LAWFARE IN POLAND

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

The Middle East conflict has entered a critical second phase on its seventh day, characterized by intensified Israeli-American strikes against Iranian government infrastructure and Hezbollah strongholds in Beirut. While military officials claim to have [destroyed 60-80% of Iran's missile launchers](#), Iran's retaliatory capacity remains potent, with over 2,500 missiles and drones launched toward Israel and neighboring Gulf states. The closure of the Strait of Hormuz has triggered a global energy shock, with [fuel prices in Poland spiking toward 8 PLN per liter](#) amid fears of prolonged supply chain disruptions. This regional conflagration is now forcing Western allies to seek unconventional support, including [US requests for Ukrainian anti-drone expertise](#) to counter Iranian-made Shahed systems.

In Poland, the external crisis is being leveraged by domestic power brokers to

escalate a constitutional standoff over military funding. The "Safe 0%" proposal introduced by President Karol Nawrocki and NBP Governor Adam Glapiński—aimed at using central bank reserves to fund armaments—is being [denounced by the government as a "smoke screen"](#) intended to justify a veto of the existing EU-backed "Safe" program. This political "lawfare" occurs as the Law and Justice (PiS) party undergoes internal fragmentation, with sidelined former Prime Minister Mateusz Morawiecki holding rival events while the party [prepares to announce a new prime ministerial candidate](#) in Kraków.

Concurrently, a major diplomatic and legal rift has opened in Central Europe following Hungary's [detention of seven Ukrainian bank employees](#) and millions in assets. Ukraine has characterized this as "state terrorism" and hostage-taking, linking the incident to energy blackmail over the "Friendship" (Druzhba) pipeline. This convergence of military escalation in the Middle East, energy insecurity, and the breakdown of regional diplomatic norms suggests a systemic shift toward a more fragmented and volatile European security architecture.

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

- **Total War in the Middle East:** Israel and the US have initiated a new phase of operations aimed at [destroying the foundations of the Iranian regime](#), specifically targeting military production and government facilities. Retaliatory strikes have hit US bases in Qatar, Bahrain, and Kuwait, while the [US Navy successfully sank an Iranian frigate](#) using a torpedo for the first time since WWII.

- **The "Safe 0%" Constitutional Standoff:** President Nawrocki and NBP Governor Glapiński have proposed an alternative to EU defense loans, suggesting the [use of gold reserves and NBP profits](#) to fund the military. The Tusk government argues this is illegal under Article 220 of the Constitution and [points to massive NBP losses](#) totaling nearly 100 billion PLN over two years.
- **Energy Market Collapse:** The Hormuz blockade has led to a [projected diesel price of 7.30 PLN/liter](#) next week, with some stations already reporting 8 PLN. Qatar Energy has declared [force majeure on LNG deliveries](#), potentially delaying Polish shipments for April and May.
- **Hungary-Ukraine Crisis:** Hungarian anti-terrorist units [seized a Ukrainian bank convoy](#) carrying 40 million USD and 9kg of gold. While Hungary alleges money laundering, Ukraine views this as [retaliation for the halted flow of Russian oil](#) via the Druzhba pipeline.
- **Polish Evacuation Efforts:** Over 2,800 Poles have been [evacuated from the conflict zone](#) since March 1. The government has activated the EU Civil Protection Mechanism to [coordinate military and commercial flights](#) from Oman and the UAE.

KEY GOVERNANCE TOPICS

Energy Security The blockade of the Strait of Hormuz, through which 20% of global oil and gas flows, is the primary threat to domestic stability. Analysts warn that [fuel prices are being "artificially inflated"](#) by panic buying and speculation. While Orlen asserts that [domestic supplies are secured through Norway and local refineries](#), the global price surge and the potential loss of Katarski LNG

threaten industrial production, particularly [fertilizer manufacturing which relies on gas](#).

Elite Politics & Leadership Dynamics

Internal friction within Law and Justice (PiS) has surfaced as the party [seeks a "young, unburdened" candidate for Prime Minister](#) to stop a polling slide below 30%. Sidelined former PM Morawiecki's [organization of a rival "Powered by Poland" conference](#) highlights deep fractionalization. Meanwhile, NBP Governor Glapiński's [description of himself as a "powerhouse" \(mocarz\)](#) and his dismissal of central bank losses as technicalities signals a defiant stance against the government's attempt to bring him before the State Tribunal.

National Security & Security Architecture

The debate over the "Safe" program (EU loan) vs. "Safe 0%" (NBP-funded) is a fundamental disagreement over Poland's strategic alignment. The government emphasizes [integration into the European defense industry](#) and immediate funding for 139 entities. The President's alternative is framed as [protecting Polish sovereignty from "German dominance,"](#) though military experts warn that delaying these funds [jeopardizes the 2030 goal](#) of building Europe's strongest army.

Diplomatic Engagement & Geopolitical Power Dynamics

The Hungary-Ukraine incident illustrates the use of "legal warfare" (lawfare) to achieve energy goals. Prime Minister Viktor Orban has [vowed to block Ukraine's EU accession](#) and suggested that force might be used to restore oil flows. This mirrors the [broader geopolitical fragmentation](#) where Russia, despite being militarily overextended, is [providing intelligence to Iran](#) to facilitate attacks on US bases, thereby distracting Western resources from the Ukrainian front.

AI & Technology Policy Reports suggest the US is utilizing [advanced AI \("Chat Cloud"\) to suggest targets](#) in Iran. However, the bombing of a school in Minap, which [killed 175 people including children](#), has sparked an investigation into whether AI error or proximity to military targets led to the tragedy. This highlights the ethical and operational risks of [AI-driven kinetic operations](#).

