing radical reforms to mining and labor laws to attract the [\\$100 billion in investment](#) signaled by Washington. However, this stability remains fragile, as the labor sector continues to demand the "salarization" of bonuses after four years of wage freezes, and supporters of Nicolas Maduro—who remains in detention—continue to [protest for his release](#).

The international fallout of the Middle East war has also sparked a significant rift within the Western alliance. President Trump has threatened to [sever trade with Spain](#) after Prime Minister Pedro Sánchez refused to allow U.S. aircraft to use Spanish bases for strikes against Iran. As global oil prices surge due to the [threatened closure](#) of the Strait of Hormuz, Venezuela is being positioned as the "safest and most reliable" alternative, with economic growth projections for 2026 reaching as high as 10% as the country reintegrates into the global financial order.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

The US-Venezuela Energy Pivot

- US Secretary of the Interior Doug Burgum arrived in Caracas to establish a strategic agenda focused on [critical mineral supply chains](#) and energy cooperation.

- The Trump administration is treating Acting President Delcy Rodríguez as a [partner and friend](#), moving rapidly to restore historical commercial ties.
- ExxonMobil has signaled a willingness to return to Venezuela, with plans to send a [technical team](#) to identify production opportunities.
- Petróleos de Venezuela (PDVSA) has signed new contracts with U.S. firms for the [supply of crude](#) and derivatives.

Total War in the Middle East & Iranian Succession

- A massive offensive by the U.S. and Israel has targeted [command centers](#) in Tehran and Hezbollah assets in Beirut.
- Ayatollah Ali Khamenei was killed in the opening days of the conflict; his son, [Mojtaba Khamenei](#), has emerged as the most likely successor despite clerical infighting.
- Iran has threatened to maintain [total control](#) over the Strait of Hormuz, through which 20% of global oil flows.
- The death toll in Iran has reportedly [surpassed 1,400](#) as Israel warns it will eliminate any new leadership selected by the regime.

Venezuelan "National Reconciliation" & Amnesty Law

- The Amnesty Law has processed over 6,100 requests, resulting in the [release of 245](#) prisoners and the granting of full liberty to 5,800 others on probation.
- Military justice has also moved to release [31 officials](#) involved in previous political events.

- Enrique Márquez, recently released from detention, has emerged as a [key moderate voice](#), invited by President Trump to represent the "reunification of the Venezuelan family."

Transatlantic Rift: US vs. Spain

- President Trump has threatened to [cut all trade](#) with Spain after Prime Minister Pedro Sánchez adopted a "No to war" stance.
- Sánchez refused to allow U.S. forces to use [Spanish bases](#) for the Iran offensive, leading to a diplomatic standoff with Washington.
- The European Commission has expressed [full solidarity](#) with Spain against U.S. commercial threats.

Domestic Economic Recovery Projections

- Venezuela's GDP growth for 2025 was confirmed at 8.66%, with the [fourth quarter](#) showing a 13.41% jump in oil activity.
- The government predicts growth between [9% and 10%](#) for 2026 as sanctions are systematically removed.
- The Central Bank reports 19 consecutive quarters of growth, suggesting a [sustained recovery](#) process.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Energy Security & Geopolitical Power Dynamics

- The closure of the Strait of Hormuz has transformed Venezuela into a [strategic energy hub](#) for the West, with the U.S. signaling a desire to shift its long-term supply chain away from the Persian Gulf.

- Venezuela is preparing to [rehabilitate its refineries](#) to compete with U.S. Gulf Coast capacity, leveraging its geographic proximity to Miami.

Critical Minerals & Technological Sovereignty

- Venezuela's transition involves a delicate "co-habitation" between the existing state structure and [new political actors](#), with the U.S. encouraging "stabilization" before holding new elections.
- Acting President Rodríguez is promoting a [Constituyente Laboral](#) to modernize labor relations and potentially end the retroactivity of social benefits to boost private investment.

