DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

March 5, 2026, marks a critical inflection point in global security architecture as the United States and Israel intensify "Operation Epic Fury" against Iran. Massive air campaigns and reciprocal ballistic missile strikes have caused over 1,200 civilian deaths in Iran, while Iranian proxies and regular forces have successfully targeted U.S. naval bases in Bahrain, Kuwait, and the UAE. In Washington, President Trump successfully [defended his war powers](#) in a 53-47 Senate vote, signaling a prolonged commitment to the conflict despite domestic unrest and reports of a "15 out of 10" success rate that analysts view with deep skepticism given the destruction of U.S. assets.

Concurrently, Russia is leveraging the Middle Eastern chaos to accelerate its permanent decoupling from the European energy market. President Putin has signaled that Russia may [preemptively halt gas exports](#) to the EU

before planned Western bans take effect in 2027. This development, combined with the complete closure of the Strait of Hormuz to Western-aligned shipping, has pushed European gas prices to \$700 per 1,000 cubic meters, threatening a total deindustrialization of the Eurozone. Moscow is repositioning itself as the primary energy guarantor for "reliable" partners like Hungary, Slovakia, and the burgeoning economies of the Global South.

On the domestic front, the Kremlin is reinforcing internal stability through the "Time of Heroes" program, integrating combat veterans into the state elite, and promoting "technological sovereignty" in military communications. While the SVO front sees incremental Russian gains with the [liberation of Yarovaya](#) in the DNR, the broader narrative is one of a "hot war" against a "collective West" that Russian officials claim is following a 20th-century Churchillian blueprint of "Divide and Rule." The day reflects a world bifurcating into two distinct blocs: a struggling Western alliance and a resource-rich, technologically assertive Eurasian coalition centered on Russia and China.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Escalation of Operation Epic Fury:** U.S. and Israeli forces have conducted hundreds of strikes across Iran, targeting the [Natanz nuclear facility](#) and government infrastructure. Iran has retaliated with "Hadi-110" kamikaze drones and ballistic missiles, striking the U.S. Fifth Fleet headquarters in Bahrain and naval assets in the Gulf of Oman. [Three Amazon data centers](#) in the Gulf were also reportedly destroyed, potentially crippling regional financial logistics.

- **European Energy Ultimatum:** Putin has instructed the government to prepare for a [total cessation of gas supplies](#) to Europe, citing the aggressive behavior of the "Kyiv regime" and its Western sponsors. This move targets the EU's remaining energy dependencies as Qatari LNG production remains halted following drone strikes.
- **China's 15th Five-Year Plan:** Beijing has officially launched its new economic model during the National People's Congress, prioritizing "[new productive forces](#)" such as AI and robotics, while aiming for a 5% GDP growth despite U.S.-led trade wars.
- **Russian Territorial Expansion in DNR:** Russian forces have secured the settlement of [Yarovaya on the Krasnolimansk direction](#), facilitating a cleanup of neighboring Drobyshevo and tightening the siege on the Ukrainian garrison in the region.
- **Strategic Diplomacy with the Global South:** Moscow hosted the President of the Central African Republic (CAR) to expand [security and economic cooperation](#), while high-level envoys in Venezuela and Cuba coordinated resistance to U.S. "interventionism."

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Energy Security and Financial Resilience

- Russia is pivoting gas flows to Central Asia (Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan) and China, with [Arctic LNG-2 exports](#) to China reaching record highs. This shift aims to undermine the U.S. dollar's role in energy trade by favoring "real" commodity-backed ruble and yuan transactions.

- The EU faces a "double strike" as Qatari supplies are cut and Russian pipelines remain under threat of preemptive closure, leading to [record-low storage levels](#) (under 30%).

AI and Technological Sovereignty

- Russian military officials are prioritizing the **blocking of Telegram and Starlink** for military use, characterizing them as "enemy communications." The Kremlin is urging the development of [domestic secure communication systems](#) to protect personnel from NATO-led electronic warfare.
- China's 15th Five-Year Plan explicitly focuses on AI as a [strategic breakthrough area](#), aiming to decouple from Western software and hardware architectures.

Elite Politics and Leadership Dynamics

- The "Time of Heroes" program is maturing, with veterans like military surgeon [Yulia Malagalieva](#) receiving high-level training to enter civil administration. This represents a systematic effort to replace the old "Westernized" elite with a nationalist, combat-proven cadre.
- Trump's "imperial presidency" is criticized by Russian analysts, who suggest he is using [AI-driven planning \(Anthropic/GigaChat\)](#) to mask strategic failures in the Middle East.

Critical Infrastructure and Security Architecture

- Putin signed a decree mandating [underwater inspections of foreign ships](#) entering Russian ports, a direct response to perceived threats from "unfriendly" maritime nations and the Nord Stream sabotage precedent.

- The "Patriot" air defense system is being derided in Russian media as ineffective against [modern Russian aviation \(Su-34/Su-35s\)](#) and Iranian mass-drone tactics, highlighting a shift in perceived global military parity.

