

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 5, 2026, marks a catastrophic structural shift in global security as the Islamic Republic of Iran executes **Operation True Promise 4**, a massive multi-front military campaign against US and Israeli assets. This escalation follows the [assassination of Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei](#) during the holy month of Ramadan by US-Zionist forces. Tehran has signaled a transition from strategic patience to total war, launching the [19th wave of ballistic missile strikes](#) targeting Israeli military hubs in Tel Aviv, Haifa, and Ashdod. The conflict has expanded beyond the Levant, with the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) targeting 27 US bases across eight regional countries, effectively neutralizing key command and control centers such as the [U.S. Fifth Fleet headquarters](#) in Bahrain.

The economic consequences are immediate and systemic. Iran has implemented an ["intelligent blockade" of the Strait of Hormuz](#), halting the flow of oil and gas and forcing Qatar to suspend all liquefied natural gas (LNG) production. Global energy markets are in a state of shock, with Brent crude prices surging and insurance companies refusing to cover shipping in the Persian Gulf. Concurrently, the Trump administration is facing a deepening domestic crisis; rumors of the suspension of the November 2026 elections and a "MAGA" base revolting against [unprecedented military losses](#) suggest that the war is destabilizing the American domestic order as much as the regional one.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

1. Operation True Promise 4 and the 19th Missile Wave

- The IRGC launched the 19th wave of retaliatory strikes using [Khorramshahr 4 heavy missiles](#) equipped with one-ton warheads against Tel Aviv and Ben Gurion Airport.
- Tehran deployed the [Hadid 110 suicide drone](#) for the first time, specifically designed to overwhelm and bypass Israeli and US layered air defense networks.
- The IRGC claims to have successfully struck [20 US military targets](#) in Bahrain, the UAE, and Kuwait, reporting significant American casualties.

2. Martyrdom of Ali Khamenei and Leadership Succession

- The assassination of Ali Khamenei has catalyzed [massive funeral processions](#) and protests across Iran, Iraq, Pakistan, and Kashmir, framing the war as a religious and existential struggle.
- A [Leadership Council/Transition Council](#) has assumed control of the Islamic Republic's military and state functions to ensure continuity of operations.
- Tehran has utilized the martyrdom to unify reformist and hardline political factions into a [single resistant front](#) against foreign aggression.

3. Strategic Naval Warfare and the Denna Incident

- The US Navy reportedly [torpedoed the Iranian frigate Denna](#) near Sri Lanka while it was participating in a joint exercise with the Indian Navy, killing 130 sailors.
- Iran retaliated by [striking an American oil tanker](#) in the northern Persian Gulf, demonstrating its capability to interdict maritime traffic far from its shores.
- Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi warned that Washington would [bitterly regret the precedent](#) set by attacking sovereign naval vessels in international waters.

4. Total Closure of Global Energy Choke Points

- The Strait of Hormuz and Bab el-Mandeb are effectively closed to "hostile" traffic; [seven oil tankers](#) are currently stranded at the mouth of the strait.
- Qatar halted LNG production as [storage facilities reached maximum capacity](#) within 72 hours of the blockade's commencement.

- Market analysts predict oil prices could exceed [record levels](#), severely impacting Asian economies (Japan, South Korea, India) and the Eurozone.

5. Fragmentation of the Western Coalition

- Spain has [barred the US from using bases](#) at Rota and Moron to launch strikes against Iran, citing a breach of international law.
- The UK government under Keir Starmer has faced intense domestic criticism for [allowing US planes to use British bases](#) in Cyprus despite initially hesitant rhetoric.
- Australia has [deployed military units](#) to the Middle East, while Canada is reportedly considering joining the belligerent coalition.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Succession & Stability

- The [Transition Council](#) is currently managing the Iranian state, emphasizing that martyrdom does not disrupt the institutional structure of the Vilayat-e Faqih.
- Internal US stability is at risk, with reports suggesting President Trump may [suspend the November elections](#), potentially ending the democratic myth in the US.

Energy Security

- The blockade of the Persian Gulf has [triggered supply scarcity](#) across Asia and Europe. Tehran is using energy as its primary "normative power" to impose costs on US accomplices.
- Reports emerge of [Trump's inner circle](#) allegedly profiting from the oil price spike, a narrative Tehran is using to fuel anti-war sentiment in the US.

Lawfare (Legal Warfare)

- Tehran is documenting [strikes on non-military targets](#), including schools and hospitals, to present a case of war crimes to the international community.
- The US Senate [failed to pass legislation](#) to reign in Trump's war powers, effectively granting the executive branch a carte blanche for the ongoing aggression.

Critical Infrastructure

- Iranian civilian infrastructure, particularly in Tehran and southern cities like Minab, has suffered [extensive damage](#) to gas lines, water facilities, and power grids.
- The [BAPCO power refinery](#) in Bahrain was severely damaged by Iranian missiles, illustrating the vulnerability of regional energy processing hubs.

Geopolitical Power Dynamics

- Russia and China have transitioned from cautious observers to a [trilateral alliance](#) with Iran, with Russia reportedly signaling it may cut off gas to Europe if NATO joins the conflict.
- The "Unipolar World" is declared dead; analysts argue the [US dollar's dominance](#) is being challenged as China moves to replace it with the Renminbi for oil transactions.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Legislative action has been characterized by executive overreach in the US and a complete breakdown of international mediation through the UN. The US Congress remains paralyzed, while the Iranian Majlis and Transition Council have authorized **total mobilization**.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The "Epstein Class" Narrative

A prominent theme in Tehran's media is the framing of the US leadership as the ["Epstein Class."](#) This psychological warfare tactic links the war to recent Epstein file releases, alleging that US and Israeli leaders are initiating the conflict to distract from domestic pedophilia and corruption scandals.

By branding the war an "[Epstein class war](#)," Iran seeks to peel away the moral ground of the US populist base, framing the IRGC's resistance as a fight for "humanity" against "evil souls."

Depletion of Western Shield Tech

State media and military analysts emphasize that the West's [myth of invincibility](#) is cracking. The high rate of interceptor consumption for systems like Iron Dome and Arrow 3—which cost millions per launch—is contrasted with Iran's [low-cost drone swarms](#) and hypersonic warheads. The trend suggests a tactical realization: the West cannot sustain a long-term missile war of attrition without [depleting its entire strategic reserve](#).

The Rise of Localized Resistance

The conflict has decentralized. Hezbollah in Lebanon has resumed [close-quarter combat](#) against advancing Israeli forces, while Iraqi resistance groups have taken the fight [directly to US embassies](#). This indicates that the "Axis of Resistance" is no longer operating as separate proxies but as a [unified regional command](#) triggered by the loss of their common spiritual leader.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks):

- **Regional Uprisings:** Protests in Bahrain, Jordan, and Saudi Arabia are likely to escalate into [civil unrest](#) as populations react to the double shock of energy shortages and the assassination of Khamenei.

Long Term (1-5 Years):

- **End of the Petrodollar:** The strategic alignment of Russia, China, and Iran will likely finalize the [transition away from the US Dollar](#) for oil, fundamentally ending American financial hegemony.
- **US Isolationism:** A military defeat in Iran would likely result in the [total withdrawal](#) of US forces from West Asia, leaving a power vacuum to be filled by the IRGC and the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO).

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- **Supply Chain Resilience:** Shipping routes must be permanently rerouted around Africa; the [Red Sea is a high-risk combat zone](#) with no short-term solution for safe passage.
- **Currency Risk:** Hedging against the US dollar is advised as [petroyuan transitions](#) become a reality in the fallout of the Iran-US war.