LEGISLATIVE ROUNDUP

Policy discussion today was dominated by the "Safe" program implementation and emergency traffic regulations intended to curb "road banditry" amid rising social tension.

BILLS DISCUSSED/DEBATED:

- **The EU "Safe" Program Implementation:** A 180 billion PLN loan package currently [awaiting the President's signature](#). The bill would enable immediate funding for Polish PGZ plants and defense contractors. The President has [threatened a veto](#) in favor of a yet-to-be-drafted domestic alternative.
- **New Road Safety Regulations:** Effective March 3, these laws [mandate immediate 3-month license suspensions](#) for exceeding speed limits by 50 km/h on single-carriageway, two-way roads outside built-up areas. Several drivers have [already lost their licenses](#) under these tightened rules.
- **NBP Law Amendments:** Proposed by the President's office to allow [profits from gold operations](#) to be transferred to the Armed Forces Support Fund. Legal experts argue this [violates NBP statutory independence](#) and EU treaties.

HEARINGS & PRESS EVENTS:

- **Coordination Team on Middle East:** Premier Tusk and Minister Sikorski updated the public on [evacuation logistics and military hospital readiness](#). Tusk emphasized a "war-like alert" for all diplomatic outposts.
- **Defense Industry Tour:** Minister Kosiniak-Kamysz and EU Commissioner Kubilius [visited the Mesko plant](#), calling for a 400% increase in European missile production to meet Ukrainian and domestic needs.
- **PiS Ethics Committee:** Several high-profile PiS members, including Morawiecki, faced [hearings for "publicly discussing party affairs,"](#) indicating a crackdown on dissent within the opposition.

DEEP DIVE: TRENDS AND THEMES

The Weaponization of the Central Bank

The NBP is no longer acting solely as a monetary authority but has been repositioned as a [political "alibi" for the President](#). By announcing a "Safe 0%" program with no concrete details, the NBP Governor is [engaging in creative accounting](#)—hypothetically selling and repurchasing gold to "create" zysk (profit) where none exists in the current balance sheet. This trend threatens the long-term credibility of the Polish Zloty and complicates Poland's standing within the European System of Central Banks.

The Transatlantic vs. European Defense Schism

A growing narrative divide exists between the government's "European Safe" (focusing on [synergy with EU defense projects](#)) and the President's "Polish Safe"

(focusing on [maintaining procurement flexibility with the US and Korea](#)). Critics of the EU loan argue it comes with [ideological "conditionality" \(gender, rule of law\)](#), while supporters note that [US military engagement in Iran](#) will inevitably delay equipment deliveries to Poland, making local European production a survival necessity.

Regional Disintegration and "Oil Hostages" Hungary's actions toward Ukrainian bank employees signal that [Viktors Orban is moving toward overt hostility](#) to preserve his energy ties with Moscow. By labeling Ukraine an "enemy" and [detaining couriers](#), Budapest is using hybrid methods to pressure Kijów into reopening the Druzhba pipeline. This suggests that the Visegrád Group is effectively dead, replaced by [bilateral energy-security bargaining](#) and "state banditry."

STRATEGIC FORESIGHT

Short Term (1-4 Weeks): Expect [fuel prices to stabilize near 7.50-8.00 PLN](#) if the Hormuz blockade holds. The [PiS PM candidate announcement](#) on Saturday will likely trigger a new wave of internal party purging or realignment. The [Presidential meeting on March 10](#) regarding the "Safe 0%" program will determine if the Tusk government pursues immediate legislative warfare or finds a "synergy" path.

Medium Term (1-6 Months): Poland may face [shortages in nitrogen-based fertilizers](#) as gas prices soar, impacting the spring planting season. Diplomatic pressure on Hungary from the EU will likely escalate, potentially [leading to renewed Article 7 proceedings](#) over the bank detention incident. If the Iran conflict persists, [US deliveries of Abrams tanks and F-35s](#) to Poland may be officially deprioritized.

Long Term (1-5 Years): The current crisis will likely accelerate the [discourse on Poland joining the Eurozone](#) to mitigate the costs of maintaining a separate currency and massive reserves. The success of Ukrainian anti-drone technology against Iranian systems will [reshape global defense exports](#), making Kijów a major security consultant for the West. The Iranian regime may survive the current strikes but will face [permanent economic devastation](#) and a transition to a more militarized, Russian-aligned leadership.

RECOMMENDATIONS & IMPLICATIONS

- **International Policy:** European nations must immediately [activate long-term civil defense mechanisms](#) and diversify LNG sources away from Qatar. Diplomatic channels must be used to [prevent the Hungary-Ukraine spat](#) from collapsing the EU's unified front against Russian energy exports.
- **Private Sector/Investors:** Investors should [hedge against high energy costs](#) in the transport and agricultural sectors. Supply chain managers should [re-evaluate reliance on Middle Eastern transit](#) and consider the "Northern Route" or African alternatives, despite higher costs. The [Polish defense sector presents a high-growth opportunity](#) if the current funding impasse is resolved.

- **National Security:** Poland must prioritize [anti-drone and anti-ballistic missile production](#) (Piorun/San programs) to mitigate the risk of stray munitions or intentional provocations. Coordination between the President and the government [on evacuations and intelligence sharing](#) is essential to prevent "narrative warfare" from weakening the state's functional capacity during an external war.