Biosurveillance & Public Health

- Health authorities have activated over 500 [immunization posts](#) to combat a regional outbreak of Yellow Fever.
- The arrival of [Sahara Dust](#) (Polvo del Sahara) has triggered respiratory alerts across the country, particularly for asthmatic and immunosuppressed populations.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative activity in Caracas is currently focused on dismantling the "punitive" legal framework of the previous era while building new "pro-investment" structures to accommodate the return of Western multinational corporations.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **Amnesty Law for Democratic Coexistence:** Already in effect, it facilitates the [liberation of thousands](#) and the dismissal of political court cases to foster national reconciliation.
- **Reform of the Organic Law of Hydrocarbons:** Designed to [remove the state monopoly](#) and grant legal security to foreign oil companies.
- **Expansion of the Mining Law:** Proposed legislation to allow foreign firms to explore and exploit [rare earth minerals](#) and gold under new environmental standards.
- **Administrative Acceleration Law:** A project to eliminate [bureaucratic "cabals"](#) and simplify business registration and production permits.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Delcy Rodríguez-Doug Burgum Meeting:** A high-level summit at Miraflores to coordinate the [three-phase US plan](#) for the region.
- **Amnesty Commission Briefing:** Representative Reinaldo Arreaza provided a [comprehensive breakdown](#) of the 6,100+ amnesty requests and military releases.
- **Fedecámaras Social Dialogue:** Business leaders and union reps met to discuss the [recovery of wages](#) and the "salarization" of bonuses in a growing economy.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The End of the "Rogue State" Narrative

The defining narrative shift is the total rehabilitation of the Venezuelan executive in the eyes of the U.S. State Department. By labeling Acting President Rodríguez a "friend," the Trump administration is effectively [ending the isolation](#) of Caracas. This is not driven by democratic idealism but by a cold-blooded "strategic alignment" aimed at creating a fortress of Western energy security while the Middle East burns. The "January 3rd" event appears to have served as the catalyst for this reset, moving the focus from "regime change" to "regime stabilization and partnership."

The Cost of Neutrality: The US-Spain Split

A new trend in bloc politics is emerging where the U.S. expects "absolute loyalty" from its European allies regarding the war in Iran. Spain's refusal to participate is being met with [economic warfare](#), a tactic previously reserved for adversaries. This suggests the Trump administration will use trade as a primary weapon to enforce its geopolitical will, even against historic NATO allies.

Labor Unrest in a Booming Economy

Despite the macro-economic optimism, there is a dangerous lag in [social well-being](#). Professors and public sector workers are pointing to 1,400+ days without a salary increase. If the government and private sector do not resolve the "bonus vs. salary" dispute soon, the "National Reconciliation" could be threatened by [civil unrest](#) from the very labor base that is supposed to drive the recovery.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks)

- We expect a surge in [ExxonMobil and Chevron activity](#) in the Orinoco Belt as new technical teams arrive.
- Tensions in Spain will likely escalate, potentially leading to [US tariffs](#) on Spanish imports if Sánchez does not yield on base access.
- The Iranian succession will remain volatile, with potential [covert operations](#) targeting Mojtaba Khamenei to prevent a hardline consolidation.

Medium Term (1-6 Months)

- Venezuela could reach [1.2 million barrels per day](#) of production as US nafta imports stabilize domestic refining.
- A formal "National Unity" government or transitional council may be announced to [incorporate moderate opposition](#) figures like Enrique Márquez into the cabinet.
- The "Constituyente Laboral" will likely pass, significantly [lowering labor liabilities](#) for new investors.

Long Term (1-5 Years)

- Venezuela is likely to displace the Middle East as the [primary marginal supplier](#) of oil to the US market, fundamentally altering global tanker routes.
- The development of the "Amazonian Mining Arc" with US technology could make Venezuela a global leader in [rare earth production](#), challenging China's dominance.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- **Diplomatic Realignment:** Allies should prepare for a US foreign policy that [prioritizes energy pragmatism](#) over traditional democratic "benchmarking."
- **Regional Security:** Increased US military presence in the Caribbean to [secure energy lanes](#) is a high-probability development.
- **Mediation:** The US will likely take the lead in [mediating the Essequibo dispute](#), using its leverage over both Guyana and Venezuela to ensure uninterrupted production.

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Oil & Gas Infrastructure:** Massive opportunities exist in [refinery rehabilitation](#) and gas capture technology, as the government seeks to end gas flaring.
- **Mining Sector:** Early-mover advantage in [rare earth minerals](#) and gold is significant as the new Mining Law opens the door to large-scale foreign ownership.
- **Risk Management:** While "Risk Country" metrics are dropping, investors must remain [skeptical of the pace](#) of salary recovery and potential labor-related operational disruptions.