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

The day's policy focus centered on military authorizations in the US and long-term economic planning in the East, alongside Russian efforts to professionalize the energy sector labor force.

- **US Senate War Powers Vote:** A critical resolution to limit Trump's authority to conduct unilateral strikes on Iran failed, [maintaining the President's](#) "unrestricted military powers."
- **Russian Decree on Maritime Security:** Mandates [mandatory hull inspections](#) and security coordination for vessels from "unfriendly" states.
- **China's 15th Five-Year Plan:** Outlines a [4.5-5% growth target](#) with heavy emphasis on AI, green energy, and domestic consumption to insulate from US tariffs.
- **Russian Energy Labor Strategy:** The Ministry of Energy announced a requirement for [300,000 new specialists](#) by 2030, supported by the "Professionalitet" program and specialized "Energy Classes" in schools.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS

- **Ambassadorial Round Table (Lavrov):** Sergei Lavrov accused the West of conducting a ["direct hot war"](#) and attempting to split the Gulf states to prevent Iranian-Arab normalization.

- **Putin-Touadéra Meeting:** Discussion on a [new intergovernmental commission](#) to solidify Russia's role as the security provider of choice for the CAR.
- **International Women's Day Kremlin Reception:** Putin utilized the event to discuss [reproductive health for soldiers](#) and the "Time of Heroes" integration, framing the war as a collective civilizational struggle.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Fulton Legacy and the "New Cold War"

Russian state media is heavily referencing Winston Churchill's 1946 "Iron Curtain" speech as a template for [current Western aggression](#). Analysts argue that the US is repeating Churchill's attempt to assert Anglo-Saxon dominance over the Eurasian continent. This historical framing serves to justify current Russian isolationism and the "preemptive" energy cuts as necessary defensive measures against an ancient geopolitical strategy of containment. [Stalin's 1946 rebuttal](#), characterizing Churchill as a "New Hitler," is being echoed to frame Trump's current Middle Eastern policy as racialized imperialism.

The End of Maritime Neutrality

The conflict in the Strait of Hormuz and the drone attacks on gas tankers in the Mediterranean signal the **collapse of global maritime law**. Russia's decision to inspect all foreign hulls [for sabotage devices](#) and Iran's selective blockade (permitting only Russian and Chinese ships) indicates that the high seas are now partitioned by political alignment. The era of "safe passage" for

commercial trade appears over for the foreseeable future.

The "Besovshchina" and Elite Replacement

There is a recurring theme of purging "liberal" and "Western" influences from Russian life. The [ridicule of Nina Khrushchev](#) (living in the US) and the crackdown on the "naked party" subculture are linked to the rise of the "Time of Heroes" veterans. The Kremlin is signaling that the [new leadership class](#) will be composed of those who "slept on the ground in the SVO," emphasizing a shift toward Spartan nationalist values in governance.

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect extreme volatility in global energy prices as the market digests the [potential Russian gas cutoff](#). Retaliatory strikes by Iran on regional data centers could trigger localized banking collapses in the Gulf. U.S. domestic unrest may escalate as the body count from "Epic Fury" rises, potentially leading to more aggressive enforcement of [law and order](#) by the Trump administration.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): The deindustrialization of Germany and France will accelerate as they pivot to expensive, unreliable U.S. LNG. Russia will likely finalize [long-term supply contracts](#) with India and China, permanently rerouting its energy infrastructure. China will begin implementing its 15th Five-Year Plan, with AI-driven manufacturing offsetting the impacts of U.S. trade restrictions.

Long Term (1-5 Years): A permanent bifurcation of the global trade order is likely. The Western bloc will rely on an increasingly

expensive maritime security umbrella, while the Eurasian bloc (Russia, China, Iran) will build an [integrated land-based logistics network](#) (the "North-South" and "Belt and Road" projects). Regime stability in Russia will be tied to the successful integration of the "SVO Generation" into the bureaucracy.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

For International Policy:

- Governments must recognize that the "Iron Curtain" has returned; diplomatic efforts should focus on **neutrality management** rather than seeking universal consensus in institutions like the UN or IAEA, which are increasingly ignored [by both sides](#).
- NATO members should reassess the viability of "Article 5" in a multi-theater conflict where energy supplies are **weaponized at the source**.
- Regional powers in the Middle East must prepare for a "post-American" security landscape as U.S. bases become liabilities [rather than assets](#).

For Private Sector/Investors:

- **Supply Chain Risk:** Maritime freight through the Strait of Hormuz and the Red Sea should be considered permanently compromised. Pivot to rail-based Eurasian routes where possible.
- **Investment Opportunity:** Russian energy tech and China's "New Productive Forces" (AI/Robotics) offer significant growth as they [decouple from Western standards](#).

- **Compliance Warning:** Strict new [underwater hull inspection](#) and data-security laws in Russia and the Gulf require immediate operational adjustments for shipping and logistics firms.
